NSIC TOURNAMENT ACTION: The No. 16 ranked St. Cloud State men's basketball team (22-5, 16-4 NSIC) finished the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference regular season in second place and will now host No. 7-seeded Concordia University-St. Paul in the first round of the NSIC tournament at 7 p.m. Wednesday in Halenbeck Hall.

WINNING STEAK SNAPPED: St. Cloud State ended their nine-game winning streak with a loss to Winona State, as the Warriors beat the Huskies 80-69 Saturday night in Winona, Minn. It is the second time Winona State has beaten St. Cloud State this season.

THE REST OF THE FIELD: Minnesota State won the NSIC Championship and will host the No. 8 seed Southwest Minnesota State. No. 3 Augustana will host No. 6 Wayne State and No. 4 Winona State will be at home against No. 5 University of Mary.

Tiebreakers - Wayne State had the highest Strength of Schedule of the three teams tied for sixth place. Concordia-St. Paul defeated SMSU twice this season to win tiebreaker.



Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball.

He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 259-117 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Game Notes

BLOCKING HISTORY: Junior Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph) is in second place on the all-time blocks list at St. Cloud State with 106 in his career. Bernstetter set the single season school record with his 41st block of the year earlier this season and is now at 54 on the season. Jon Hinzman (1994-98) is the leading shot blocker in school history with 115. Bernstetter is also second in the NSIC with 2.00 blocks a game. As a team, the Huskies own a school record with 132 blocks on the season and lead the NSIC with 4.89 a contest.

HOME SWEET HOME: By earning a win over Minnesota, Crookston and Concordia-St. Paul, St. Cloud State ended the 2009-10 regular season with a 14-1 home record and are currently on a 12-game winning streak at Halenbeck Hall.

GOING STREAKING: During the regular season, St. Cloud State put together a 10-game winning streak and followed it with a nine-game streak before a loss to Winona State.

JOINING THE CENTURY MARK: Coming into Saturday's game with Winona State, junior Taylor Witt (Morris) needed just one point to become the 34th player in school history to score 1,000 points. He ended the game with 23 points and is now No. 29 on the all-time scoring list.

NATIONALLY RANKED: Senior captain Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) is 10th in the country in rebounding with 10.5 per game and 19th in field goal percentage at 62.5 percent. Bernstetter is 30th in blocks with 2.00 a game and Witt is 53rd in assists with 4.85 per contest. As a team the Huskies are 14th in blocked shots and 27th in highest scoring margin over opponents.

DROPPING DIMES: Witt is now No. 11 on the St. Cloud State all-time assists list after dishing out eight assists against Winona State. He now has 320 in his career and is 13 from moving past his brother Forest Witt (1998-03) who recorded 332 in his career for the No. 10 spot.

OWNING THE GLASS: Schneck is No. 5 on the all-time rebounds list at St. Cloud State. He now has 795 rebounds in his career and is just 10 rebounds from passing Jon Hinzman (1994-98) for the No. 4 spot. He also leads the conference with 10.5 per contest and overall rebounds with 272.

Bernstetter is seventh in the conference with 6.6 rebounds a game. As a team, the Huskies are third in the conference with 37.7 rebounds a game and are 28th in the country with a +5.0 rebounding margin over opponents.

Opponents Notes

ABOUT THE GOLDEN BEARS: The Golden Bears finished the regular season in fifth place in the NSIC after finishing the year 13-14 overall, while going 10-10 in conference play. Concordia-St. Paul is coming off three straight losses including an 80-77 loss to Upper Iowa on the road to close out the regular season.

The Golden Bears are 8-6 at home this season and finished 5-5 on the road during regular season play.

Concordia-St. Paul is led by head coach Kelly Boe, who is in his fourth season as the bench leader for the Golden Bears. He comes into the week with a 63-48 overall record with the Concordia-St. Paul.



As a team, the Golden Bears are fifth in the conference with a 78.4 points per game average and are giving up 77.1 points a game to opponents. They also are fifth in field goal percentage at 48.0 percent, while shooting 38 percent from beyond the arc.

Senior Craig Heiman is leading the team with 15.7 points a game and three pointers made with 58 this season. Two other Concordia-St. Paul players are scoring in double digits this season. Freshman Isaiah Thomas is shooting 52.6 percent from beyond the arc this season, which is a conference best.

THE MATCHUP: St. Cloud State is 12-2 in a 10-year history with Concordia University-St. Paul and have won five straight in the series, including two wins this season over the Golden Bears.

Concordia-St. Paul has not beaten St. Cloud State since earning a 61-57 home win on December 30, 2007.

The Huskies beat the Golden Bears 89-80 on the road earlier this season as Witt dropped 26 points and dished out six assists in the win.

In the second game between both squads, Witt again had a big game scoring 18 points and dishing out five assists to help the No. 16 Huskies to a 12th straight home victory with an 83-71 win Wednesday night.

Schneck led all players with his 15th double-double of the season with 27 points and 11 rebounds in Wednesday's win.
