HEAD COACH KEVIN SCHLAGEL



Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball. Schlagel and his squad are coming off a 15-14 overall season in 2010-11 and finished sixth in the conference with a 12-10 record.

He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times. Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 282-132 overall record.

Schlagel's squads have went on to win the NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship in 2009 and 2010, to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament. During the 2009-10 season, his squad won the NSIC Tournament, the Regional Tournament and finished out the season with a loss in the final four in Springfield, Mass. The team finished the season with a school record 29 wins.

2011-12 ASSISTANT COACHES



Matt Reimer is in his 15th season as a full-time assistant coach for the Huskies and serves as the recruiting coordinator and director of operations and player personnel. Reimer also served for two seasons as a grad. assistant coach under Butch Raymond in 1995-96 and 1996-97, bringing his overall experience with the Huskies to 17 seasons.



Dan DeWitt is in his first season as an assistant coach for the Huskies in 2011. DeWitt played collegiate basketball at Northern State University under former Coach Don Meyer, the current NCAA all-time wins leader. In four years at Northern State, DeWitt helped his team accumulate a record of 98-27.



Jon Roesch is in his first season as a volunteer assistant coach for the SCSU in 2011. Roesch comes to St. Cloud with 19 years of teaching high school mathematics, while coaching high school basketball four 14 of those seasons. He spent four years as the head men's coach at Montgomery-Lonsdale High School before moving on to take the head coaching position at Sauk Rapids for 10 seasons.

SCSU QUICK NOTES

ALL OVER THE GLASS: St. Cloud State grabbed a season-high 40 rebounds Friday and topped it by pulling down 47 Saturday night. Eleven different players had a rebound Saturday, as freshman **James Fort** (South Haven) led the team by grabbing a career-high eight.

MR. CLUTCH: With time running out, junior **Shaun Jensen** (Spring Lake Park) buried a jumper with two seconds remaining on the clock to take a 72-70 road win over BSU. The Beavers tied the game up at 70-70 with 15 seconds remaining before Jensen ended the game with his fourth and most crucial field goal of the night. He finished with 11 points and a game-high eight assists.

LET IT RAIN: The Huskies made a season-high 34 field goals against UMD, while firing up a season-high 75 shots. The previous high was 59 attempts. They also took a season-high 26 three's.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Senior captain **Brett Putz** (Forest City, Iowa) is fourth all-time on the SCSU three-point baskets made list with 211. He scored 33 points this weekend including a career-high 26 points Saturday to move into the No. 25 spot on the all-time SCSU scoring list with 1,151 points.

SOPHOMORE BREAKOUT: Sophomore **Mike Rostampour** (West St. Paul) scored a career-high 18 points Friday after shooting a stellar 6-for-8 from the field and 6-for-7 from the free throw line. He also had eight rebounds, two blocks and an assist in the win. Fellow sophomore **Kenquane Brown** (Robbinsdale) score a career-high 13 points Friday night on a 5-for-8 night from the field. Brown also had six rebounds and a block to go with one three pointer. Brown then scored nine points and grabbed another six rebounds the next night in Duluth in 16 minutes of action off the bench.

FINISHING AT THE LINE: St. Cloud leads the NSIC with a 77.9 percent shooting percentage from the free throw line and is second in attempts (380). Putz is the top-ranked free throw shooter at 90.9 percent (50-55).

NATIONALLY RANKED: The Huskies were ranked for the first time this season in the Jan. 10 National Association of Basketball Coaches top 25 poll. It was the first time in the ranks since November of 2010. SCSU is currently ranked No. 17.

PACING THE COMPETITION: SCSU is second in the NSIC with a +11.3 scoring margin after 15 games. The Huskies beat UMD by 35 points, which is the largest single-game margin for SCSU since beating Bemidji State 107-71 on the road during the 2009-10 season.

NORTHERN SUN INTERCOLLEGIATE CONFERENCE OPPONENT QUICK NOTES

SCSU VS. UMC ALL-TIME: The Huskies are 19-0 all-time against the Golden Eagles since the series started in 1995-96. The Huskies won the last meeting 62-50 on the road last season. It was their only matchup during the 2010-11 season.



MEET UMC'S HEAD COACH: Jeff Oseth is in his 10th season as the head coach and is in his 18th overall season as a head coach. He owns a 44-177 overall record with UMC after finishing 7-19 overall and 3-19 in the NSIC a season ago.

THE GOLDEN EAGLES IN 2011-12: Minnesota, Crookston is 5-10 overall this season, while starting off 1-10 in conference games. The squad is coming off two home losses last weekend and earned their only conference win of the season against the University of Mary when they won 56-54 on Jan. 8. The Golden Eagles are averaging 64.7 points a game and are allowing 65.7 to opponents. UMC is outrebounding opponents 31.8 to 30.5 per contest in 2011-12.

UMC is led by senior Akeem Cubie who is averaging 17.6 points a game, while pulling down 4.5 rebounds. Fellow senior guard Jacolby Anderson is second on the team and only other player to have a double figure scoring average (16.3). Both Cubie and Anderson are tied for the team lead with 18 made three's. Sophomore Keith Newberry, Jr. leads the team with 5.3 rebounds a game and 12 total blocks.

SCSU VS. MSUM ALL-TIME: St. Cloud State has played the Dragons 116 times since the 1932-33 season and lead the all-time series 79-37. The Huskies have won eight straight games and have not lost at home to MSUM since losing 54-52 during the fifth game of the 1983 season.

MEET MSUM'S HEAD COACH: Chad Walthall is in his second season as the head coach after finishing his first season 15-12 overall and 12-10 in the NSIC. He has coached at the collegiate level for 22 seasons.



THE DRAGONS IN 2011-12: MSUM has an identical record to SCSU (13-2, 9-2 NSIC) and is coming off a 76-63 home loss to ranked Winona State. The Dragons are averaging 72.2 points a game, while holding opponents to 64 points a contest. They are also outrebounding the competition 32.3 to 30.2 a game as junior Alex Novak leads the conference with 8.3 rebounds a game. MSUM is 3-1 on the road this season after dropping a contest at Bismarck earlier this season. Novak is also one of four players with a double-digit scoring average (10.3). Junior Jake Lindfors is leading the team with 15.1 points a game and 77 total field goals on the season. He is also second on the team with 6.1 rebounds a contest. Senior guard DJ Hamilton is second on the team with 14.8 points a game and leads the squad with 53 assists and 25 steals this season.
