ST. CLOUD STATE MEN'S BASKETBALL



KICKING OFF 2010: The St. Cloud State men's basketball team (9-2, 3-1 NSIC) will begin 2010 on the road in the middle of a six game winning streak after closing out the final two weeks of 2009 with three non-conference wins.

The Huskies will get back into Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference action when they travel to St. Paul to take on Concordia University St. Paul (5-6, 2-2 NSIC) at 4 p.m. on Saturday, January 2. Both squad's will play each other again on February, 24 at Halenbeck Hall.

NON-CONFERENCE CONCLUSION: The Huskies started its three game non-conference stint with an easy 102-68 victory at home over Judson College on December 16, before beating up on Cardinal Stritch in a 99-73 victory in Halenbeck Hall the next night.

St. Cloud State ended its non-conference regular season schedule with a convincing 78-46 win over the University of Sioux Falls on Tuesday night at Halenbeck Hall.

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have been 20-game winners six times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 246-114 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Game Notes

BLOCK PARTY: The Huskies broke a school record for blocks in a game with 15 against the University of Sioux Falls, surpassing a 2005-06 squad, who recorded 13 against Johnson & Wales back in 2005.

Junior Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph) and Jesse Fisher (Pequot Lakes) both swatted four shots a piece, while five other Husky players recorded a block in the game. Bernstetter is in the top three in the conference with 2.18 blocks per game.

OVER THE CENTURY MARK: St. Cloud State put up a combined 279 points in its last three games at Halenbeck. The Huskies first put up a season high 102 points against Judson College on 37-of-68 shooting on Dec. 16, and scored 99 points against Cardinal Stritch the following night.

It was the first 100 point performance since scoring 120 points against Dakota State last season.

HANDLING THE ROCK: The Huskies recorded a season high 22 assists against Cardinal Stritch, while posting a season high +11 assist to turnover ratio. Witt recorded a career high 10 assists in the game and recorded his first double-

double of his career in the process. He also became the first player to record a double digit assist total since Dusty Wabiszewski recorded 10 against South Dakota State on March 1, 2008.

GOOD FOR THREE: Sophomore Brett Putz was on fire from beyond the arc over the last three games, making 12-of-19 three's, including a personal career high 6-for-8 performance against Cardinal Stritch. Putz is in the top five with 30 three-point field goals made.

SHUTDOWN DEFENSE: St. Cloud State held the University of Sioux Falls to a season low 46 points on a 19-for-65 shooting night. The Cougars were 9-for-33 in the first half, which included two baskets in the final 1:30. It was the lowest opponent score since Concordia scored 46 last January.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Senior captain Matt Schneck was named Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference player of the week for this play from Dec. 14- Dec. 21. Schneck shot a blazing 75 percent from the field and made 10 of 12 free throws during the week and also scored more points (46) than the minutes he played (45), while recording his seventh and eight double-double of the season.

MOVING UP THE LADDER: Schneck moved himself further up the all-time St. Cloud State scoring list over the last two weeks.

Schneck scored 20 points against Judson University on Dec. 16 and followed it with a career high 26 points against Cardinal Stritch to put himself at 1,149 total points in his career to tie Dean Kesler (1990-92) for 23rd on the all-time scoring list.

Opponents Notes

CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY: The Huskies are 10-2 against the Golden Bears since the series started during the 1999-00 season. St. Cloud State beat up on the Golden Bears 68-46 in the first game against each other last season at Halenbeck Hall.

The Golden Bears did not go down so easy in the second matchup, as the Huskies came away with a 69-67 win at the Gangelhoff Center last February.

Concordia University is 5-6 overall this season and 2-2 in the NSIC. The team is currently on a two game losing streak and most recently lost to St. Thomas University 80-78 at home on Dec. 22. The Golden Bears earned conference wins over Minnesota, Crookston and Minnesota State University Moorhead, while losing to Upper Iowa and Winona State.

The Golden Bears are a well balanced offensive team with four starters scoring in double figures. Senior Craig Heiman leads the team with 170 points and 15.5 points a game this season. Fellow senior Mike Cunningham is second on the team with 12.3 points, while senior Sammy Ricks is averaging 10.7 points and leads the team with 35 assists. Sophomore Brent Barz rounds out the double digit scorers with 10.4 a game and leads the team with 8.1 rebounds per contest.

As a team, Concordia University is averaging 76.8 points a game while giving up 72.8 points to its opponents. They have out rebounded opponents 426 to 354 this season while shooting nearly 47 percent from the field.



Kelly Boe is in his fourth season as head coach of the Golden Bears, where he has gone 50-35 before the 2009-10 season. Boe also helped lead Concordia University to its best season in school history in his first season during the 2006-07 campaign with a 21-8 record. It was also the best Division II record the school has posted.

The Golden Bears finished in eight place last season in the NSIC with an 11-9 conference record, while going 13-15 overall. Concordia University was picked to finish sixth in the NSIC this season in the pre-season coaches poll.
