A "GOLDEN" ENDING: The No. 20 ranked St. Cloud State men's basketball team (20-4, 14-3 NSIC) will play in the final two regular season home games in the next week and a half, as the Huskies first take on the University of Minnesota, Crookston Golden Eagles at 4 p.m., Saturday, Feb. 20 at Halenbeck Hall. St. Cloud will then host Concordia University-St. Paul at 8 p.m., Wednesday, Feb. 24.

MAKE IT SEVEN IN A ROW: St. Cloud State earned a pair of Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference wins last week, as they first beat Southwest Minnesota State 64-51 Friday, Feb. 12 and then finished out the weekend with a 92-84 win over No. 7 Minnesota State University, Mankato the following evening to make it seven straight wins for the Huskies.

SENIOR DAY: Seniors Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.), Michael Riley (Milwaukee, Wis.), and Mahmoud Abdelfattah (Chicago, Ill.) will be honored for their commitment to the St. Cloud State basketball program at Halenbeck Hall when the Huskies play Minnesota, Crookston Saturday afternoon.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 257-116 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Game Notes

BACK-TO-BACK 20 WIN SEASONS: By No. 7 ranked Minnesota State 92-84 Saturday, coach Kevin Schlagel recorded back-to-back 20 win seasons for the third time at St. Cloud State and is his seventh 20-win season. His season high for wins is 26 during the 2002-03 season.

BLOCKING HISTORY: Junior Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph) is in second place on the all-time blocks list at St. Cloud State with 104 in his career. He recorded eight blocks last weekend, including tying his career high with five against SMSU. Bernstetter set the single season school record with his 41st block of the year earlier this season and is now at 52 on the season. Jon Hinzman (1994-98) is the leading shot blocker in school history with 115. Bernstetter is also second in the NSIC with 2.17 blocks a game. As a team, the Huskies own a school record with 119 blocks on the season and are 13th in the country and lead the NSIC with 4.96 a contest.

CAREER NIGHT: Senior captain Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) scored a career high 34 points and dished out a career high five assists in a win over Minnesota State. He is 13th in the country in field goal percentage at 61.9 percent. Junior Josh Ortmann (Buffalo) grabbed a career high six rebounds and scored a season high 15 points against MSU.

HOME SWEET HOME: With a pair of wins over the weekend, St. Cloud State is now 12-1 this season at home and have won 10 straight at Halenbeck Hall.

IRON MEN: Junior Taylor Witt (Morris) played in all 40 minutes against Southwest Minnesota State, scoring a game-high 26 points, while going 7-for-7 from the free throw line. Not to be outdone, Ortmann was on the court for a solid 39 minutes in the game and then followed it with a 37-minute night against Minnesota State.

THREE-PEAT: Schneck earned his third NSIC player of the week award after his dominating play in two wins over Southwest Minnesota State and Minnesota State. He is the only player in the conference to win the award three times this season.

CHAIRMEN OF THE BOARDS: Schneck recorded 26 rebounds over the weekend and moved into No. 5 on the all-time rebounds list at St. Cloud State Friday night, passing Jason Kron (99-03) and now has 768 rebounds in his career. He also leads the conference with 10.7 per contest and overall rebounds with 245. Bernstetter is seventh in the conference with 7.0 rebounds a game.

MOVING UP THE RANKS: Schneck is No. 13 in all-time scoring in St. Cloud State history at 1,391 points in his career. After a 42 point weekend, he is now 44 points behind Haug Scharnowski (89-94) for 12th on the all-time list. Scharnowski recorded 1,434 points in his career.

Opponents Notes

ABOUT THE GOLDEN EAGLES: The Huskies have never lost to the University of Minnesota, Crookston and are 16-0 since the series started during the 1995-96 season. Most recently, St. Cloud State beat Minnesota, Crookston 84-70 on the road last year after a 91-54 win earlier in the year at home. The Golden Eagles are 4-19 overall this season and are in last place in the NSIC with a 1-16 record.

The Golden Eagles are coming off an 81-64 to Bemidji State at home on Feb. 13. Minnesota, Crookston earned its first conference victory of the season the night before in a 78-64 win over the University of Minnesota Duluth to snap a 17-game losing streak.

Head coach Jeff Oseth is in his eighth year at the University of Minnesota, Crookston and is coming off a 5-22 overall season in 2008-09, while going 3-17 in the team's first season in the NSIC.



The Golden Eagles are posting 64.1 points a game offensively, while giving up 79.8 points to opponents this season. Minnesota, Crookston has four players scoring in double figures as junior Akkem Cubie leads the team with 19.9 points in eight games played this season. Junior Adam Hendricks is the only player on the team to start all 23 games and is averaging 10.2 points a game.

ABOUT THE GOLDEN BEARS: St. Cloud State is 11-2 in a 10-year history with Concordia University-St. Paul and has won four straight in the series. The Huskies beat the Golden Bears 89-80 on the road earlier this season as junior Taylor Witt (Morris) dropped 26 points and dished out six assists in the win. The Golden Bears are in fifth place in the NSIC after a triple overtime 104-103 win over Southwest Minnesota State on Feb. 14. to improve to 13-11 overall and 10-7 in the NSIC. Concordia-St. Paul will play Minnesota State University Moorhead on Feb. 20 before traveling to St. Cloud. The team is 5-3 on the road this season in NSIC play and 5-3 at home.

Concordia-St. Paul is led by head coach Kelly Boe, who is in his fourth season as the bench leader for the Golden Bears. He comes into the week with a 63-46 overall record with the Concordia- St. Paul.



The Golden Bears are fifth in the conference with a 78.7 points per game average and are giving up 76.2 points a game to opponents. They also are third in field goal percentage at 48.4 percent, while shooting nearly 39 percent from beyond the arc. Senior Craig Heiman is leading the team with 16 points a game and three pointers made with 52 this season. Two other Concordia-St. Paul players are scoring in double digits. Freshman Isaiah Thomas is shooting 51.9 percent from beyond the arc this season, which is a conference best.
