**ON THE RADIO:** SCSU women's basketball was broadcast live on WJON AM 1240 Radio during the 2005-06 season. WJON sports director Jay Caldwell and Denise Gill called all of the action.

**2005-06 SEASON RECORD:** St. Cloud State posted a 29-5 overall record in 2005-06, the most wins for a Husky squad since the 1982-83 team went 31-4 in season play.

**HUSKIES SECOND IN THE NCC:** With a mark of 9-3 in the North Central Conference, the St. Cloud State Huskies finished second in the NCC after regular season play. This is the team's highest NCC finish since they took first place in 1988-89. The Huskies were knocked out of the Wells Fargo Finals in the quarterfinal round by Augustana College with a score of 80-77.

**BACK-TO-BACK REGION CHAMPS!!:** The Huskies entered their tenth Regional tournament with a #3 seed and defeated three opponents on their way to a repeat as North Central Region Champions. They stopped a two-game slide against Augustana College by snatching an 82-69 win in the quarterfinals, knocked Concordia-St. Paul out of postseason play for the second consecutive year with a 96-89 semifinal round win, and pulled off a remarkable 75-69 upset over previously undefeated North Dakota for the 2006 North Central Region title. This is the school's sixth North Central Region title.

**ELITE EIGHT APPEARANCE:** The Huskies made a second straight and sixth overall trip to the NCAA Division II Elite Eight, held in Hot Springs, Arkansas. 12th-ranked St. Cloud State took on 20th-ranked Shaw University on Wednesday, March 22. They quieted a loud and quick Bears team by a final score of 78-71 and became the first ever SCSU basketball team, men's or women's, to remain one of the final four Division II teams left standing in the NCAA tournament. SCSU faced American International College in the semifinal round, but could not get their offense flowing and ended their season with a 58-70 loss.

Head Coach: Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota, 1983) has completed her twelfth season with the Huskies and 21st season as a collegiate head coach. She has compiled a 191-150 record at SCSU and has amassed a career record of 343-239. Dr. Ulferts recorded her 300th career win against the University of Minnesota-Crookston on Dec. 19, 2004 with a 92-73 victory. Under her guidance, the Huskies have made back-to-back Elite Eight appearances and this year made it to the program's first Final Four appearance. Last year, SCSU went 23-10, winning the 2005 North Central Region title and earning a berth at the NCAA Elite Eight, the first under Head Coach Ulferts and the fifth in school history. The Huskies were defeated by Merrimack College in the final seconds of the Quarterfinal game, falling 78-79. The Huskies also reached the NCAA North Central Region Tournament in 2000-01 but fell to the University of North Dakota in the semifinal round, 63-76. Before coming to St. Cloud, Ulferts coached at MN-Crookston (four seasons) and MN-State, Moorhead (five seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the Year.

Assistant Coaches: Mike Jewett finished his second year as top assistant at SCSU. Jewett also served as the head women's basketball coach at Franklin College in Franklin, Indiana for three seasons (2001-2004), was an assistant coach at Augustana College and has high school head coaching experience. Megan Taylor (Iowa State, 2002) has completed two seasons as a graduate assistant coach at SCSU. At Iowa State, Taylor was a four-time All-Conference Player and an All-American. She is the state of Minnesota's second leading scorer for girls' and boys' basketball with 3,300 career points. Katie Huschle served this season as a student assistant coach for the Huskies. Huschle was the third-leading scorer for SCSU last season, averaging 11.5 points, and led the team in steals with 67. Huschle became St. Cloud State's 22nd member of the 1,000 Point Club and wrapped up her career with 1,043 points scored.

All-NCC Huskies: Senior Sascha Hansen and junior Erika Quigley were named to this year's All-North Central Conference team. Quigley is a three-time All-NCC pick, while Hansen has received the honor twice in her career.

Books and Brawn: Sascha Hansen was named to the 2005-06 Academic All-North Central Conference team, the 2006 ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District Second Team, and along with Shannon Francis, was named to the Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll. Hansen is a physical education major with a 3.52 gpa, a two-time Academic All-NCC selection and is SCSU's 2005-06 Physical Education Major of the Year. Francis is a marketing major.

Quigley Named to Wells Fargo Finals All-Tournament Team: Quigley was named to the six member Wells Fargo Finals All-Tournament team. She tallied 27 points, seven rebounds, five assists, and four blocked shots in SCSU's 77-80 loss to Augustana.

North Central Region Player of the Year Goes to Quigley: Erika Quigley headlined the 2006 Daktronics NCAA Division II All-North Central Region team as Player of the Year. This is her third career All-Region honor. Sascha Hansen was named to the All-Region Second Team.

Hansen Named North Central Region Most Valuable Player: Sascha Hansen was named Most Valuable Player of the North Central Region Tournament after scoring a season high 28 points in SCSU's win over UND for the Region title. She averaged 22.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, and 5.7 assists in the tournament. Quigley was also named to the All-Region team.

Quigley Receives Three More All-America Accolades: After averaging 22.2 points and 12.6 rebounds in her junior campaign, Erika Quigley received All-American status by three separate organizations this year. She was named to the 2006 Daktronics, Inc., Division II All-America First Team, the 2006 WBCA Kodak All-America team, and the 2006 Women's Division II Bulletin All-American First Team. Quigley was also named an All-American twice last season for a career total of five All-American honors.

Huskies Set New Records: The 2005-06 squad set a new program record for best season start, going undefeated through the first half of the season with a 17-0 record. They also set new team records for Most 3-Point Field Goals in a Season (223) and Most Points in a Season (2,812), and tied the record for Best 3-Point Percentage in a Season (37.4%, 223-597).



**Senior Sascha Hansen:** Senior Sascha Hansen (Marshall, MN) wrapped up her career by becoming SCSU's all-time leader for career starts (121) and three-pointers made (185) and also upped her previously held record for three's made in a season with 73. A three-time team captain, Hansen was SCSU's second-leading scorer, averaging 15.5 points and 5.5 assists per game. Hansen surpassed the 1,000 point mark of her career on December 11 against St. Thomas and became one of just three players in school history to post over 1,000 points and 400 assists (1,391 pts, 488 asst.). Her career highs are 32 points (UMC, 12/11/04), 12 rebounds (SMSU, 12/7/04), and 12 assists (PLNU, 11/26/05). She was named NCC Player of the Week, Most Valuable Player of the Regional Tournament, All-NCC, Academic All-NCC, and Academic All-District Second Team.

**Senior April Carlson:** 2005-06 co-captain April Carlson finished her run at St. Cloud State tied for second career games played with 121. She missed just one game in four years and made 91 starts. Carlson averaged career high figures of 7.2 points and 4.9 rebounds per game this season. She is known for her defensive efforts on the hardcourt and was second on the team in steals with 50. She posted career highs this season with 18 points against Northern Michigan on November 25, 2005 and 12 rebounds against South Dakota on February 11, 2006.



**Junior Shannon Francis:** Junior Shannon Francis averaged 12.7 points and 4.6 rebounds for the Huskies this season. She has climbed to the top of SCSU's career free throw percentage list with a mark of 87.4% after shooting 89.0% from the line this season. Francis had a career high 29 points against Minnesota State on January 12, 2006. In that game, Francis tied SCSU's single game free throw performance by hitting 11 of 11 shots from the charity stripe. Francis is also one of SCSU's greatest threats from long range, having hit 55 threes this season and 146 in her career. She was named to the Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll.



**Junior Erika Quigley:** Quigley once again led the Huskies in scoring and rebounding this season with averages of 22.2 points and 12.6 rebounds per game, double-doubling in 25 of SCSU's 34 games this season. She set a new league record for junior rebounding with 13.3 rpg in the regular season. Quigley's career figures have put her on top of both SCSU's career scoring average (21.4 ppg) and rebounding average (11.6 rpg) charts. Her career high scoring performance stands at 37 points against Southwest Minnesota State on December 7, 2004. She recorded a career high 22 rebounds in the second game of the season against Wisconsin-Stout. Quigley was named NCC Player of the Week five times, was declared the 2005-06 North Central Region Player of the Year, and was named an All-American by three organizations this season for a career total of five All-American honors.



**Sophomore Kayla Rengel:** Sophomore Kayla Rengel was the team's fourth-leading scorer this season with a 12.0 ppg average. She is one of the team's best long-range shooters, connecting on 44 of 110 three-pointers this season (40.0%). Rengel tops SCSU's career three-Point Field Goal Pct list with a 42.0% average (79-188). On the defensive end, Rengel led the Huskies in steals this season with 59 and was the second-best rebounder with 6.4 boards per game. Rengel scored a career best 29 points against Augustana College on January 14, 2006. She pulled down a career high 12 rebounds against Shaw University on March 22, 2006.

**First Year Krystal Scott:** First Year Krystal Scott (Rosemount, MN) was SCSU's first player off the bench this season and saw playing time in all 34 games. She averaged 4.2 points and 2.1 rebounds per game and dished out 62 assists. Scott led all Husky newcomers in minutes played throughout the NCC play. She scored a career high 14 points against North Central University on November 22, 2005 and had a career high 6 rebounds against Minnesota State on March 1, 2006.

**First Year Brianna Nance:** Nance (Minneapolis, MN) saw playing time in 31 games this season, averaging 8.3 minutes per game. She finished her rookie campaign with averages of 2.6 points and 1.1 rebounds per game. Nance scored a career high 13 points in the first game of the season against Minnesota Crookston on November 18, 2005.



**First Year Heather Miller:** Heather Miller (Sun Prairie, WI) played in 24 games this season and averaged 2.0 points and 1.3 rebounds per game. She saw an increase in playing time as the season progressed and was often the third bench player to be used by St. Cloud State. Miller scored a career high six points twice this season, most recently against Nebraska-Omaha on February 9, 2006.

**First Year Katie Jensen:** Katie Jensen (North English, IA) made 27 appearances this season, including three starts. She averaged 2.4 points and 1.5 rebounds in an average 10.7 minutes of play. She led all Husky newcomers in free throw percentage, sinking 86.7% of shots taken. Her career best figures come from a December 2, 2005 game against Waldorf College, when she scored seven points and had six rebounds.



**First Year Jackie Carlson:** First Year Jackie Carlson (Litchfield, MN) was one of SCSU's strongest newcomers this season, averaging 5.6 points and 5.3 rebounds. She saw more court time than any other SCSU first-year player, appearing in all 34 games for an average of 17.4 minutes per game. She was a reliable bench player who played quality minutes for the short Husky roster. Carlson has scored a career high 13 points three times this season, most recently against South Dakota on February 25, 2006. She has recorded two double-doubles in her rookie year, with 11 points and 10 rebounds on both occasions.
