Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) Basketball

St. Cloud State Regular Season Finale

at Concordia University, St. Paul, Sat., Feb. 26, 6:00 p.m.

- ✓ St. Cloud State enters the final game of the regular season with a 12-13 overall record and a 9-12 mark in the NSIC. The Huskies are tied for tenth place in the league standings with Minnesota State University.
- ✓ Concordia University, St. Paul brings a 16-9 overall record and a 15-6 league mark into the game. The Golden Bears are tied for second place in the NSIC standings with Northern State.
- ✓ This is the final weekend of NSIC play in 2010-11. The top eight teams will advance to the NSIC/Sanford Health Women's Basketball Tournament beginning Wednesday, Mar. 2, at the home site of the top four seeds.
- ✓ The semifinals and championship final will be played at the Gangelhoff Center on the Concordia-St. Paul campus on Saturday and Sunday, Mar. 5-6.
- ✓ This is the second time around for these teams as the Huskies defeated Concordia-St. Paul, 61-60, on Dec. 18 in St. Cloud. Since losing that game, CSP has gone on a 13-3 run.
- ✓ Huskies are third-year members of the NCAA Division II Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC).
- ✓ Huskies posted a 10-17 overall record in 2009-10 and finished 13th in the NSIC with a 5-15 mark.
- ✓ The Huskies return 10 letterwinners from the 2009-10 season including five players with starting experience.

2009-10 SCSU SEASON RECAP: The 2009-10 Huskies posted a 10-17 overall record and finished 5-15 in the NSIC, for a 13th place finish. St. Cloud State started the season with wins in three of their first four games including the NSIC opener, a 78-69 win over the University of Mary. The Huskies finished the season with two wins over their final four games.

THIRD YEAR IN THE NSIC: The 2010-11 season marks the third year of membership in the NSIC. The 2009-10 Huskies posted a 10-17 record and were 5-15 for 13th place in the league. In 2008-09 the Huskies posted a 22-9 overall record, went 12-8 in the NSIC to finish in sixth place, won the NSIC Sanford Health postseason tournament, and advanced to the NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament.

Coaching Staff

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is in her third season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team and seventh overall as a collegiate coach in 2010-11.



Fish, a St. Cloud native, became the eighth coach in the history of the women's basketball program in July of 2008. She is very familiar with Husky basketball as she was an assistant coach under Dr. Lori Ulferts from 1999 to 2004.

In her first season with the Huskies, Fish guided St. Cloud State to a 22-9 overall record, won the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship, and an NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament appearance.

In 2009-10, the Huskies went 10-17 overall and 5-15 in the NSIC.

Fish has compiled a six-year career record of 94-79. During her career she has coached teams that have made six NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances including the 2009 St. Cloud State women.

A familiar name to the St. Cloud area, Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.

After assistant coaching stints at Eastern Illinois, South Dakota State and St. Cloud State, Fish was named the head coach at Minnesota State University, Mankato in 2004. She quickly

distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament. She compiled a 62-53 won/loss record with the Mavericks.

SEASON NOTE: On Dec. 19, 2010, Fish collected her 100th career coaching win. The milestone came in an exciting 61-60 win over Concordia University, St. Paul on the Huskies home court. Sam Price made two free throws with :13 seconds left in the game to preserve the win.

and was a four-year standout on the basketball court for the Jackrabbits. Vogel left SDSU as the second leading scorer in school history with 1,850 points, third all-time in three-point field goals with 194, and fifth all-time in rebounds with 783. She led the Jackrabbits to their first ever Division I post season tournament, advancing to the WNIT quarterfinals.

Upon graduation from SDSU, Vogel was drafted 19th overall in the 2007 WNBA draft by the Washington Mystics. During her season with the Mystics, Vogel assisted with scouting and film breakdown of opponents. In 2008, she played for WWK Donau Ries of the German 1st League and led her team in scoring and rebounding.

Vogel's coaching experiences include serving as a volunteer assistant at Minnesota State University, Mankato in 2009-10, as a volunteer assistant at St. Peter High School in 2009 and as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota State during the 2007-08 season.

Alanna Wahl completed her first season as a graduate assistant coach in 2009-10. Wahl played four years at Minnesota State University and earned a degree in physical education with a minor in coaching. She was an NCC Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll student and the recipient of the 2007 "Maverick Achievement Award".

LAST WEEKEND: The Huskies lost the final two home games of the season. St. Cloud State fell to Northern State, 65-52 on Friday and then dropped a 79-53 decision to the University of Mary on Saturday.

Northern State opened the second half on an 8-0 run to gain their largest lead of the game, 41-26 at the 17:51 mark. The Huskies didn't have their best shooting night of the season, but fought back to within seven points, 51-44 at the 10:47 mark on an Aaryn Booker jumper. With 5:44 to go, the Huskies once again closed the gap to seven points, this time on a three-point basket from Rachael Moen. Northern State shot 59.1 percent from the field that included a 63.2 percent pace in the second half. The Wolves had three players score in double figures led by senior forward Jodi Reinschmidt with 19 points. St. Cloud State was led in scoring by sophomore guard Nicole Anderson (Cannon Falls) with 11 points. Sophomore guard Amanda Wagner (Webster) pulled down eight rebounds to lead the Huskies. St. Cloud State forced 23 NSU turnovers, but shot 29.4 percent from the field.

The **University of Mary** shot over 50 percent in the first half and raced out to a 16 point lead by the ten minute mark. The Huskies shot 41.7 percent from the field in the first half and trailed the Marauders, 44-32 at halftime. The Marauders led from start to finish and made ten of 19 three-point attempts, shot 80.8 percent from the free throw line and out rebounded St. Cloud State, 37-33. U-Mary was led in scoring by sophomore guard Ali Collins with a game high 22 points. The Huskies were led by junior guard Jordi Gerking (Spirit Lake, Iowa) with 13 points and made three three-point attempts. Senior guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada),

on senior night, added 12 points and a team high seven rebounds. She also dished out four assists.

SPLITSVILLE: The Huskies have earned a split in six of the ten conference weekends this season. The exceptions were two losses at Augustana College and Wayne State on Jan. 3-4 and two losses at home to the same teams on Jan. 28-29. Feb. 11-12 the Huskies recorded their first NSIC sweep of the season, and last weekend lost two at home.

ON THE ROAD: St. Cloud State is 8-6 overall in road games and 5-5 in NSIC road games this season.

SERIES RECORDS: Saturday's game is the second between the Golden Bears and Huskies this season. Earlier, on Dec. 18, St. Cloud State defeated Concordia-St. Paul, 61-60. This will be the 21st match-up between these two teams since 1977. The Huskies have an 11-9 advantage over the Golden Bears and are 2-1 in the last three outings.

BY THE NUMBERS: The Huskies average 66.6 points and allow 67.4 points. SCSU averages 34.0 rebounds a game but are giving up 37.5 rebounds. The Huskies are shooting 39.7 percent from the field, 30.4 percent from three point range and 77.1 percent from the free throw line.

THREE IN A ROW: Twice this season the Huskies have won three games in a row. The Huskies won three early in the season, the final two non-conference games followed by the NSIC opener at U-Mary. In mid-February, SCSU ran off three wins against Upper Iowa, Minnesota State and Southwest Minnesota State on Feb. 5, 11 and 12. The NSIC weekend sweep on Feb. 11-12 was the first of the season for the Huskies and the first league road sweep since Jan. 9-10 of 2009. The Huskies won at Minnesota State 71-70 and at Southwest Minnesota State, 78-76 in double overtime to gain the sweep.

CLOSE ONES: The Huskies have had six of their league games come down to the final seconds and/or final shot of the game. Those six league games were determined by a combined total of 12 points. The five wins were by a total of nine points. Talisha Barlow won the game against U-Mary on a layup with :11 seconds left on Dec. 3, Nicole Anderson beat Southwest Minnesota State at the buzzer on Dec. 10 and on Dec. 11 Minnesota State University beat the Huskies at the buzzer. On

Dec. 18, Sam Price scored two points on free throws with :13 seconds left to win the game against Concordia-St. Paul. Jordi Gerking made two free throws with .2 seconds remaining to win the game on Feb. 12. On Feb. 13, Amanda Wagner's put back at the buzzer won the game in the second overtime.

OVERTIME?: The Saturday, Feb. 12 double overtime game at Southwest Minnesota State was the first overtime game for the Huskies since Dec. 29, 2007, a 68-67 loss at Sonoma State. It was the first overtime game under current head coach Lori Fish. It was the first double overtime game on record dating back to the 1977-78 season.

HUSKY LEADERBOARD: Senior guard **Talisha Barlow** (Little Canada) is the leading scorer on the team. She is averaging 12.8 points per game. First-year guard Sam Price (Eau Claire, Wis.) is averaging 11.7 points per game. Junior forward Aaryn Booker (Minneapolis) leads the team in rebounding with 5.9 boards a game.

BARLOW CLIMBS THE CHARTS: Barlow began the season ranked 20th on the all-time scoring list. She now stands in 10th place on the chart with 1,502 career points. She is the 11th Husky to score over 1,500 points in her collegiate career. Barlow pulled down her 500th career rebound against Winona State on Jan. 9 and has 564 in her career. She is the 22nd player to reach the 500 rebound plateau. She ranks 19th on the all-time rebounding chart. Barlow is the 16th player in school history to score 1,000 points and collect over 500 rebounds in a career.

DOUBLE THE FUN: Nicole Anderson and Aaryn Booker each recorded a double double in the win at SMSU on Feb. 12. Anderson, who wears #10 had ten points and ten rebounds for her second double double of the season. Booker also recorded ten points and ten rebounds for her first double double.

ABOUT CONCORDIA-ST. PAUL: In the first meeting of the season, back on Dec. 18, St. Cloud State's Sam Price made two free throws with :13 seconds left in the game to give the Huskies a 61-60 win. Price finished the game with 15 points for the Huskies. She made all four of her free throw attempts and was three of five from behind the arc. Jineen Williams of the Golden Bears led all players with 17 points. Jodi Batzel added ten points and ten rebounds for CU. The Golden Bears out rebounded the Huskies 43-35.

Since that loss to the Huskies, Concordia-St. Paul has posted a 13-3 record that includes a 13-game winning streak that propelled the Golden Bears into their current second place tie in the league standings.

Last weekend, the Golden Bears went 1-1 in games defeating U-May 108-74 and losing to Northern State, 60-57. The Golden Bears made 16 three-point baskets to tie a school record against U-Mary in the win. Senior guard Maurika Hickman averaged 23 points over the weekend. Hickman and Jineen Williams lead the team in scoring as they average 15.8 points each, and rank fourth and fifth in NSIC scoring. Teammate Zoraa Quoie leads the NSIC in steals with 3.28 per game.

Concordia University averages 73.2 points per game and have a +8.4 scoring margin over their opponents. The Golden Bears average 37.5 rebounds per game.

The Golden Bears are currently ranked sixth in the NCAA Division II Central Region rankings.

IRON WOMAN GAINS 100: Talisha Barlow started her 100th career game on Saturday, Jan. 29 for the Huskies. She played in her 100th career game on Friday, Jan. 14 against Bemidji State. She has played in every game, 111 straight, during her career with the Huskies. She has started 106 of those games, including 102 straight since Dec. 16, 2007. Her 106 career starts rank sixth on the all-time list.

STARTING FOUR: Four Huskies have started all 25 games of the season and have missed a combined eight starts during their careers. The rookie Price has started all 25 games of her career. Sophomore guard Amanda Wagner (Webster) has started all 25 this season and 50 of 52 in her career. Sophomore guard Nicole Anderson (Cannon Falls) has started 25 this season and 51 of 52 career games, and Barlow has started 106 of 111 games during her career including all 23 this season.

CAREER HIGH FOR BARLOW: Talisha Barlow scored a career high 34 points against SMSU on Feb. 12 to complete a weekend sweep in NSIC play. The 34 points marked the third time in her career that Barlow has scored over 30 points. Her previous career high was 31 points scored against UW-Stout on Nov. 15, 2009. She also had a 30 point game against U-Mary on Jan. 22, 2010.

CAREER HIGH FOR ANDERSON: Sophomore guard Nicole Anderson (Cannon Falls) pulled down a career high ten rebounds against SMSU on Feb.12. She also equaled her career high with six assists. Anderson, who wears #10, had ten points, ten rebounds and six assists. It marked the second double double of the season for Anderson. Earlier this season she tied the school record for steals in a game with ten against Bemidji State on Jan. 14. She shares the record with Dawn Anderson (1982) and Katie Tacheny (2008). Her previous career high was seven which she had swiped twice during her career. Anderson had eight steals in the first half alone and finished the game with her first collegiate double double as she scored 12 points to go with the ten steals. She leads the team with 68 steals and is second in assists with 52. This week she ranks second in the NSIC in steals with 2.86 per game.

CAREER HIGH FOR WAGNER: Sophomore guard Amanda Wagner (Webster) pulled in a career high 11 rebounds against SMSU on Saturday, Feb 12. She continues to lead the team in assists with 57 and is second on the team in steals with 50 She dished out a career high six assists in the Husky win over CSP on Dec. 18. Wagner opened the season with eight steals against the University of Wisconsin-Stout. The school record is ten. In 2009, she tallied eight steals in her collegiate debut against the same team, UW-Stout. Wagner is the Huskies top free throw shooter and has made 87.5 percent of her attempts. That ranks her second in the NSIC in free throw shooting percentage this week. She also ranks seventh in the league in steals.

TOPS FROM THE CHARITY STRIPE: The Huskies are one of the top free throw shooting teams in the country. This week, St. Cloud State is ranked sixth in NCAA Division II in free throw percentage with a team mark of 77.1 percent.

SENIOR GUARD TALISHA BARLOW

BARLOW TO BE HONORED: St. Cloud State women's basketball senior guard **Talisha Barlow** was honored Saturday in the Huskies annual senior day presentation.

Barlow has been the "Iron Woman" of Husky basketball over the last four years. She has played in every game, 111 straight, of her SCSU career. She has started in 106 of those games including 102 straight since Dec. 16, 2007.

Barlow has climbed the all-time scoring chart to 10th place with 1,502 points.. She also has 564 rebounds during her career and is the 16th player in school history to score 1,000 points and collect 500 rebounds.

Three times, she has scored 30 or more points in a game including her career high of 34 points in a 78-76 double overtime win at Southwest Minnesota State on Feb. 12. She was named the NSIC Player of the Week on Monday, Feb. 14.

Barlow is the 19th SCSU player to score 30 or more points in a game.

She is a two-time All-NSIC Second Team pick and an Academic All-NSIC team member. In 2009, she was named to the NSIC/ Sanford Health All-Tournament Team and the Daktronics All-Region Second Team.

On Feb. 14, she was named the NSIC Player of the Week.
