TRAVELING NORTH: After a weekend in the friendly confines of Halenbeck Hall, the St. Cloud State men's basketball team (16-4, 10-3 NSIC) will be on the road heading north for a pair of Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference games.

The Huskies will first battle the University of Minnesota Duluth at 8 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 5. St. Cloud State will then take on Bemidji State at 8 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 6. Both games will follow the St. Cloud State women's game.

IMPRESSING THE HOME CROWD: The Huskies earned its seventh and eighth straight home game wins over the weekend. St. Cloud State first handed Wayne State a 74-66 loss on Friday night, before earning a 68-58 win over No. 17 Augustana College in front of 4,024 fans Saturday evening.

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball.

He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have been 20-game winners six times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 253-116 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Game Notes

SWEET REVENGE: St. Cloud State earned a 68-58 win over No. 17 Augustana College Saturday night and took over sole possession of second place in the NSIC after losing earlier in the season to the Vikings 89-80 at the NSIC Holiday Hoopsfest. A buzzer beater was also involved in the game after Augustana beat the Huskies in the final game of the 2008-09 season on a buzzer beater in the first round of the NCAA Central Regional tournament.

THROW HIM A BLOCK PARTY: Junior Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph) had a record setting weekend on the defensive end of the court. On Friday he moved into second place on the all-time blocks list at St. Cloud State with 88 in his career. He passed Rado Rancik (1998-02) for the No. 2 spot after recording four blocks against Wayne State. Then on Saturday night, Bernstetter set the single season school record with his 41st block of the year. He tied his career high with five blocks and is now at 43 on the season and 93 in his career. Jon Hinzman (1994-98) is the leading shot blocker in school history with 115. Bernstetter is also second in the conference with 2.15 blocks a game. As a team, the Huskies set a school record with 107 blocks on the season passing the 2003-04 team that recorded 106.

STRONG BENCH PLAY: St. Cloud State's bench scored 64 points in two games this weekend. The Huskies' bench outscored Wayne State's 26-3 on Friday before outscoring Augustana's 38-17. Junior Jesse Fisher (Pequot Lakes) scored 12 points and grabbed nine rebounds in 15 minutes off the bench on Saturday.

HOME SWEET HOME: Following a pair of home wins this weekend, the Huskies are 10-1 this season at home and have won eight straight at Halenbeck Hall.

NSIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Senior Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) earned his second NSIC Player of the Week award after finishing Friday night one rebound from a double-double, with a game-high 18 points to go with nine rebounds. On Saturday, Schneck capped off the weekend with his 12th double-double of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds.

MOVING UP THE RANKS: Schneck moved into No. 18 in all-time scoring in St. Cloud State history at 1,303 points in his career. Schneck passed Matt Siegle (02-06) for the No. 18 spot at 1,294 points.

Opponents Notes

ABOUT THE BULLDOGS: No. 17 The Huskies are 46-30 against Minnesota Duluth since the series started back during the 1932-33 season. St. Cloud State beat the Bulldogs earlier this season 65-45 at home on Jan. 8.

The Bulldogs are 7-13 overall this season and are 4-9 in NSIC play. Most recently, Minnesota Duluth lost on the road to No. 5 Minnesota State 79-65 on Saturday.

Head coach Gary Holquist has compiled an overall record of 182-63 since taking over the head coaching job in 1998 and ahs Minnesota Duluth at 6-3 at home this season, while going 0-8 on the road.



The Bulldogs are 13th in the conference in scoring this season, averaging 65.1 points per contest. Defensively, the Minnesota Duluth is giving up just over 75 points a game and are second in the conference with 4.20 blocks per game.

Individually, senior forward Ron White is 14th in the NSIC with 13.9 points a game and is fifth the conference with 7.2 rebounds a contest. He is also eighth in the conference with 3.67 assists per 40 minutes of play. Sophomore guard Ryan Rasmussen has averaged 16 points in the 13 games he has played this season for the Bulldogs.

Minnesota Duluth has been outscored this season 1,504-1,302, while being outrebounded 790-680.

ABOUT THE BEAVERS: Bemidji State is one of St. Cloud State's oldest rivalries, stretching back 86 years to the 1923-24 season. The Huskies lead the all-time series by a large 51-game margin at 89-38 after St. Cloud State beat the Beavers 80-69 at home on Jan. 9.

The Beavers are 7-12 overall this season and are 11th in the conference with a 4-9 record after a pair of losses to Minnesota State and Southwest Minnesota State last weekend. Bemidji State will host Concordia St. Paul on Friday, before tangling with the Huskies.

Matt Bowen is in his fourth season as Bemidji State's bench leader. He comes into the Beaver home-stand with a 26-75 overall record with the Beavers.



Bemidji State has a well balanced offensive attack with nearly three players scoring in double figures. Senior guard Seth Haake leads the team with 17.2 points a game, while recording 34 steals on the season. Freshman Lance Ronstad helps the NSIC 8th ranked scoring offense, with 10.5 per contest. Sophomore Bryce Tesdahl is scoring 9.7 points and is grabbing a team high 5.2 rebounds per game.

The Beavers have been narrowly outscored this season, scoring 1,321 points while giving up 1,366. Bemidji State has outrebounded its opponents by 30 rebounds at 350 on the year. The Beavers distribute the ball well and are fifth in the conference with 15.05 assists per game.
