### ST. CLOUD STATE MEN'S BASKETBALL



**NSIC SEASON:** The St. Cloud State men's basketball team (10-2, 4-1 NSIC) will play Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference opponents for the remainder of the regular season after three non-conference games to close out 2009. The Huskies will be back at home this week for a pair of NSIC showdowns. On Friday, St. Cloud State will host the University of Minnesota Duluth in an 8 p.m. contest at Halenbeck Hall. The Huskies will then take on Bemidji State at 6 p.m. on Saturday at home.

**CONCORDIA UNIVERSITY:** St. Cloud State beat the Concordia University-St. Paul 89-80 on Saturday on the road to earn its fourth conference win.

**TAKE A KID TO THE GAME:** St. Cloud State will host its first NCAA men's and women's basketball "Take A Kid to the Game" day on Saturday, Jan. 9, when the Huskies host NSIC rival Bemidji State University at Halenbeck Hall. Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have been 20-game winners six times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 247-114 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Game Notes

**CHARITY STRIPE:** Junior guard Taylor Witt (Morris) tied a school record on Saturday when he made 16 free throws against Concordia University. He missed just two shots from the line, as the Huskies went on to make a season high 35 free throws on 44 attempts.

**DOUBLE DIGITS:** Witt has also scored in double figures in all 12 games this season and 20 straight games dating back to last season. He has not been held under 10 points since Feb. 13, 2009 against Southwest Minnesota State.

The Huskies as a team are beating opponents by 13.8 points a contest this season and are shooting nearly 49 percent from the field, while holding opponents to just 41 percent shooting.

**CONFERENCE LEADERS:** Senior Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) also leads the conference in field goal percentage at 67.3 percent a game. The Huskies have outscored its opponents 992-826 this season, while averaging the third highest scoring average in the conference at 82.7 points per contest. Witt is third in the conference with 18.3 points and 5.08 assists per game.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** St. Cloud State is now 3-0 away from Halenbeck Hall this season, earning road wins over Minnesota State University Moorhead, Minnesota, Crookston and Concordia University. The Huskies have not lost on the road since Feb. 14, 2009.

**CLOSING IN ON TOP 20:** Schneck moved to within 47 points of cracking the top 20 in all-time scoring in St. Cloud State history over the weekend. Schneck passed Dean Kesler (1990-92) for 23rd on the all-time scoring list on Saturday and is 33 points from moving past Jack Kelly (1954-58) for 22nd place as he sits at 1,174 points in his career.

**CLEANING THE CLASS:** Schneck is now 11th on the all-time rebounds list at St. Cloud State with 647. He surpassed Rado Rancik (1998-02) and Jeff Barott (1967-71) over the weekend in grabbing nine rebounds against Concordia University. He is just 11 rebounds from surpassing Izzy Schmeising for a place in the top 10. Schneck leads the conference with 11.3 per contest and offensive rebounds with 39.

Opponents Notes

**MINNESOTA DULUTH:** The Huskies are 45-30 against the Bulldogs since the series started back during the 1932-33 season. St. Cloud State lost to the Bulldogs in the first game between both squads last season 75-64 on the road. The Huskies bounced back in the second game, beating Minnesota Duluth 72-59 at Halenbeck.

The Bulldogs are 6-7 overall this season, while going 3-3 in the NSIC. Most recently, Minnesota Duluth lost to #24 Augustana College 73-58 at home on Saturday, after beating Wayne State 79-78 in double overtime the night before.

Head coach Gary Holquist has compiled an overall record of 181-155 since taking over the head coaching job in 1998. Holquist's offense is 12th in the conference, averaging 68.9 points a contest, but has the Bulldogs swatting 4.46 shots a game, which is good for second place in the conference behind the Huskies.



Senior Ron White is 13th in the conference and leads the team with 14.7 points per contest. He also leads the team and is fifth in the NSIC with 4.27 assists per game, while grabbing a team high 7.4 rebounds. The Bulldogs have been outscored 996-896 this season.

**BEMIDJI STATE:** The Beavers are one of St. Cloud State's oldest rivals, with the series dating back to the 1923-24 season. The Huskies lead the all-time series 88-38 after dropping a 69-66 contest to the Beavers last season, before taking care of business 69-51 at home.

The Beavers are 5-7 overall and are 2-4 in NSIC action this season after dropping its last four games. Bemidji State is coming off a 78-66 to Wayne State College at home on Sunday, but will play Concordia University before traveling to St. Cloud. The Beavers have not won a game since December 12, when they beat Winona State 88-87 in overtime.

Bemidji State is led by head coach Matt Bowen, who is in his fourth season as the bench leader. He comes into the week with a 24-70 overall record with the Beavers.



The Beavers have three players scoring in double figures and are seventh in the conference in scoring at 74.4 points a game. Bemidji State leads the conference in free throw percentage at nearly 76 percent. Senior Seth Haake leads the team with 17.4 points a game and 18 steals on the season. The Beavers have outscored opponents 893 to 873 this season.
