### ST. CLOUD STATE MEN'S BASKETBALL



**BACK IN HALENBECK HALL:** The Husky men's basketball team (5-6, 4-3 NSIC) will begin a four-game homestand this weekend with a pair of Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference games.

Due to schedule changes, SCSU will start the weekend with a 4 p.m. home game Saturday afternoon against Upper Iowa University and will close out the weekend with a 5 p.m. game Sunday evening against No. 24 Winona State University.

**HUSKIES SPLIT ROAD TRIP:** St. Cloud State went 1-1 in NSIC road action earlier this week after defeating Augustana College 76-74 Monday and losing to Wayne State College 69-53 Tuesday night.

In Monday's game Josh Ortmann (Buffalo) made both free throws in the final 14 seconds to help SCSU earn a crucial road win over Augie. Tuesday night Wayne State spoiled St. Cloud State's attempt to gain a road sweep in the NSIC with a strong second half effort in which the Wildcats led by as many as 20 and forced 23 Husky turnovers.

**Head Coach Kevin Schlagel**

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball. Schlagel and his squad are coming off the most successful season in school history after going 29-6 in 2009-10 to earn a trip to the NCAA Final Four in Springfield, Mass.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times. Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 266-118 overall record.

Schlagel's squads have went on to win the NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship in 2009 and 2010, to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Weekly Notes

**CLOSING IN ON THE TOP 10:** Senior captain **Taylor Witt** (Morris) is now No. 14 on the all-time scoring list at SCSU with 1,380 points after scoring 41 points during the recent two game road trip. He passed Kevin Catron (1984-86), who finished his career with 1,342 points. Witt is now 54 points from passing Haug Scharnowski (1989-94) for the No. 13 spot and is 118 points from the top 10. Witt has also scored in double digits in 10 of 11 games and has scored more than 20 points in five games.

**THREE STRAIGHT DOUBLE-DOUBLES:** Senior captain **Andrew Bernstetter** (St. Joseph) recorded three consecutive double-doubles after posting 15 points and 12 rebounds against Augustana Monday. He had 12 points and a career-high 15 rebounds against CSP and in the previous game against MSU he had 16 points and 11 rebounds. His streak was snapped against Wayne State when he posted 10 points, five rebounds and five assists. Witt had the team's first double-double of the season against U-Mary with 27 points and a career-high 10 rebounds.

**MR. DIME:** Witt recorded seven assists over the weekend to remain in the No. 6 spot on the all-time assist chart. With his fourth assist in Monday's game against Augustana, Witt recorded the 400th assist of his career. He will start the four game home stand with 403 assists in his career and 24 assists from passing Dusty Wabiszewski (05-08) who recorded 427 in his career. He currently leads the team with 4.4 assists per game and has posted two or more in every game this season.

**A GANG OF THEIVES:** SCSU recorded a season-high 15 steals against Wayne State Tuesday night. Bernstetter also recorded a season-high with five steals of his own to lead the team. Witt recorded his

100th career steal against Mankato earlier this season and is currently 16th on the all-time steals list at SCSU with 103.

**SECOND HALF SCORERS:** St. Cloud State has scored 432 second half points this season, compared to 354 in the first half.

**STARTING A NEW STREAK:** The Huskies will hope to start a new home game winning streak this weekend after having their 18-game home winning streak snapped with a 73-66 loss to Concordia- St. Paul Dec. 18. It was their first loss at home since Dec. 4, 2009 when they dropped a 77-72 contest with Winona State.

**IT DOESN'T GET MUCH CLOSER:** The Huskies have been out-scored 795 to 797 this season. They have finished three games this season that were decided by two points and have won all three. Tuesday's loss to Wayne State was the largest losing margin for the Huskies in 2010-11.

NSIC Opponent Notes

**UPPER IOWA UNIVERSITY:** The Peacocks and Huskies have battled in just 10 games against each other dating back to 1952. Upper Iowa won the opening game of the series and have dropped nine straight, including an 80-65 contest last season.

The Huskies have won eight of the nine games by more than 10 points and recorded the biggest win of the series in 2005 with an 80-56 win.

Upper Iowa comes into the weekend with a 4-7 overall record, while going 3-3 in the conference. The Peacocks are 1-3 on the road this season and are coming off a 65-56 loss to the University of Mary.

Upper Iowa is led by head coach Brian Dolan who is in his fifth season with the squad. Dolan has posted a 34-93 overall record during that span.



The Peacocks are averaging 68.6 points a contest and are giving up 72.5 points, which is the same amount SCSU is rendering to their opponents this season.

Senior guard Matt Lesan leads the team with 13.1 points a game and 19 steals on the season. He has also played in a team-high 341 total minutes.

Senior Dan Bestul is second on the team with 13 points a game and sophomore Tucker Wentzien rounds out the top scorers with 10.5 a contest. Wentzien also leads the team with 5.5 rebounds a game.

**WINONA STATE UNIVERSITY:** The Huskies have dominated the 126-game series with 90 wins in 88 seasons, but No. 24 Winona State has earned a pair of wins in the last two games between both squads.

The Huskies lost 77-72 to the Warriors at home last season and dropped an 80-69 contest to Winona in the final game of the 2009-10 regular season.

The Warriors are 8-2 overall this season and are 4-2 in NSIC action. Winona State is coming off an 84-50 win over SMSU and will play Concordia-St. Paul before coming to Halenbeck.

Head coach Mike Leaf is in his 13th season as the bench leader for the Warriors and enters the week with 278-110 record. Leaf and company has recorded a 3-1 road record this season.



The Warriors are scoring 80.2 points a game, while grabbing 37.9 rebounds. WSU is holding opponents to just 69.2 points a contest.

Winona State has two players scoring in double figures, as junior Anthony Tucker leads the team with 19 points a game. Tucker has made a team-high 62 field goals with half coming in the form of a three point basket. Sophomore Clayton Vette is second with 13.3 a contest, while leading the team with 6.7 rebounds a game.

Senior Ben Fischer is averaging 9.7 points and leads the team with 48 assists from his guard position.
