## Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish begins her second season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2009-10, and her sixth overall as a collegiate coach.

Fish, a St. Cloud native, became the eighth coach in the history of the women's basketball program in July of 2008. She is very familiar with Husky basketball as she was an assistant coach under Dr. Lori Ulferts from 1999 to 2004.

In her first season with the Huskies, Fish guided St. Cloud State to a 22-9 overall record, won the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship, and an NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament appearance.

Fish has compiled a five-year career record of 84-62. She brings 18 years of coaching experience, including 16 years at the collegiate level to the Huskies' program. During her career she has coached teams that have made six NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances including the 2009 St. Cloud State women.

A familiar name to the St. Cloud area, Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.

After assistant coaching stints at Eastern Illinois, South Dakota State and St. Cloud State, Fish was named the head coach at Minnesota State University, Mankato in 2004. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament. She compiled a 62-53 won/loss record with the Mavericks.

## Game Notes

**A LITTLE HISTORY:** This game kicks off the 42nd season of women's basketball at St. Cloud State. Eight women have coached the Huskies during those 42 seasons and have combined to produce a winning record of 585-450. Gladys Ziemer owns the longest tenure as head coach with 20 seasons and a 321-212 overall record. Dr. Lori Ulferts coached for 14 seasons and compiled a 219-178 winning record. Current head coach Lori Fish begins her second season with the Huskies and has a 22-9 record at St. Cloud.

**SERIES RECORD:** The Huskies are 4-0 against the University of Wisconsin-Stout since the series began in the 2003-04 season. The last game between the two teams was during the 2007-08 season and resulted in an 87-72 SCSU win.

**ABOUT ST. CLOUD STATE:** After a successful 2008-09 campaign with first year coach Lori Fish guiding the Huskies to a 22-9 overall record, the 2009 NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament Championship, and an NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament berth, St. Cloud State looks to a young squad to continue the Huskies success. The 2009-10 Huskies have nine first year players on the squad and four sophomores that make up the majority of the team. St. Cloud State returns one start-

er from a year ago in junior guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada). Barlow averaged 15.4 points per game in her sophomore campaign. She was named to the All-NSIC Second Team, the Daktronics All-Central Region Second Team and the NSIC/Sanford Health All-Tournament team. Barlow started all 31 games during the season and has a 59-game starting streak. She has scored 785 points in her career. Sophomore forward Aaryn Booker (Minneapolis) played in all 31 games last season and averaged 4.9 points and 4.4 rebounds for the Huskies. Other returning players with playing time include sophomores Becca Friestleben (Victoria) and Christina Steele (Apple Valley). Friestleben, a guard, played in 23 games last season and averaged 3.7 points. A post, Steele played in 19 games and collected 48 points and 31 rebounds. Senior guards Kaylan King (Reno, Nev.) and Megan Foley (St. Cloud) saw limited playing time for the Huskies.

**SECOND IN NCAA ATTENDANCE:** The NCAA released its women's basketball attendance figures for the season and the Huskies were ranked 2008-09 second in NCAA Division II behind conference member Northern State University. St. Cloud State had 40,263 fans attend 13 home games for an average of 3,097. Northern State led all of NCAA Division

II women's basketball with an average attendance of 3,400. The only other schools to finish above 2,000 fans per game in Division II were Washburn, Emporia State, and North Dakota. The Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) ranked second in conference attendance at the Division II level. NSIC schools overall averaged 1,045 fans per game. The Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association (MIAA) led Division II in attendance with 1,290 fans per game.

Opponents Notes

**BLUE DEVILS NOTES:** The Blue Devils are an NCAA Division III member and compete in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC). UW-Stout posted a 16-11 overall record in 2008-09 and went 10-6 in the WIAC, good for fourth place. The Blue Devils advanced to the second round of the WIAC postseason tournament. UW-Stout is led by four experienced seniors - forward Julia Hirssig, an all-WIAC and second team All-America selection, forward Megan Maslowski, swing player Danielle DeWitt and guard Kim Stokke. Hirssig led Stout last season with 18.9 points and 10.7 rebounds. Stokke averaged 8.2 points, DeWitt 6.6 points and Maslowski 5.7 points. The Blue Devils return five seniors, three juniors, one sophomore and 13 freshmen. Last week Hirssig was named to the first team of the 2009-10 D3hoops.com Preseason All-America Team. Last season, Hirssig averaged 18.9 points per game and 10.7 rebounds, finishing the season with 511 points, third on the Stout all-time single season list. Her 290 rebounds also ranks her third on the Stout single season list. Hirssig posted a field goal percentage of .548, hitting 187-of-341 shots. Hirssig has started 54 consecutive games and has played in all 83 games since her freshman year. Fellow seniors Megan Maslowski and Kim Stokke have played in 80 games over their career, and Danielle DeWitt has played in 68, coming off the

bench for all of her playing time. Maslowski and Stokke started almost all of the games last season.

**University of Wisconsin-Stout head coach Mark Thomas** begins his 23rd season with the Blue Devils in 2009-10. Over the past 18 seasons, the Blue Devils have finished in the top four of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) - one of the top NCAA Division III women's basketball conferences - 17 times. The Blue Devils have also been consistently ranked in the top 25 NCAA Division III programs in attendance. Thomas, who is the dean of WIAC women's basketball coaches, has a 388-201 record, the most wins of any coach in WIAC women's basketball history.

**NSIC Preseason Poll**

St. Cloud, Minn. -- The 2009-10 St. Cloud State women's basketball team has been picked to finish eighth in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) Women's Basketball Preseason Coaches Poll. Defending NCAA Division II Champions Minnesota State University, Mankato has been picked as the No. 1 team.

St. Cloud State finished the 2008-09 season as the NSIC/Sanford Health Post-season Tournament Champions and advanced to the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament. The Huskies posted a 22-9 overall record and finished sixth in the NSIC with a 12-8 record.

St. Cloud State junior guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) is a player to watch. Barlow was a NSIC All-Conference Second Team pick, NSIC/Sanford Health All-Tournament team selection, and Daktronics Central Region Second Team pick last season. She ranked sixth in the NSIC in scoring with 15.2 points per game and is sixth in field goal shooting percentage. She started all 28 games last season for the Huskies and has played in 59 straight games. She led the team in field goal shooting percentage with a mark of .504. She scored a career high 28 points against Fort Lewis in the NCAA tournament on Mar. 13 and scored in double figures 27 times during the season. She had a career high 11 rebounds against Concordia-St. Paul on Mar. 8 and opened the season with a career high seven steals on Nov. 15. Barlow has scored 785 points in her career.
