- Last season the Huskies posted a 12-14 record and finished 9-13 in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC).
- The Huskies are in their fourth season as a member of the NSIC. SCSU won the 2009 Sanford Health/NSIC Tournament.
- Augustana** finished the 2010-11 season with a 20-10 overall record and tied for fifth in the league standings with a 13-9 mark.
- Wayne State** College posted a 26-4 overall record in 2010-11 and won the NSIC regular season title with a 21-1 mark. The Wildcats advanced to the NCAA North Central Region Tournament.
- Wayne State was ranked 9th and Augustana College was receiving votes in the Dec. 13, 2011 USA Today/ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll.

- Junior guard **Amanda Wagner** (Webster) scored a career high 19 points in the Huskies 65-48 win over Concordia-St. Paul on Dec. 17. She made three-of-four three-point basket attempts and grabbed a game high eight rebounds. Wagner leads the team in scoring with a 9.0 points per game average. She is shooting 41 percent from the field, 40 percent from beyond the arc and 79 percent from the free throw line. Wagner leads the NSIC in three-point field goal percent shooting at .545 and is second in the league in steals with a 2.6 average.
- First-year forward **Jessica Benson** (Grand Meadow) also had eight rebounds in the win over the Golden Bears. She is averaging 5.9 rebounds and 6.1 points per game.
- Senior post **Christina Steele** (Apple Valley) had a season high seven points in the win and for the third time this season blocked two shots. Steele leads the team with nine blocked shots this season.
- Senior post **Aaryn Booker** (Minneapolis) had a solid outing as she finished the game with nine points and seven rebounds. She has 14 rebounds over the last two games and leads the Huskies with 6.4 boards per game.
- Over the last three games junior guard **Nicole Anderson** (Cannon Falls) has scored 20 points and pulled down 18 rebounds. She is the team leader in steals with 23 and assists with 18 this season.
- Senior guard **Jordi Gerking** (Spirit Lake, Iowa), along with junior guards **Nicole Anderson** (Cannon Falls) and **Amanda Wagner** (Webster) have been starters in all nine games this season. Anderson and Wagner have played in every game of their collegiate career, a total of 62.
- **Wagner** has started 60 of her 62 career games and **Anderson** has been a starter in 61.
- In conference play the Huskies rank second in scoring defense allowing 59.0 points per game. They will face the league leader Wayne State who allows just 53.0 points per game. Wayne State and St. Cloud State also top the stat sheet in three-point field goal percent defense. SCSU is holding their league opponents to .234 percent shooting and Wayne State is holding their opponent to .243. St. Cloud State **leads the NSIC** in steals with 13.0 picks a game, turnover margin with a +6.60 and of-fensive rebounds with 16.6 per game.

### Series Records:

- St. Cloud State leads the all-time series against Augustana, 31-24. The Vikings won twice last season and have won nine in a row over the Huskies.
- St. Cloud State has a slim 5-4 winning margin over Wayne State. The Wildcats beat the Huskies twice last season and have won three straight over SCSU.

**About Augustana:** The game against Augustana will pit the NSIC's top scoring offense against the leagues second best defense. The Vikings are scoring a league high 76.8 points per game while the Huskies are allowing 59.0 points per game. Augustana was picked to finish third in the NSIC in the annual preseason coaches poll. The Vikings last NSIC action was at home on Dec. 16 and 17 against Minnesota, Crookston and MSU Moorhead. The Vikings lost to UMC, 73-70 and defeated MSUM 98-66. Alex Feeney (14.5 ppg), Molly Hayes (11.0 ppg) and Lydia Nelson (10.3 ppg) all average double figures in scoring for the Vikings. As a team AC averages 74.5 ppg and 38.9 rebounds a game.

**About Wayne State:** The Wildcats are the preseason pick to win the NSIC. Their only loss this season was a 72-64 defeat at the University of Mary on Dec. 10. On Nov. 29th the Wildcats were ranked fourth in the nation, the highest ever national ranking for the team. Wayne is led by the NSIC Preseason Player of the Year Ashley Arlen. She is averaging 19.5 points and 8.8 rebounds per game. The Wildcats average 71.2 points per game and 35.4 rebounds per outing.

### Head Coach Lori Fish

St. Cloud, Minn., native Lori Fish is at home in her fourth season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2011-12 and her eighth overall as a collegiate coach.

During the 2008-09 season, her first season with the Huskies, Fish guided St. Cloud State to a 22-9 overall record, won the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship, and advanced to the NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament.

In 2009-10 the Huskies posted a 10-17 overall record and in 2010-11 were 12-14 overall.

On Dec. 18, 2010 Fish collected her 100th career coaching win. The milestone came in an exciting 61-60 win over Concordia University, St. Paul on the Huskies home court.

In seven seasons as a collegiate coach, Fish has compiled a 106-93 career record. In her three season at St. Cloud State she is 44-40.

She brought 19 years of coaching experience, including 17 years at the collegiate level to the Huskies' program. During her career she has coached teams that have made six NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances including the 2008-09 St. Cloud State women.

A familiar name to the St. Cloud area, Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State from 1986-1990 and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.

Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant.

In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons.

In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament. She compiled a 62-53 won/loss record with the Mavericks.
