HUSKIES REMAIN ON ROAD: The Huskies (11-2, 7-2 NSIC) will continue their longest road stretch of the season as they first travel to Bemidji State University, Friday, January 13. The game time is set for 8:00 p.m. SCSU will then have a 6:00 p.m. contest against the University of Minnesota Duluth Saturday evening to round out the weekend.

WEEKEND ROAD SPLIT: St. Cloud State split road NSIC games this weekend, beating Upper Iowa University 74-68 in overtime Saturday before losing to #10 Winona State, 87-77 Sunday night. The Huskies are now 3-2 on the road in the NSIC this season.

HEAD COACH KEVIN SCHLAGEL



Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball. Schlagel and his squad are coming off a 15-14 overall season in 2010-11 and finished sixth in the conference with a 12-10 record.

He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times. Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 282-132 overall record.

Schlagel's squads have went on to win the NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship in 2009 and 2010, to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament. During the 2009-10 season, his squad won the NSIC Tournament, the Regional Tournament and finished out the season with a loss in the final four in Springfield, Mass. The team finished the season with a school record 29 wins.

Matt Reimer is in his 15th season as a full-time assistant coach for the Huskies and serves as the recruiting coordinator and director of operations and player personnel. Reimer also served for two seasons as a grad. assistant coach under Butch Raymond in 1995-96 and 1996-97, bringing his overall experience with the Huskies to 17 seasons.



Dan DeWitt is in his first season as an assistant coach for the Huskies in 2011. DeWitt played collegiate basketball at Northern State University under former Coach Don Meyer, the current NCAA all-time wins leader. In four years at Northern State, DeWitt helped his team accumulate a record of 98-27.



Jon Roesch is in his first season as a volunteer assistant coach for the SCSU in 2011. Roesch comes to St. Cloud with 19 years of teaching high school mathematics, while coaching high school basketball four 14 of those seasons. He spent four years as the head men's coach at Montgomery-Lonsdale High School before moving on to take the head coaching position at Sauk Rapids for 10 seasons.

SCSU QUICK NOTES

PUTTING IN THE TIME: Junior **Shaun Jensen** (Spring Lake Park) and sophomore **Tim Bergstraser** (St. Cloud) both played 73 minutes a piece in both games last weekend. Jensen leads the team with 410 total minutes played this season, while Bergstraser has played in 403. Jensen played in all 45 minutes of the overtime win over Upper Iowa, while Bergstraser played in 38 minutes, before playing 35 against No. 10 Winona State.

SHARP PLAY FROM THE SENIOR: Senior captain **Brett Putz** (Forest City, Iowa) had five assists and no turnovers against Upper Iowa. It is the best individual assist-to-turnover difference this season in a single game, tying Jensen who did it earlier in the season.

FRESHMAN FORCE: First-year big man **Connor Niehaus** (Fremont, Neb.) has scored in double figures in four straight games after scoring 12 points against Upper Iowa and 14 against Winona State. His seven rebounds against the Peacocks equaled his season-high. He is now third on the team with 57 rebounds and in made three's with 14.

OVER THE CENTURY MARK: Bergstraser posted six rebounds against Upper Iowa and nine rebounds against Winona State to go over 100 on the season. He has a team-leading 105 total rebounds this season and is averaging 8.1 a contest. He grabbed 100 total rebounds in his first season as a freshman in 34 games played in 2009-10.

OVERTIME SUCCESS IN THE NSIC: SCSU is 3-1 in overtime games since joining the NSIC back in 2008-09. Saturday's game was their first overtime contest of the season and for the first time since Jan. 14, 2011.

BENCH PLAY: Junior **Tony Brooks** (Rockford, Ill.) scored a career-high 14 points in just 15 minutes of action against Winona State. He was 6-for-8 from the field and 2-for-4 from beyond the arc, to go with three rebounds, three assists and a steal.

NSIC TEAM LEADERS: The Huskies are second in conference games with 79.4 points a contest while outscoring opponents by nearly nine points a game. SCSU also leads the league with a 78.2 free throw percentage (194-248), while holding its NSIC opponents to a league-low 43.7 percent shooting from the field. St. Cloud also leads the NSIC with a +3.22 turnover margin.

INDIVIDUAL NSIC LEADERS: Jensen leads the league with 5.44 assists per NSIC contest, while Putz is tops in free-throw percentage at 97.1 percent (33-34). Bergstraser leads the NSIC with 5.67 defensive rebounds a game and is second with 7.8 total rebounds per contest.

NORTHERN SUN INTERCOLLEGIATE CONFERENCE OPPONENT QUICK NOTES

SCSU VS. BEMIDJI STATE ALL-TIME: The Huskies are 91-38 all-time against the Beavers since the series started in 1923-24. The Huskies have won four straight against BSU after a 92-88 overtime win last season. SCSU has only played Minnesota State and Winona State more times since the program was started.



MEET BSU'S HEAD COACH: Matt Bowen is in his sixth season with the Beavers. His squad finished the 2010-11 season with an 11-15 overall record, while going 8-14 in the NSIC. He has a 53-97 overall career record coming into the weekend.

THE BEAVERS IN 2011-12: Bemidji State is 11-4 overall this season and 6-3 in the NSIC. All four of the Beavers' losses have come from nationally ranked teams, including No. 1-ranked Metro State. The Beavers are averaging 71.5 points a game, while holding opponents to just 63.2. BSU is also outrebounding their competition 33.8 to 29.7 per contest.

Bemidji State has two players scoring in double figures this season, as senior forward James Ellisor leads the team and NSIC with 20.9 per contest, while also grabbing a team-best 7.4 rebounds a game. Ellisor is also just one of two players to start all 15 games this season for BSU, as senior guard Bryce Tesdahl also has 15 starts. Tesdahl leads the team with 75 assists and is second in three pointers made with 18.

SCSU VS. MINNESOTA DULUTH ALL-TIME: St. Cloud State has played the Bulldogs 78 times since the 1932-33 season and are leading the overall series 48-30. The Huskies have won four straight games after beating UMD 94-74 last season.

MEET UMD'S HEAD COACH: Mike Leaf is in his 15th season as the head coach of the Bulldogs, where he is 192-184 overall after going 10-16 last season. UMD finished in a tie for 10th place in the NSIC with a record of 8-14 in 2010-11.



THE BULLDOGS IN 2011-12: Minnesota Duluth is 9-4 overall and is in a three-way tie for fourth place with a 6-3 record in the NSIC. The Bulldogs are averaging 81.0 points a game and are allowing opponents 77.8. They are also outrebounding opponents by a small 35.6-34.9 margin. UMD is shooting 40 percent from beyond the arc as a team, making 90 of 225 in 13 games this season.

Junior guard Jake Hottenstine is leading the team and is second in the NSIC with 18.5 points a game and also is grabbing a team-high 6.6 rebounds per contest. Hottenstine scored 31 points in his last game against Augustana and has a season-high of 37 that he posted in the season opener. Senior guard Ryan Rasmussen is right behind Hottenstine with 18.2 points a contest after making a team-leading 37 three pointers this season.
