HUSKY HOMESTAND: The St. Cloud State men's basketball team (18-4, 12-3 NSIC) are home this week and will take on Southwest Minnesota State and No. 4 Minnesota State for a second time this season in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference.

The Huskies will try to earn a second win over Southwest Minnesota State this season with an 8 p.m. game on Friday in Halenbeck, before looking to revenge an earlier loss this season to the Mavericks in a 6 p.m. contest.

ROAD WARRIORS: St. Cloud State earned its second and third straight road win last weekend in beating Minnesota Duluth and Minnesota State University Moorhead for the second time this season. The Huskies beat Minnesota Duluth 83-68 and ended the weekend with a 107-71 win on Saturday over the Dragons.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have been 20-game winners six times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 255-116 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Game Notes

BLOCKING HISTORY: Junior Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph) is in second place on the all-time blocks list at St. Cloud State with 96 in his career. He passed Rado Rancik (1998-02) for the No. 2 spot after recording four blocks against Wayne State. Then a night later, Bernstetter set the single season school record with his 41st block of the year. He tied his career high with five blocks and is now at 44 on the season. Jon Hinzman (1994-98) is the leading shot blocker in school history with 115. Bernstetter is also second in the conference with 2.0 blocks a game. As a team, the Huskies own a school record with 110 blocks on the season passing the 2003-04 team that recorded 106.

DOUBLE DIGITS: Five players scored in double figures for the Huskies on Saturday night. Senior center Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) scored a game high 19 points and junior guard Taylor Witt (Morris) scored 16 points. Bernstetter knocked down 13 points, while freshman Tim Bergstraser (St. Cloud) scored 12 points and sophomore Theo Rothstein (St. Michael) added 10 points.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Huskies are coming home for four games straight starting this weekend and are 10-1 this season at home and have won eight straight at Halenbeck Hall.

LOOKING FOR 20: With a pair of wins this weekend, head coach Kevin Schlagel will earn his seventh 20-win season in his career at St. Cloud State. His season high for wins is 26 back during the 2002-03 season.

SCORING SURGE: St. Cloud State scored a season high 107 points against Bemidji State on Saturday afternoon. The Huskies also tied a season high in both field goals made (37) and three-pointers made (10) as a team. Schneck scored a career high 27 points against UMD, while making 13 free throws.

300 DIMES: On Friday night, Witt went over 100 assists on the season. He now has 111 this season and exactly 300 in his career after six assists in both games over the weekend. He is now 13th on the all-time assists list at St. Cloud State.

CHAIRMEN OF THE BOARDS: Schneck went over 200 rebounds on the season over the weekend and is currently No. 6 on the all-time rebounds list at St. Cloud State. He recorded 20 rebounds to his total over the weekend. He currently has 742 rebounds in his career and leads the conference with 10.4 per contest and overall rebounds with 219. Bernstetter is seventh in the conference with 6.8

rebounds a game.

Opponents Notes

ABOUT THE MUSTANGS: The Huskies are 32-16 against Southwest Minnesota State since the series started during the 1969-70 season. St. Cloud State broke a three game losing streak with the Mustangs after earning a 72-67 road win on Jan. 15.

The Mustangs are 13-8 overall this season, while going 8-7 in the NSIC. Southwest Minnesota State is a 11-2 at home this season, but are just 2-6 on the road and are coming off a 75-50 win over Minnesota, Crookston on Saturday night.

Head coach Brad Bigler is in his first season as the head coach at Southwest Minnesota State. He was named the head coach on Sept. 30 after 12 seasons as a player and assistant coach with the program.



The Mustangs are a defensive minded team, giving up a conference low 65.3 points a game, and are holding opponents to just 42 percent from the field. Teams are shooting just 32.4 percent from beyond the arc against Southwest Minnesota State and are blocking over three shots a game.

Offensively, the Mustangs are scoring 70 points a game, as an offensive unit. Southwest Minnesota State is aggressive on the offensive glass, leading the conference with 14.19 offensive rebounds a game and distribute the ball well with 15.50 assists per contest.

ABOUT THE NO. 4 MAVERICKS: St. Cloud State has played No. 4 Minnesota State more times than any other team in school history as 167 games between both squads have been played. The Huskies lead the all-time series that dates back to the 1923-24 season, 90-77, but lost the most recent contest 88-76 on Jan. 16. The Mavericks are 21-1 this season and are 14-1 in conference play after a pair of wins last weekend. Minnesota State will travel to University of Concordia-St. Paul Friday before coming to Halenbeck Hall Saturday.

Minnesota State is led by head coach Matt Margenthaler, who is in his ninth season as the bench leader for the Mavericks. He comes into the week with an 187-77 overall record with the Mavericks.



The Mavericks have four players scoring in double figures and are leading the conference with 89.1 points a game. Minnesota State has been dominating opponents by a +22 scoring margin. The Mavericks also lead the conference with 38.5 rebounds a game, while out rebounding opponents by 5.9 boards a contest. Junior Marcus Hill, who shot a perfect 6-of-6 from the field and 4-of-4 from the three-point line against the Huskies earlier in the season is second in the conference in three-point field goal percentage at 51.5 percent, while senior Jesse Clark leads the NSIC with a +3.80 assist to turn-over ratio.
