HUSKIES KICK OFF SEASON WITH FUTURE NSIC OPPONENT: The St. Cloud State men's basketball team will kick off the 2010-11 season with a matchup against a future Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference opponent in the University of Sioux Falls. The game time is set for 4:00 p.m., Sunday, November 13 in Halenbeck Hall. The Cougars will compete in conference play starting in 2012-13.

HANGING IN HALENBECK: St. Cloud State kicks off the season with six straight home games at Halenbeck Hall, including the first two conference games of the season December 2 and 3.

NSIC PRESEASON POLL: The Huskies were picked to finish in sixth place in the NSIC Preseason Coaches Poll after receiving 108 votes. Augustana was picked to win the conference after receiving 164 points and nine first place votes.

RADIO: All St. Cloud State men's basketball games can be heard on Uptown 1010 AM radio with JW Cocks as the play-by play announcer all season long for the Huskies.

HEAD COACH KEVIN SCHLAGEL



Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball. Schlagel and his squad are coming off a 15-14 overall season in 2010-11 and finished sixth in the conference with a 12-10 record.

He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times. Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 282-132 overall record.

Schlagel's squads have went on to win the NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship in 2009 and 2010, to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament. During the 2009-10 season, his squad wond the NSIC Tournament, the Regional Tournament and finished out the season with a loss in the final four in Springfield, Mass. The team finished the season with a school record 29 wins.

2011-12 ASSISTANT COACHES



Matt Reimer is entering his 14th season as a full-time assistant coach for the Huskies and serves as the recruiting coordinator and director of operations and player personnel. Reimer also served for two seasons as a graduate assistant coach under Butch Raymond in 1995-96 and 1996-97, bringing his overall experience with the Huskies to 16 seasons.



Dan DeWitt begins his first season as an assistant coach for the Huskies in 2011. DeWitt played collegiate basketball at Northern State University under former Coach Don Meyer, the current NCAA all-time wins leader. In four years at Northern State, DeWitt helped his team accumulate a record of 98-27.



Jon Roesch is in his first season as a volunteer assistant coach for the SCSU in 2011. Roesch comes to St. Cloud with 19 years of teaching high school mathematics, while coaching high school basketball four 14 of those seasons. He spent four years as the head men's coach at Montgomery-Lonsdale High School before moving on to take the head coaching position at Sauk Rapids for 10 seasons.

QUICK 2011-12 NOTES

A PROGRAM RICH IN HISTORY: Sunday's game against the University of Sioux Falls will officially kick off the 88th season of men's basketball at St. Cloud State. Current head coach Kevin Schlagel and the entire basketball program comes into the season with a 1,215-756 all-time record.

SENIOR CAPTAIN: Senior **Brett Putz** (Forest City, Iowa) is the Huskies' only team captain in 2011-12. Putz has played in all 95 games of his collegiate career and was a starter in 63 games. Last season he started 28 games and averaged 12.1 points. He is a 42.8 percent field goal shooter, 42.3 percent from beyond the

arc and 83.2 percent from the free throw line. Putz is the top returning scorer for the Huskies and last year made a career high seven three-point baskets against Cal. State-Dominguez Hills on Nov. 19. He has scored 971 points in his Husky career and ranks seventh on the all-time three-point baskets made list with 183.

MAKING UP FOR LOST TIME: Junior **Theo Rothstein** (St. Michael) and sophomore **Tim Bergstraser** (St. Cloud) will both be returning to the lineup after sitting out with injuries a year ago. Both players played a crucial role in the Huskies' 2009-10 run to the NCAA Final Four in Springfield, Mass.

FRESH FACES: There are eight players on the 2011-12 roster that have never posted playing time for the Huskies. Sophomore **Darius Cruz** (Robbinsdale) will be playing in his second season of NSIC action, after playing his freshman season at the University of Minnesota, Crookston, where he averaged over 17 points a game.

STARTING A NEW STREAK: The Huskies lost to St. John's 70-65 in last season's opener to snap a opening game win streak that dated back to the 1983-84 season. SCSU has a chance to start a new winning streak Sunday.

QUICK NOTES ON THE UNIVERSITY OF SIOUX FALLS

RECORD WITH THE COUGARS: The Huskies are 4-1 all-time against the University of Sioux Falls since the series began during the 1986-87 season. SCSU has won the last two contests between both squads after beating the Cougars 78-46 at Halenbeck Hall Decemeber 29, 2009.

USF HEAD COACH: The Cougars are led by head coach Chris Johnson (Bloomington), who starts his fourth season with the program. Johnson posted a 24-win season last year and has brought his team to the NAIA National Tournament in all three of his seasons at USF. He has an overall record of 69-35 with the program after going 24-9 last season.



THE COUGARS IN 2010-11: USF averaged 76.6 points a game a season-ago, while allowing opponents 70.1 a contest. The Cougars also outrebounded their opponents 35.7 to 33.0 a game.

Junior forward David Maxwell is the top-returning scorer for the Cougars after finishing third on the team with 11.3 points a game a season ago. He also started in 31 of the 33 games and participated in 32.

Maxwell was second on the squad in 2010-11 with 154 total rebounds, while posted 44 assists and 31 steals.

Senior center Skyler Bloch returns for his final season after averaging 7.9 points and 4.1 rebounds a game last season. He played in 31 games and started in 26 for the Cougars. Bloch is also the only senior on the USF roster.

Sophomore guard Derek Brown is the only player on the team that played in all 33 games last season, but started just three in 382 minutes of action.
