St. Cloud State (3-3 overall, 0-2 NSIC) at Southwest Minnesota State, 6:00 p.m., Friday, Dec. 9, Marshall, Minn. Minnesota State, Mankato, 6:00 p.m., Saturday, Dec. 10, Mankato, Minn.

- St. Cloud State will take to the road for the first time in the 2011-12 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) this weekend with a pair of league games at Southwest Minnesota State University on Friday and Minnesota State University, Mankato on Saturday.
- Last season the Huskies posted a 12-14 record and finished 9-13 in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC).
- The Huskies begin their fourth season as a member of the NSIC. SCSU won the 2009 Sanford Health/NSIC Tournament.
- Southwest Minnesota State posted a 7-19 overall record and 6-16 mark in the NSIC last season and finished 12th in the league.
- Minnesota State tied for eighth in the NSIC with a 10-12 conference record and went 13-13 overall last season.
- St. Cloud State opened the 2011-12 NSIC season at home last weekend and suffered a pair of losses by a combined six points. The Huskies gave up a 19 point second half lead to the University of Mary on Friday night and lost 58-56. On Saturday, in a closely contested game, the Huskies lost a six point second half lead and the game by a score of 71-67 to Northern State University.
- Sophomore guard **Sam Price** (Eau Claire, Wis.), a member of the 2011 NSIC All-Freshmen Team, is the Huskies leading scorer. She is averaging 8.8 points per game and scored a season high 22 points in the Huskies outing against UW-Stout.
- Senior post **Aaryn Booker** (Minneapolis) scored in double figures in both games over the weekend and finished with 28 points and 12 rebounds. She is the leading rebounder for the Huskies averaging 6.5 boards per game. She ranks second in scoring at 8.5 points. This week Booker ranks 15th in the NSIC in points (14.0), 16th in rebounds (6.0) and fourth in steals (2.5).

- Senior guard **Jordi Gerking** (Spirit Lake, Iowa), along with junior guards **Nicole Anderson** (Cannon Falls) and **Amanda Wagner** (Webster) have been starters in all six games this season. Anderson and Wagner have played in every game of their collegiate career, a total of 59.
- **Wagner** has started 57 of her 59 career games and **Anderson** has been a starter in 58.
- **Wagner** and first year forward **Jessica Benson** (Grand Meadow) hit the boards for the Huskies against Northern State, each posting season highs. Wagner pulled down eight boards and Benson came away with seven. Wagner had 15 points and 15 rebounds over the weekend. She leads the NSIC in offensive rebounds with 4.5 per game.
- Sophomore guard **Rachael Moen** (Savage) had a season high nine points and three steals against UMary on Friday. Saturday she had a season high four assists against Northern.
- St. Cloud State leads the **NSIC in steals** with 13.5 swipes per game. Wagner averages 3.0, Booker 2.5, and Moen and Anderson 2.0.

Series Records:

- St. Cloud State is 29-16 all-time against Southwest Minnesota State. The Huskies defeated the Mustangs twice last season, 70-67 at home and 87-76 in double overtime in Marshall.
- The Huskies and Mavericks have played 98 games in a series that began in 1969. St. Cloud State is 59-39 all-time against MSU. Last year the Huskies lost at home 51-54 and posted a 71-70 road win against the Mavericks. Over the last three seasons these teams are even, 6-6, in games played.

About Southwest Minnesota State: The Mustangs have lost four straight games including two road losses in opening weekend NSIC play. SMSU lost at Augustana College, 85-54 on Friday and then fell to fourth-ranked and NSIC defending champion Wayne State, 78-58 on Saturday. The Mustangs only win of the season thus far was a 72-60 victory at Minot State on Nov. 17. Abby Kenealy has led the team in scoring in four of their games and is the Mustangs overall scoring leader with 16.8 points per game.

About Minnesota State: After starting the season 4-0, the Mavericks stumbled in NSIC opening weekend action, losing at Wayne State, 78-60 and Augustana College, 62-57. Minnesota State opened the season with non-conference wins over Ashland and California (Pa.) at the California (Pa.) tournament Nov. 12 and 13. The Mavericks are 2-0 at home this season. Ali Wilkinson is the team's leading scorer as she averages 12.0 points per game. She has led the team in scoring in three games.

Head Coach Lori Fish

St. Cloud, Minn., native Lori Fish is at home in her fourth season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2011-12 and her eighth overall as a collegiate coach.

During the 2008-09 season, her first season with the Huskies, Fish guided St. Cloud State to a 22-9 overall record, won the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship, and advanced to the NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament.

In 2009-10 the Huskies posted a 10-17 overall record and in 2010-11 were 12-14 overall.

On Dec. 18, 2010 Fish collected her 100th career coaching win. The milestone came in an exciting 61-60 win over Concordia University, St. Paul on the Huskies home court.

In seven seasons as a collegiate coach, Fish has compiled a 106-93 career record. In her three season at St. Cloud State she is 44-40.

She brought 19 years of coaching experience, including 17 years at the collegiate level to the Huskies' program. During her career she has coached teams that have made six NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances including the 2008-09 St. Cloud State women.

A familiar name to the St. Cloud area, Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State from 1986-1990 and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.

Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant.

In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons.

In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament. She compiled a 62-53 won/loss record with the Mavericks.
