2003-04 SCSU BASKETBALL TEAM NEWS

Release Date: March 1, 2004



THIS WEEK'S ACTION: The SCSU men's basketball team (17-10, 7-7 NCC) will open defense of its Wells Fargo Finals crown on Tuesday, March 2, with a first round game in the 2004 Wells Fargo Finals tournament at North Dakota State (15-12, 8-6 NCC). SCSU enters the tournament as the #5 seed, while NDSU is seeded #4. The winner of the game will advance to finals on March 5-6 in Omaha, Neb. Of note, SCSU is 6-1 all-time in Wells Fargo Final action, and they have won two of the three WFF titles (2001 and 2003). This will most likely mark the final time that SCSU and NDSU will play as members of the NCC, since the Bison will move to the NCAA Division I level in 2004-05. WJON AM 1240 is scheduled to broadcast the games live, with Jay Caldwell calling the play-by-play. NCC CHAMPS IN 2002-03: Final Record: The 2002-03 St. Cloud State University men's basketball team completed the season with a 26-5 overall record. The Huskies won the North Central Conference regular season title with a 13-3 record. SCSU went on to win the Wells Fargo Finals (hosted by St. Cloud State) and finished the season in the semifinals of the NCAA Division II North Central Region (hosted by the University of Nebraska-Kearney). St. Cloud State was ranked 19th in the final poll of the NABC/Division II Bulletin National Rankings.



THE COACHES: Kevin Schlagel (SCSU, 1976), is in his 7th season as head coach of the Huskies. He has compiled a current won/loss record of 138-61 in his seven years with the Huskies. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. It is the first Coach of the Year honor for Schlagel and the first for a Husky basketball coach since Butch Raymond was honored in 1986. Schlagel is 2-3 in NCAA tournament games that he has coached. He recorded his 100th career win on Dec. 7, 2002 in an 84-52 win over Northern Michigan. Schlagel is averaging 20-wins per season at the helm of the Huskies. He has compiled a 75-45 mark in NCC games over the past 7 years. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He has led the Huskies to three NCAA Division II Playoff appearances, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships (2001 and 2003) and one NCC Championship (2003). Schlagel is assisted by **Matt Reimer** (Central College), who is in his seventh season with the Huskies and graduate assistant Spencer Esslinger (Iowa State), who is in his second season at SCSU.

HUSKIES PICKED THIRD: The Huskies were picked third in this year's NCC pre-season media poll. USD was named first with 136 points, while SDSU was second with 135 points. SCSU came in at third place with 107 points, followed by NDSU (86), UND (78), Nebraska-Omaha (71), Minnesota State (38) and Augustana (33). Of note, Metro State was #1 in the latest poll NCAA DII poll (Feb. 22), while SDSU was #2. In the regional poll, SCSU will certainly need to pick up some wins in the WFF, as it was not ranked in the top 10. Teams currently ranked in the regional poll are 1. Metro State, 2. SDSU, 3. UN-Kearney, 4. Northern State, 5. Nebraska-Omaha, 6. South Dakota, 7. Bemidji State, 8. Colorado Christian, 9. Mesa State, 10. Ft. Lewis.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

HUSKIES WIN AT UND: In the final regular season game of the 2003-04 season, SCSU dropped a tough 88-84 decision at North Dakota State on Feb. 28. In the game at NDSU, the Huskies trailed 36-31 at the half but they did manage to make things close in the second half. With 2:30 left to play, Matt Siegle sunk a jumper to make the score 74-72. NDSU managed to rebuild its lead to seven before the Huskies cut the gap to 81-78 with :28 left after Siegle hit a pair of FTs. Down the stretch Nate Miller hit a pair of three-pointers that kept the game close but NDSU prevailed with eight free throws in the final :40 seconds of play to ice the game. Miller capped a stellar weekend with 25 points and five treys in the game, while Alex Carlson had 17 points and seven rebounds. Siegle joined the double-digit club with 15 points and eight rebounds, while Brad Evans came off the bench with 14 points and six rebounds. CoCo Cofield had 25 points in the game and Ben Nemmers had 16 points for the Bison...SCSU made its last trip to the Hyslop Sports Arena at the University of North Dakota on Feb. 27, and came away with a big 86-83 win. The Huskies led 41-33 at the half, but UND did manage to take the lead in the second half at 44-43 at the 17:08 mark of the second half. The lead bounced back and forth until SCSU grabbed the lead for good at the 6:47 mark with a basket by Alex Carlson. SCSU took that 63-61 lead and held it for the remainder of the game. A basket by Carlson at 1:49 gave SCSU a 75-68 lead before UND charged back and closed the gap to 82-81 with :13 left to play. To ice the game, Nate Miller made four free throws in the closing seconds for the win. Carlson and Miller shared the spotlight with 29 points apiece. Miller was five-of-seven from the three-point zone and was a perfect 8-of-8 from the line. Carlson notched three treys and six assists in the game. Brad Evans chipped in eight points and five rebounds, while Matt Siegle had six points. Todd Rypkema led UND with 24 points and 13 rebounds and Evan Lindahl had 26 points.

CARLSON NOTES: Alex Carlson ranks 13th in the nation (as of 2/22) with an assists per game average of 6.3. Carlson now has 1,250 career points, which places him 15th in team history. For career treys, Carlson has moved into third place on the SCSU. He currently has 194 treys...Carlson moved ahead of Haug Scharnowski (1989-94) in the career steal list this past weekend. Carlson now has 181 career steals, which places him second in team records...in the current NCC overall stats, Carlson ranks 7th at 16.1 ppg and he is 2nd with 6.3 assists per game. In NCC games only, Carlson is 3rd in the league with 20.4 ppg and is first in assists to turnover ratio at 2.93. He's 4th in the league with 1.64 steals per game and second with 6.07 assists per game. In league FT%, Carlson is third at 86.8%...of note, Carlson's career high vs. NDSU is 19 points on 1/9/04 and 2/13/03...Carlson's 29 points vs. UND on 2/27 ranks second in his career for points in a game.

THE OPPONENTS: The NDSU Bison will meet SCSU for the final time as members of the NCC, since NDSU is slated to move to the DI level next year. The Bison are 15-12, 8-6 NCC. The Huskies are 0-2 vs. NDSU this year, which includes an 86-83 loss at NDSU this past Saturday. Earlier this season, SCSU lost an 85-76 match to the Bison at Halenbeck. The last time SCSU won in Fargo was a 79-77 win in 2002-03. Coach Schlagel is 9-5 vs. NDSU during his tenure at SCSU. NDSU is 32-26 vs. the Huskies since 1934-35, and the loss at Halenbeck earlier this year snapped a six-game win streak for the Huskies vs. NDSU. In the 2003 Wells Fargo Finals, SCSU eliminated the Bison in the semi-finals by a 75-60 margin. This marked the first time that NDSU and SCSU had played in the WFF. CoCo Cofield leads the Bison this season with 15.0 ppg and Ben Nemmers has 12.9 ppg in 2003-04. Coach Tim Miles is in his third season with the Bison.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

CHAD VIRGIN: Senior guard Chad Virgin (Eagan) played in 16 games in 2002-03. He scored a season and career high seven points against Puerto Rico-Mayaguez last year. In 2003-04, Virgin has a season-high 3 pts. vs. UMC on 11/15/03.

PAT WEIHERT: Sophomore forward Pat Weihert (Watertown, WI) saw action in 15 games last year. In 2003-04, Weihert hit a career-high with 13 pts. vs. USD (2/13/04) and WOU (11/21) and 6 rebs. vs. DWU (11/16). Has three starts in 2003-04.

SCOTT PETERS: Sophomore center Scott Peters (Litchfield) played in 16 games last year. Twice he scored his season-best four points. In 2003-04, Peters hit a season-high 3 points vs. UND (1/10).

JOE EVERT: Junior center Joe Evert (Wanamingo), a transfer from Loyola-Chicago notched 14 pts and 10 rebs. in his SCSU debut against UMC (11/15/03). Collected double-double with 10 pts. and 11 rebounds against CSP on 12/18/03...hit a team-high five blocks in same game. 18 starts in 2003-04. Enjoyed season high 16 points at NMU.

THE REST OF THE CREW: Brad Evans posted a double-double (13 pts./10 rebs.) in action at NMU on 1/3/04. Evans hit a career-high with 23 points in SCSU win over AC on 1/16/04 and had a start in win over SDSU on 1/17/04. Evans had 22 points in win at Augie...Frosh Bobby Harris hit a season-high 8 points against DWU. Harris hit the game-winner with :06 left on a trey against Wayne State on 11/30. Zac Campbell has 9 starts this year and scored a season-high 13 points against USD on 1/24.

2003-04 TEAM CAPTAINS: The team captains for the 2003-04 season are senior Alex Carlson and junior Nate Miller.

NEXT UP: If the Huskies win, they will play UN-Omaha in the WWF on March 6, in Omaha, Neb.

TEAM NOTES: SCSU is 11-5 when they have a lead at the half this year, and they are 4-4 when they trail at the half. If the score is tied at the half, SCSU is 2-1 this year...Nate Miller's 16-of-16 free throw effort against Central Wash. this season ranks 1st among all NCAA Division II players for best FT% in a game. His 41 points in the same game ranks 14th in the nation among DII players this season for points in a game...SCSU is first in the league (NCC games only) with 15.79 assists per game and 2nd with 8.07 treys per game. SCSU is also tied for 2nd in the NCC with 3.86 blocks per game and a .755 FT%.
