PLAYER PROFILE

Jackie Carlson, sophomore, hailing from Litchfield, has started six games for the Huskies this season.



Carlson has charted three double-digit games this season, all coming within the last four games. She tied her career high of 13 points, twice this season, and charted her third career double-double on Dec. 8 against Alaska-Fairbanks (13 pt, 10 reb). Carlson's past two double doubles fell during the 2005-06 season against MSU Mankato (11 pt, 10 reb) and Upper Iowa (11 pt, 10 reb).

During the 2005-06 season she averaged 5.6 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. She saw more playing time than any other first year player, appearing in all 34 games, averaging 17.4 minutes per game.

A 2005 graduate of Litchfield High School, where she pled in 106 varsity games, starting as an 8th grader. She is the younger sister of former SCSU men's basketball standout Alex Carlson, and is the daughter of John and Jo Carlson of Litchfield.

HUSKIES TRAVEL TO FACE NORTHERN SUN TEAMS

The St. Cloud State women's basketball team (8-3 overall) will travel to St. Paul on Wednesday and to Moorhead on Saturday to compete against Northern Sun teams.

The Huskies will face off against Concordia-St. Paul on Wednesday, December 13 at 7:00 p.m. SCSU saw CSP on November 28, sneaking by the Golden Bears in the last minute, 59-57. Minnesota State-Moorhead will host St. Cloud on Saturday, December 16 at 6:00 p.m.

SCSU SETS NEW SINGLE GAME STEALS RECORD AGAINST NORTH CENTRAL

St. Cloud State women's basketball set a new single game record of 28 steals against North Central on Thursday, December 7, 2006. All but two Huskies charted a steal. Sophomore, Kaylan King (Reno, NV) tallied five, leading the team, with both sophomore Megan Foley (St. Cloud) and senior Shannon Francis (Mahnomen) tallying four.

EVERY HUSKY IN UNIFORM TALLIED TWO POINTS AGAINST NORTH CENTRAL

Sophomore Katie Jensen scored with five minutes left in the game versus North Central on Thursday, to mark the first time every Husky charted at least two points in a game this season. Playing time was also split among starters and the bench as the starters averaged 21.2 minutes. The least amount of playing time was seven minutes charted by two Huskies off the bench.

QUIGLEY THREE-PEATS AS NCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK, JOINS THE 2,000 POINT CLUB



Senior post, Erika Quigley (Duluth), claimed her third consecutive player of the week nod from the North Central Conference, announced on Monday, December 11. Quigley scored 101 points in the four game homestand, averaging 25.3 ppg, 121.5 rpg, and 2.0 of both blocks and steals per game. She shot .577 from the field and was one rebound away from four double-doubles on the week.

She was also honored on Sunday for becoming SCSU's second women's basketball player to hit 2,000 points in her career and for becoming SCSU's all-time leading rebounder. Both were marked on the team's trip to Denver.

She received a 2,000 point club basketball in front of over 1,200 fans and her parents. She ended the week with a career total of 2,140 points and 1,145 rebounds.

The Golden Bears have won two games since their tight loss to the Huskies, sneaking by Moorhead 70-69 in overtime and beating Crookston on Dec. 9, 77-52. They tallied another loss since visiting SCSU, an 82-77 loss to Bemidji State.

All five starters for the Golden Bears are averaging over nine points a game. Kelly Lund leads the team with 12.1 ppg and 5.0 rpg. Both Katie LaVoilette and Amanda Behnke are also in double figures in scoring, averaging 11.4 and 10.4 respectively.

THE HUSKY RECAP

SCSU has played four games in the past six days, going 4-0 at home and improving their record to 8-3 overall. The week began on Tuesday as the Huskies hosted Minnesota-Morris, claiming victory 97-41.

On Thursday the Huskies set a single season record of 28 steals against North Central University. Each uniformed player scored at least two points in the win, 101-40.

On Friday the Huskies hosted Alaska-Fairbanks for the third time in the history of SCSU women's basketball. SCSU won the defensive battle 82-71.

SCSU took a commanding 18-0 lead in the first six and half minutes of the game on Sunday, and never looked back as they defeated Wisconsin-Eau Claire, 71-55.

"It helped us build our confidence," Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts said about the four game homestand, "and allowed us to get our transition offense rolling."

Erika Quigley tallied 101 points and 50 rebounds in the four games. She scored 29% of the team's total points, including three 25+ point games and three double-doubles. Against Minnesota-Morris she tallied 31 points and 12 rebounds, North Central she charted 27 points and 11 boards, and Wisconsin-Eau Claire she scored 28 points and grabbed 18 rebounds (15 pts and 10 rebounds at halftime). She had a streak of six consecutive double-doubles when she fouled out in the game against Alaska-Fairbanks where she was one rebound away from keeping the streak alive.


Junior Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) charted a season high, 24 points against Alaska-Fairbanks, and grabbed eight boards. Sophomore Jackie Carlson charted three double-digit scoring games, including her first double-double of the season against Alaska-Fairbanks.

Sophomore Heather Miller scored her career high 11 points against UAF. Both first year athlete Jennifer Waletzko and sophomore Anna Cashman scored their first points as a Husky over the homestand.

IN THE POLLS

The Huskies were ranked 23rd in the USA Today/ESPN poll released on December 5. The Huskies slipped from the number eight slot after going 0-2 at the Coors Classic in Denver, Colo.

Head Coach: Dr. Lori Ulferts is in her thirteenth season with the Huskies and 22nd season as a collegiate head coach. **She has compiled a 191-150 record at SCSU and has amassed a career record of 343-239.** Dr. Ulferts recorded her 300th career win against the University of Minnesota-Crookston on Dec. 19, 2004 with a 92-73 victory. Under her guidance the Huskies have made back-to-back Elite Eight appearances and in 2005-06 made it to the program's first Final Four. Last season the Huskies went 29-5, winning the North Central Region for the second consecutive year. Before coming to St. Cloud, Ulferts coached at UM-Crookston (4 seasons) and MN-State Moorhead (5 seasons). In 2005 Dr. Ulferts was inducted to the University of Minnesota-Crookston Hall of Fame and in October of 2006 she was inducted into the University of North Dakota Hall of Fame as a member of the Women's Field Hockey team.



Assistant Coaches: Carol Thelen enters her first season as an assistant coach for the Huskies. An SCSU alumni, Thelen has served as both a head college coach as well as the head coach for DeLaSalle High School for the past seven years. Prior to DeLaSalle, Thelen served as head coach at the University of Minnesota-Morris and Wisconsin River Falls. **Chad Eickhoff** is in his first season at SCSU. He was the assistant director of Pam Borton's Minnesota Basketball Camps in 2005-06 and an assistant varsity girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle and was the head Islanders 14U AAU Girls basketball coach in 2006.
