- ✓ Upper Iowa enters Saturday's tilt with a 1-10 overall record and 1-6 league mark
- ✓ Winona State is receiving votes in this week's USA Today ESPN Top 25 Coaches poll. The Warriors bring a 10-1 overall record and 6-1 NSIC mark into the weekend. WSU will play at Concordia-St. Paul on Saturday.
- ✓ Huskies are third-year members of the NCAA Division II Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC).
- ✓ Huskies posted a 10-17 overall record in 2009-10 and finished 13th in the NSIC with a 5-15 mark.
- ✓ The Huskies return 10 letterwinners from the 2009-10 season including five players with starting experience.
- ✓ Upper Iowa posted a 2-25 overall record and 0-20 NSIC mark in the 2009-10 season.
- ✓ Winona State went 17-11 in 2009-10 and finished in a fifth place tie in the league standings with a 12-8 record. The Warriors season ended in the first round of the NSIC tournament.

2009-10 SCSU SEASON RECAP: The 2009-10 Huskies posted a 10-17 overall record and finished 5-15 in the NSIC, for a 13th place finish. St. Cloud State started the season with wins in three of their first four games including the NSIC opener, a 78-69 win over the University of Mary. The Huskies finished the season with two wins over their final four games.

THIRD YEAR IN THE NSIC: The 2010-11 season marks the third year of membership in the NSIC. The 2009-10 Huskies posted a 10-17 record and were 5-15 for 13th place in the league. In 2008-09 the Huskies posted a 22-9 overall record, went 12-8 in the NSIC to finish in sixth place, won the NSIC Sanford Health postseason tournament, and advanced to the NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament.

Coaching Staff

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish begins her third season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team and seventh overall as a collegiate coach in 2010-11.



Fish, a St. Cloud native, became the eighth coach in the history of the women's basketball program in July of 2008. She is very familiar with Husky basketball as she was an assistant coach under Dr. Lori Ulferts from 1999 to 2004.

In her first season with the Huskies, Fish guided St. Cloud State to a 22-9 overall record, won the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship, and an NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament appearance.

In 2009-10, the Huskies went 10-17 overall and 5-15 in the NSIC.

Fish has compiled a six-year career record of 94-79. During her career she has coached teams that have made six NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances including the 2009 St. Cloud State women.

A familiar name to the St. Cloud area, Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.

After assistant coaching stints at Eastern Illinois, South Dakota State and St. Cloud State, Fish was named the head coach at Minnesota State University, Mankato in 2004. She quickly

distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament. She compiled a 62-53 won/loss record with the Mavericks.

Assistant Coaches

Megan Vogel joined the women's basketball staff on July 1, 2010.



A native of St. Peter, Minn., Vogel graduated from South Dakota State University with a degree in HPER and was a four-year standout on the basketball court for the Jackrabbits. Vogel left SDSU as the second leading scorer in school history with 1,850 points, third all-time in three-point field goals with 194, and fifth all-time in rebounds with 783. She led the Jackrabbits to their first ever Division I post season tournament, advancing to the WNIT quarterfinals.

Upon graduation from SDSU, Vogel was drafted 19th overall in the 2007 WNBA draft by the Washington Mystics. During her season with the

Mystics, Vogel assisted with scouting and film breakdown of opponents. In 2008, she played for WWK Donau Ries of the German 1st League and led her team in scoring and rebounding.

Vogel's coaching experiences include serving as a volunteer assistant at Minnesota State University, Mankato in 2009-10, as a volunteer assistant at St. Peter High School in 2009 and as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota State during the 2007-08 season.

Alanna Wahl



completed her first season as a graduate assistant coach in 2009-10. Wahl played four years at Minnesota State University and earned a degree in physical education with a minor in coaching. She was an NCC Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll student and the recipient of the 2007 "Maverick Achievement Award".

LAST OUTING: The ninth-ranked Wayne State College Wildcats women's basketball team showed their muscle Tuesday night with a 69-42 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) win over St. Cloud State University.

Sophomore guard Amanda Wagner (Webster) led the Huskies with 11 points. She was nearly perfect on the night, making four of five field goals, one of one three-point attempts and two of two free throws. Senior guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada), and first year guards Sam Price (Eau Claire, Wis.) and Rachael Moen (Savage) each scored seven points. Moen was three for three from the field including one of one three-point attempts.

Wayne State scored the first basket of the game and never looked back. The Wildcats led 35-15 at half-time. Wayne State was led in scoring by Ashley Arlen with 18 points and Alyssa Fischbach pulled down ten rebounds. The Wildcats shot 46.3 percent from the field and made 13 of 16 free throw attempts.

QUICK TURNAROUND: Due to the weather conditions over New Year's weekend, the NSIC made changes to its Jan. 1-2 and Jan. 7-8 games. They were moved to Jan. 3-4 and Jan. 8-9. That meant the Huskies returned home late Tuesday night/early Wednesday morning from Wayne, Neb., and will be back on the court on Saturday at 2:00 p.m.

SERIES RECORDS: The Huskies have a 4-0 advantage over Upper Iowa in a series that began in 2005. In the only match up last season, SCSU won 81-60 at home. St. Cloud State is 23-10 all-time against Winona State in a rivalry that began in 1969. The Warriors beat the Huskies twice last season in NSIC play. The Huskies last win over Winona State was in the 2009 Sanford Health/NSIC tournament semifinal played in Winona.

BY THE NUMBERS: St. Cloud State is averaging 65.7 points and 35.4 rebounds per game heading into the weekend. The Huskies are shooting 39.8 percent from the field and 75.5 percent from the free throw line. SCSU is 2-1 at Halenbeck Hall this season. The Huskies suffered their first back to back losses of the season on Monday and Tuesday at Augustana and Wayne State.

The **Upper Iowa** Peacocks lone win was over Southwest Minnesota State, 53-49 on Dec. 18. Upper Iowa is averaging 56.8 points per game and 34.7 rebounds. They are 38.6 percent field goal shooters and are 69.1 percent from the line.

Winona State brings a four-game win streak into the weekend. The Warriors only loss was at Minnesota Duluth, 63-56, on Dec. 11. WSU averages 77.0 points and 32.9 rebounds per game. They are shooting 48.3 percent from the field, 38.5 percent from three-point range and 78.4 percent from the free throw line. The Warriors are receiving votes in this week's top 25 coaches poll.

CLOSE ONES: The Huskies have had four of their league games come down to the final seconds and/or final shot of the game. Those four league games were determined by a combined total of nine points. The three wins were by a total of six points. Talisha Barlow won the game against U-Mary on a layup with :11 seconds left on Dec. 3, Nicole Anderson beat Southwest Minnesota State at the buzzer on Dec. 10 and on Dec. 11 Minnesota State University beat the Huskies at the buzzer. On

Dec. 18, Sam Price scored two points on free throws with :13 seconds left to win the game against Concordia-St. Paul.

HUSKY LEADERBOARD: Three Huskies average double figures in scoring this week led by first year guard Sam Price (Eau Claire, Wis.) Price is averaging 10.9 points per game and is a 90 percent free throw shooter. First year forward Jessica Benson (Grand Meadow) who will miss the remainder of the season with a knee injury tops the Huskies in rebounding with 7.0 boards per game. She also averaged 10.8 points an outing. Senior guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) is scoring 10.3 points per game and is second on the team in rebounding with 5.4 boards per game.

CHART CLIMBER-Points & Rebounds: Barlow began the season ranked 20th on the all-time scoring list. This week she stands alone in 15th place on the chart with 1,296 career points. Barlow is also closing in on 500 career rebounds as she enters the week with 496 boards.

GIVING A CAREER ASSIST: Sophomore guard **Amanda Wagner** (Webster) leads the team in assists with 30 and has a team high 24 steals. She dished out a career high six assists in the Husky win over CSP on Dec. 18. Wagner opened the season with eight steals against the University of Wisconsin-Stout. The school record is ten. In 2009, she tallied eight steals in her collegiate debut against the same team, UW-Stout.

STARTING FOUR: Four Huskies have started all 11 games of the season and have missed a combined eight starts during their careers. The rookie Price has started all 11 games of her career. Wagner has started all 11 this season and 36 of 38 in her career. Sophomore guard Nicole Anderson (Cannon Falls) has started 11 this season and 37 of 38 career games, and Barlow has started 92 of 97 games during her career including all 11 this season.

IRON WOMAN: Barlow has played in every game, 97 straight, during her career with the Huskies. She has started 92 of those games, including 88 straight since Dec. 16, 2007.

FISH COLLECTED 100TH CAREER WIN ON DEC. 18: St. Cloud State head coach Lori Fish collected her 100th career win on Dec. 18, a 61-60 home victory over Concordia-St. Paul. In her sixth season as a head coach, she has compiled a current career record of 100-84.
