St. Cloud will first take on Minnesota State University Mankato at 8:00 p.m. Friday night before hosting Southwest Minnesota State University at 6:00 p.m. Saturday.

HEAD COACH KEVIN SCHLAGEL



Kevin Schlager has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball. Schlager and his squad are coming off a 15-14 overall season in 2010-11 and finished sixth in the conference with a 12-10 record.

He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlager's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times. Since Schlager was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 282-132 overall record.

Schlager's squads have went on to win the NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship in 2009 and 2010, to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament. During the 2009-10 season, his squad won the NSIC Tournament, the Regional Tournament and finished out the season with a loss in the final four in Springfield, Mass. The team finished the season with a school record 29 wins.

2011-12 ASSISTANT COACHES



Matt Reimer is in his 15th season as a full-time assistant coach for the Huskies and serves as the recruiting coordinator and director of operations and player personnel. Reimer also served for two seasons as a grad. assistant coach under Butch Raymond in 1995-96 and 1996-97, bringing his overall experience with the Huskies to 17 seasons.



Dan DeWitt is in his first season as an assistant coach for the Huskies in 2011. DeWitt played collegiate basketball at Northern State University under former Coach Don Meyer, the current NCAA all-time wins leader. In four years at Northern State, DeWitt helped his team accumulate a record of 98-27.



Jon Roesch is in his first season as a volunteer assistant coach for the SCSU in 2011. Roesch comes to St. Cloud with 19 years of teaching high school mathematics, while coaching high school basketball four 14 of those seasons. He spent four years as the head men's coach at Montgomery-Lonsdale High School before moving on to take the head coaching position at Sauk Rapids for 10 seasons.

SCSU QUICK NOTES

TOP THREE THREAT: Senior captain **Brett Putz** (Forest City, Iowa) is now tied for fourth on the SCSU three-point baskets made list with 222. He tied Joel McDonald with his second three against Winona State. He is also currently in the No. 25 spot on the all-time SCSU scoring list with 1,200 points. Putz is now 17 three's from passing Forest Witt for second place. He is also fourth on the all-time three-point field goals attempted list with 538 and is 16th on the 3-point field goal percentage list (.413). Putz leads the team and is fifth in the NSIC with 39 made three's this season.

A PAIR OF 24'S: Junior guard **Shaun Jensen** (Spring Lake Park) and sophomore center **Tim Bergstraser** (St. Cloud) both set career-high's with 24 points a piece in their respected games. Jensen scored 24 against Winona State after setting a team season-high with 10 field goals made and 19 field goals attempted. He also tied his career-high with eight assists. Bergstraser scored 24 points on a solid 8-for-12 night from the field, while making eight of nine from the charity stripe.

SIMILAR FINISHES: The Huskies lost to Winona State by 10 points for the second time this season. SCSU then beat Upper Iowa in the closing minutes Saturday night, after beating the Peacocks 74-68 in overtime earlier this season.

IRON MAN: Jensen has played in a team-high 677 minutes this season and is coming off playing all 40 minutes against Winona State and 38 against Upper Iowa. He is ninth in the conference with a 31.95 minutes played average this season.

PICKING POCKETS: Putz had four steals this weekend, including three against Winona State. He leads the team and is third in the conference with 36 steals. Putz is averaging 1.71 per contest.

HOME WIN STREAK ENDS: SCSU had its 10-game home winning streak come to an end with the 84-74 loss to Winona State Saturday. The Huskies nearly went an entire season without losing at home.

CLOSING IN ON 300: Head coach **Kevin Schlagel** is just two wins from his 300th at SCSU. He has already broke his win total from a season ago. Schlagel has had double-digit win totals in all 15 seasons as the head coach and has only one season with less than 15 wins, after winning a career-low 14 games in his second season. The Huskies had their best season in school history (29-6) in 2009-10 under Schlagel and the program's only Final Four appearance.

NATIONALLY RANKED: The Huskies have been ranked in the Nation Association of Basketball Coaches Poll for five straight weeks after being ranked No. 21 on January 20th. SCSU was as high a No. 13 in the country.

NORTHERN SUN INTERCOLLEGIATE CONFERENCE OPPONENT QUICK NOTES

SCSU VS. MSU ALL-TIME: The Huskies are 94-78 all-time against the Mavericks since first competing during the 1923-24 season. SCSU has played MSU a school-record 172 times and is coming off a very tight 77-75 win over the Mavericks December 10 in Mankato.

MEET MSU'S HEAD COACH: Matt Margenthaler is in his 10th season with the Mavericks, where he has posted a 226-100 overall record. His squad is coming off a school-record 28-win season and a Final Four appearance in 2010-11.



SCSU VS. SMSU ALL-TIME: The Huskies are 35-18 in 52 meetings with the Mustangs since the 1969-70 season. SMSU handed the Huskies their first loss of the season in an 85-81 road loss December 9th. The Huskies have now lost two in a row to SMSU.

MEET SMSU'S HEAD COACH: Brad Bigler is in his third season at SMSU after taking over as the interim coach in 2009. Bigler has a 41-34 overall record heading into the weekend as the head coach after going 17-12 last season.



THE MAVERICKS IN 2011-12: Minnesota State is 7-14 overall this season and 10th in the conference with a 6-11 record. The Mavericks are being outscored 68.7 points to 73.4 a game this season and are outrebounding opponents by a narrow 33.9 to 33.1. Minnesota State has a balanced attack offensively with four players scoring in double-figures and seven players with an average of seven points a game or higher. The Mavericks also have four players with over 75 field goals.

Senior Stephen Kirschbaum is leading the team with 12.1 points a game and 39 total made three point field goals this season. Sophomore Connor O'Brien is leading the team with 7.7 rebounds a game, while posting 10.8 points a contest. Sophomore Jimmy Whitehead leads the team with 65 assists this season and is third in scoring with 11.0 a contest.

THE MUSTANGS IN 2011-12: SMSU is 12-9 overall this season and in 5th place in the NSIC with an 11-6 record. The Mustangs are averaging 74.1 points a game, while allowing opponents 71.7. SMSU is being outrebounded this season by a slim 0.5 margin at 31.9 to 32.4 a game.

Junior Jordan Miller leads the team with 13.7 points a game and made three's with 38. He is also second on the team with 54 assists while grabbing 4.8 rebounds a game. Sophomore Nick Smith leads the team with 5.8 rebounds a game and 35 total blocks. Smith is second on the team with 11.2 points a game. The Mustangs have four players who have made all 21 starts this season and have eight players that have made an appearance in all 21 contests.
