### ST. CLOUD STATE MEN'S BASKETBALL



**REGULAR SEASON FINALE:** The No. 16 ranked St. Cloud State men's basketball team (21-4, 16-3 NSIC) will play in their final regular season Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference game this Saturday when they travel to Winona, Minn. to take on Winona State at 7 p.m.

**NINE IN A ROW:** St. Cloud State took care of business in a pair of NSIC wins in their last two home games, beating the University of Minnesota, Crookston 86-57 on senior night last Saturday and came back Wednesday and won the final regular season home game 83-71 over Concordia University-St. Paul to earn their ninth straight victory.

**FIRST PLACE TIE:** The Huskies are now in a tie for first place in the NSIC with No. 5 Minnesota State University after a Mavericks' 72-71 loss to Augustana College Wednesday night as both teams sit at 16-3 in conference play. The Huskies and Mavericks split the season head-to-head series at one win a piece.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 259-116 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Game Notes

**BLOCKING HISTORY:** Junior Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph) is in second place on the all-time blocks list at St. Cloud State with 106 in his career. Bernstetter set the single season school record with his 41st block of the year earlier this season and is now at 54 on the season. Jon Hinzman (1994-98) is the leading shot blocker in school history with 115. Bernstetter is also second in the NSIC with 2.08 blocks a game. As a team, the Huskies own a school record with 128 blocks on the season and lead the NSIC with 4.92 a contest.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** By earning a win over Minnesota, Crookston and Concordia-St. Paul, St. Cloud State ended the 2009-10 regular season with a 14-1 home record and are currently on a 12-game winning streak at Halenbeck Hall.

**JUST SHY OF 1,000:** After scoring 26 points in the last two games, junior Taylor Witt (Morris) is sitting at 999 points in his career at St. Cloud State. With one more point, he will become the 34th player in school history to reach the century mark.

**NATIONALLY RANKED:** Senior captain Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) is 10th in the country in rebounding with 10.6 per game and 19th in field goal percentage at 62.2 percent. Bernstetter is 30th in blocks with 2.08 a game and Witt

is 53rd in assists with 4.7 per contest. As a team the Huskies are 14th in blocked shots and 27th in highest scoring margin over opponents.

**REGIONAL POSITIONING:** St. Cloud State is ranked No. 4 in the latest NCAA Division II Central Region Poll. NSIC competitors Minnesota State and Augustana College are ranked No. 1 and No. 3 respectfully.

**SEASON HIGH:** Junior Josh Ortmann (Buffalo) scored a season high 19 points against Concordia-St. Paul on a solid 6-for-8 night from the field. He also was 3-for-5 from beyond the arc. The top eight teams from the region make the post season regional tournament.

**CHAIRMEN OF THE BOARDS:** Schneck recorded 26 rebounds over the last two games and is No. 5 on the all-time rebounds list at St. Cloud State. He now has 788 rebounds in his career. He also leads the conference with 10.6 per contest and overall rebounds with 265. Bernstetter is seventh in the conference with 6.7 rebounds a game. As a team the Huskies are second in the conference with 38 rebounds a game and are 28th in the country with a +5.6 rebounding margin over opponents.

Opponents Notes

**ABOUT THE WARRIORS:** Winona State is 18-8 overall this season while going 12-7 in the NSIC to sit in fourth place in the conference rankings. The Warriors are 10-4 at home this season and are 7-3 in away games.

Winona State snapped a two-game losing streak with a 66-58 win over Upper Iowa at home Wednesday night after dropping an 88-86 game with Bemidji State after losing to Augustana 82-81 on the road.

Head coach Mike Leaf is in his 12th season with the Warriors. While at Winona State, Leaf has posted a 306-105 record, including two National Championships in a three-year span.



Winona State is averaging 81.0 points a game, which is good for second in the conference. They are holding opponents to 69.2 points a contest, while shooting a conference-high 50.8 percent from the field and 44.1 percent from beyond the arc. The Warriors also lead the conference with 17.73 assists per game.

Individually, senior David Johnson is leading the conference with 19.8 points a game, while sophomore Jon Walburg is second in the conference in three-point field goal percentage at nearly 51 percent. Junior Ben Fischer is leading the conference with 7.67 assists per contest.

**THE MATCHUP:** The series between St. Cloud State and Winona State is one of the oldest rivalries in school history, with the Huskies coming out on top 89-of-35 games since the series started up during the 1922-23 season.

The Warriors won the most recently showdown, handing the Huskies their only home defeat this season in a 77-72 conference-opening loss.

The Huskies were up 56-45 with 13:13 to go in the game, but went cold as the Warriors went on a 20-6 run over the next five minutes to take its first lead of the half at 65-62 and carried the momentum to a victory.

Witt led the Huskies in scoring with 25 points, while dishing out seven assists, while Schneck recorded a double-double as he poured in 15 points and grabbed 14 rebounds.

The Huskies as a team shot 43 percent from the field on a 23-for-53 night, while shooting just 27 percent from beyond the arc after making 2-of-15 from the three point line in the second half.
