## ST. CLOUD STATE MEN'S BASKETBALL



**HUSKIES HOST A PAIR OF NSIC GAMES:** The Husky men's basketball team (6-7, 5-4 NSIC) will close out a four-game homestand this weekend with two crucial Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference games. The Huskies will first host Bemidji State University at 8 p.m. Friday evening following the women's game at Halenbeck Hall. SCSU will then take on the University of Minnesota Duluth at 6 p.m. Saturday night.

**SCSU GOES 1-1 AT HOME:** St. Cloud State went 1-1 in two NSIC home games. Behind a career performance from senior Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph), the Huskies were able to earn a 76-68 come from behind win over Upper Iowa University Saturday. SCSU then lost 93-91 on a last second shot in overtime to No. 24 Winona State University Sunday night.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball. Schlagel and his squad are coming off the most successful season in school history after going 29-6 in 2009-10 to earn a trip to the NCAA Final Four in Springfield, Mass.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times. Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 266-118 overall record.

Schlagel's squads have went on to win the NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship in 2009 and 2010, to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Weekly Notes

**BEYOND THE ARC:** SCSU made a season high 16 three-pointers Sunday to make it an even 100 on the season. The Huskies are third in the league with 7.69 per contest. Junior **Brett Putz** (Forest City, Iowa) is fifth in the NSIC with 33 made three's.

**CLOSING IN ON THE TOP 10:** Senior captain **Taylor Witt** (Morris) is No. 14 on the all-time scoring list at SCSU with 1,423 points after scoring 43 points this weekend. Witt is now 12 points from passing Haug Scharnowski (1989-94) for the No. 13 spot and is 64 points from the top 10. Witt has also scored in double digits in 12 of 13 games and has scored more than 20 points in six games.

**NEARLY PERFECT:** Witt has made 53 of 57 free throws this season (93%) and has made 42 straight dating back to the first half of a game against U-Mary on Dec. 3. His season best is 11-for-11 against Minnesota State Dec. 11. He is eight made free throws from tying Dave Dreas (04-08), who made 50 straight in 2005-05. Witt is sixth on the all-time list at SCSU with 377 in his career.

**NSIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Senior captain **Andrew Bernstetter** (St. Joseph) was named NSIC Player of the Week after having a career-weekend for the Huskies, scoring 64 total points on a 23-for-37 weekend of shooting (62 percent). In two games, Bernstetter's scoring average went from 11.3 to 15.4 and he is now second on the squad in scoring and leads the team with four double-doubles this season, while posting 8.7 rebounds a contest. Bernstetter started the weekend with a career-high 35-point performance in a 76-68 win over Upper Iowa. His previous career-high was 20 and with the performance. He then scored 29 against Winona State Sunday.

**STACKING UP THE MINUTES:** Putz and Witt are tied for second in the conference with 458 total minutes played and 35.23 per contest. They are the only SCSU players to start and play in every game.

**TAKING CARE OF THE ROCK:** The Huskies tied a season best in both games this weekend with a +13 assist to turnover ratio with 18 assists

Saturday and 21 on Sunday. Witt recorded a team best +7 ration Sunday against Winona State with nine assists and just two turnovers. The Huskies are leading the conference with 207 assists this season while averaging 15.92 a contest.

**THE DISTRIBUTOR:** Witt recorded 15 assists over the weekend to remain in the No. 6 spot on the all-time assist chart. Witt recorded a season-high nine against Winona State and will start the week with 418 assists in his career and nine assists from passing Dusty Wabiszewski (05-08) who recorded 427 in his career. He currently leads the team with 4.8 assists per game and has posted two or more in every game this season.

NSIC Opponent Notes

**BEMIDJI STATE UNIVERSITY:** The Huskies and Beavers have battled through 130 total games since the 1924 season, with SCSU coming out on top in 90 of those games. SCSU has also won 16 of the last 17 games.

St. Cloud State has won three straight games against BSU including two last season. The Huskies beat Bemidji State 107-71 in their last meeting in 2010.

Bemidji State comes into the weekend with a 7-6 overall record, while going 4-5 in the conference. The Beavers have posted a 4-2 road record and are coming off a 63-53 win over Wayne State Sunday.

Bemidji State is led by head coach Matt Bowen, who is in his fifth season with the Beavers. He comes into the week with a 38-84 overall record



The Beavers are averaging 77.2 points a contest and are giving up 73.1 points.

BSU has four players scoring in double figures this season as junior James Ellisor leads the team with 17.2 a contest, while recording a team-high 89 rebounds.

Senior Pat Cassidy is second on the team with 12.2 points a game, while junior Bryce Tesdahl averaging 11 points and leads the team with 76 assists.

Sophomore Mason Walters rounds out the top scorers with 10.5 points in 20 minutes of playing time a night.

**MINNESOTA DULUTH:** In 77 seasons, the Huskies have won 48 of 77 games against UMD, including both games last season. Similar to Bemidji, SCSU has won 15 of the last 16 games against the Bulldogs.

SCSU earned an 83-68 victory in their last meeting on the road in 2010.

The Bulldogs are 7-6 overall this season and are 5-4 in NSIC action. Minnesota Duluth is coming off a 76-49 loss to Augustana and will play Concordia-St. Paul before coming to St. Cloud.

Head coach Gary Holquist is in his 14th season as the bench leader for the Bulldogs and enters the week with 189-174 record. He has his team at 1-2 on the road this season.



The Bulldogs have played opponents close this season, averaging 71.9 points a game and grabbing 35.5 rebounds. They are giving up 73.1 points and 35.0 rebounds a contest.

UMD has two backcourt players scoring in double figures with junior Ryan Rasmussen averaging 18.4 a contest, while making 35 shots from beyond the arc. He is second on the team with 40 assists and is pulling down 3.8 rebounds a game.

Sophomore Jake Hottenstine is second on the team with 13.8 points a contest and leads the squad with 70 total rebounds.
