ST. CLOUD STATE MEN'S BASKETBALL



TOURNAMENT TIME: The No. 16 nationally ranked St. Cloud State men's basketball team (25-5) will be the #4 seed in the Central Region and will play #5 seed Metro State (24-6) in Mankato on Saturday, March 13 at 8:30 p.m. The tournament runs Saturday, Sunday, and Tuesday, March 13, 14 and 16. Minnesota State University, Mankato (24-4) is the #1 seed and will host the tournament. The Central Region tournament features four Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) teams and four Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) teams.

BACK-TO-BACK CHAMPIONS: The Huskies won their second straight NSIC tournament championship with a 68-67 win over Southwest Minnesota State Sunday in Halenbeck Hall. Down one point with 2.3 seconds to go in the game, junior captain Taylor Witt (Morris) buried two free throws to claim the title before causing a Mustang turnover on the ensuing inbounds pass.

TICKET INFORMATION: Tickets for the Central Regional tournament can be purchased in advance or on the day of the event. Tickets are \$15 for reserved general admission, \$10 for adults and \$5 for youth (ages 5-17), senior citizens and college students with school identification. The ticket office and pass gates will open 90 minutes prior to the start of the first game of each daily session and the arena will open 60 minutes prior to the scheduled start of each game. There will be no advance ticket sales by phone for the tournament. Instead, fans may order tickets online at www.msumavericktickets.com beginning Monday, March 8 at 12:00pm. Tickets ordered online will not be mailed and can be picked up at the "Will Call" window of Taylor Center on game day. Online ticket availability will close at 9:00pm the day prior to each session.

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 262-117 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Game Notes

NSIC AWARDS: Senior captain Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) was voted the 2009-10 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Player of the Year and both Schneck and junior captain Taylor Witt (Morris) were named First Team All-NSIC. Schneck was then named NSIC Tournament Most Valuable Player on Sunday. Both Schneck and Witt were named to the NSIC All-Tournament team.

BLOCKING HISTORY: Junior Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph) is in second place on the all-time blocks list at St. Cloud State with 114 in his career. Bernstetter set the single season school record with his 41st block of the year earlier this season and is now at 62 on the season. Jon Hinzman (1994-98) is the leading shot blocker in school history with 115. Bernstetter is also finished the regular season second in the NSIC with 2.00 blocks a game. As a team, the Huskies own a school record with 146 blocks on the season and led the NSIC with 4.89 a contest.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Huskies will go into next season with a 15-game home winning streak. They finished the season 17-1 in Halenbeck Hall.

DROPPING DIMES: Witt is now No. 10 on the St. Cloud State all-time assists list after dishing out 10 assists in the

semifinal round of the tournament. He currently has 341 in his career.

800 CLUB: Schneck became the fifth player in school history to record 800 rebounds in his career. He is moved past Jon Hinzman (1994-98) for the No. 4 spot regular season finale. Schneck has 835 rebounds in his career and led the conference with 10.5 per contest and overall rebounds with 272 during the regular season.

WINS ADDING UP: In sweeping the NSIC tournament, the Huskies became the sixth team in school history to win 25 games. The school record for wins is 26, which has been accomplished three times. It's also the third time a Kevin Schlagel coached team has recorded 25 or more wins in a season.

REGIONAL PLAY: The Huskies will make their second straight regional appearance, 12th overall and fourth appearance in the last five seasons. Last year, the Huskies entered the tournament as the #2 seed and lost to #7 seed Augustana College on a buzzer beater in the quarterfinals. St. Cloud State is 7-12 all-time in NCAA region tournament games. The 1986-87 Huskies are the only team to advance out of regional play. Under a different format, the Huskies defeated Lock Haven and Ferris State to win the North

Central Region. In the quarterfinal round of the NCAA tournament, Huskies lost 78-73 in overtime to Delta State.

NCAA Central Regional Tournament Notes

ABOUT THE NO. 5 SEEDED ROADRUNNERS: The No. 21 nationally ranked Metro State Roadrunners are 24-6 overall this season and put together a 14-5 record in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC).

The Roadrunners are coming off an 83-79 win in the RMAC tournament championship game and have now won five straight games. Metro State is 10-1 in non-conference games this season and have posted a 4-0 record on neutral courts.

Brannon Hays is in his fourth season as the head coach at Metro State, where he has put together a 98-26 record with the Roadrunners.



Metro State has a balanced scoring attack with four players scoring in double figures this season. Junior guard Donte Nicholas leads the team with nearly 18 points a game, while tying for the team lead with 6.1 rebounds a contest. Junior guard A.J. Flourney also is averaging 6.1 rebounds a game.

The Roadrunners were fourth in the RMAC with 77.5 points a game while holding opponents to 68.1 points per 40 minutes. Metro State is grabbing 36.4 rebounds a game and are very active on the offensive boards with 438 this season. Senior guard Brian Minor is leading the team with 114 assists and 78 steals, while making 29 three-pointers.

MATCHUP WITH THE ROADRUNNERS: St. Cloud State and Metro State will play each other for the fifth time since the 1994-95 season Saturday in Mankato, Minn.

The Huskies hold a 3-1 advantage in the series, including a 1-1 record in regional tournament games.

They last met in NCAA tournament play in the 2002-03 North Central Region semifinals, with Metro State winning 75-63.

In the 2000-01, the North Central Region tournament was held in St. Cloud, as the Huskies opened the tournament with a 100-61 win over the Roadrunners.

St. Cloud State and Metro State last met in the 2008-09 season opener in St. Cloud, with the Huskies coming out on top 82-71.
