2009-10 SCSU SEASON RECAP: The 2009-10 Huskies posted a 10-17 overall record and finished 5-15 in the NSIC, for a 13th place finish. St. Cloud State started the season with wins in three of their first four games including the NSIC opener, a 78-69 win over the University of Mary. The Huskies finished the season with two wins over their final four games.

THIRD YEAR IN THE NSIC: The 2010-11 season marks the third year of membership in the NSIC. The 2009-10 Huskies posted a 10-17 record and were 5-15 for 13th place in the league. In 2008-09 the Huskies posted a 22-9 overall record, went 12-8 in the NSIC to finish in sixth place, won the NSIC Sanford Health postseason tournament, and advanced to the NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish begins her third season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team and seventh overall as a collegiate coach in 2010-11.



Fish, a St. Cloud native, became the eighth coach in the history of the women's basketball program in July of 2008. She is very familiar with Husky basketball as she was an assistant coach under Dr. Lori Ulferts from 1999 to 2004.

In her first season with the Huskies, Fish guided St. Cloud State to a 22-9 overall record, won the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship, and an NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament appearance.

In 2009-10, the Huskies went 10-17 overall and 5-15 in the NSIC.

Fish has compiled a six-year career record of 94-79. During her career she has coached teams that have made six NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances including the 2009 St. Cloud State women.

A familiar name to the St. Cloud area, Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.

After assistant coaching stints at Eastern Illinois, South Dakota State and St. Cloud State, Fish was named the head coach at Minnesota State University, Mankato in 2004. She quickly

distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament. She compiled a 62-53 won/loss record with the Mavericks.

Assistant Coaches

Megan Vogel joined the women's basketball staff on July 1, 2010.



A native of St. Peter, Minn., Vogel graduated from South Dakota State University with a degree in HPER and was a four-year standout on the basketball court for the Jackrabbits. Vogel left SDSU as the second leading scorer in school history with 1,850 points, third all-time in three-point field goals with 194, and fifth all-time in rebounds with 783. She led the Jackrabbits to their first ever Division I post season tournament, advancing to the WNIT quarterfinals.

Upon graduation from SDSU, Vogel was drafted 19th overall in the 2007 WNBA draft by the Washington Mystics. During her season with the

Mystics, Vogel assisted with scouting and film breakdown of opponents. In 2008, she played for WWK Donau Ries of the German 1st League and led her team in scoring and rebounding.

Vogel's coaching experiences include serving as a volunteer assistant at Minnesota State University, Mankato in 2009-10, as a volunteer assistant at St. Peter High School in 2009 and as a graduate assistant coach at South Dakota State during the 2007-08 season.

Alanna Wahl



completed her first season as a graduate assistant coach in 2009-10. Wahl played four years at Minnesota State University and earned a degree in physical education with a minor in coaching. She was an NCC Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll student and the recipient of the 2007 "Maverick Achievement Award".

LAST OUTING: Exciting home basketball continued as St. Cloud State first year guard Sam Price (Eau Claire, Wis.) made two free throws with :13 seconds left in the game to give the Huskies a 61-60 NSIC win over Concordia University, St. Paul on Dec. 18 in Halenbeck Hall. Down by eight points with 3:03 left on the clock, the Golden Bears fought back and the Husky lead was down to two, 59-57 after a Zoraa Quoie free throw with :16 seconds left in the game. The Huskies put the ball in the hands of Price who was fouled and went to the free throw line with :13 seconds on the clock. She made both to put the Huskies up 61-57. Maurika Hickman nailed a three with :05 seconds on the clock and the Husky defense held the Golden Bears after a pair of missed free throws gave CU one final attempt. Price finished the game with 15 points for the Huskies.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCED: The two games this weekend mark the second and third straight games in which the Huskies will face an NCAA playoff team from a year ago. It started on Dec. 18 with Concordia-St. Paul and now the first competition of the new year. Concordia-St. Paul, Augustana and Wayne State all advanced to the NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament in 2009-10. All three won first round tournament games and CU and Augustana advanced to the semifinals. The Golden Bears lost to Fort Lewis in the region championship game.

SERIES RECORDS: St. Cloud State and Augustana College will meet for the 54th time since the 1984 season on Saturday. The Vikings lead the all-time series 29-24. Augustana has won seven straight against the Huskies. The last Husky win was during the 1005-06 season in a first round game of the NCAA DII North Central Region tournament played in Grand Forks, N.D., 82-69.

The Huskies lead the series with Wayne State, 5-2. In the only meeting between the teams last year, the Wildcats won 66-52 in St. Cloud.

BY THE NUMBERS: St. Cloud State averages 68.2 points per game and are allowing 62.7 points. They trail their opponents in rebounding 36.9 to 35.7 and are shooting 40.5 percent from the field and 75 percent from the free throw line. SCSU averaged 11.8 assists and 11.7 steals per game.

Augustana is outscoring its opponents by 23.6 points per game. The Vikings average 81.0 points and shoot 44.8 percent from the field. AC averages 41.7 rebounds, 17.8 assists and 10.2 steals.

Wayne State holds a +15.4 scoring margin over their opponents, averaging 70.8 points per game. The Wildcats are +6.2 in rebounding with 38.4 boards per game. They average 10.3 assists and 7.8 steals.

CLOSE ONES: The Huskies have had four of their league games come down to the final seconds and/or final shot of the game. Four of the Huskies five NSIC games thus far were determined by a combined total of nine points. The three wins were by a total of six points. Talisha Barlow won the game against U-Mary on a layup with :11 seconds left on Dec. 3, Nicole Anderson beat Southwest Minnesota State at the buzzer on Dec. 10 and on Dec. 11 Minnesota State University beat the Huskies at the buzzer. On Dec. 18, Sam Price scored two points on free throws with :13 seconds left to win the game against Concordia-St. Paul.

HUSKY LEADERBOARD: Three Huskies average double figures in scoring this week led by first year guard Sam Price (Eau Claire, Wis.) Price is averaging 11.2 points per game and is an 88.9 percent free throw shooter. First year forward Jessica Benson (Grand Meadow) who will miss the remainder of the season with a knee injury tops the Huskies in rebounding with 7.0 boards per game. She also averaged 10.8 points an outing. Senior guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) is scoring 10.6 points per game and is second on the team in rebounding with 5.4 boards per game.

CHART CLIMBER: Barlow began the season ranked 20th on the all-time scoring list. Heading into the weekend, she is in 17th place with 1,278 career points. She is 15 points away from solo ownership of the 15th spot on the scoring chart.

GIVING A CAREER ASSIST: Sophomore guard **Amanda Wagner** (Webster) leads the team in assists with 26 and has 16 steals. She dished out a career high six assists in the Husky win over CSP on Dec. 18. Wagner opened the season with eight steals against the University of Wisconsin-Stout. The school record is ten. In 2009, she tallied eight steals in her collegiate debut against the same team, UW-Stout.

PRICE TAKES LEAD IN THREES: Sam Price leads the Huskies with 15 three-point field goals this season. She equaled her season high with three from beyond the arc against CSP.

IRON WOMAN: Barlow has played in every game, 95 straight, during her career with the Huskies. She has started 90 of those games, including 86 straight since Dec. 16, 2007.

ABOUT AUGUSTANA: The Vikings two losses of the season were on the road at Southwest Minnesota State University, 63-56 in the NSIC opener on Dec. 3 and at MSU Moorhead, 64-60 on Dec. 18. Head coach Dave Krauth is in his 22nd season with the Vikings and has compiled a 431-193 career won/loss record. In the NSIC statistical report for this week, the Vikings lead the league in scoring offense (81.0) and scoring margin (+23.6) in all games. Junior Molly Hayes leads the league in in assists and assist/turnover ratio. Megan Doyle is the leader in scoring with 16.0 points per game and Alex Feeney is the leading rebounder with 5.8 boards. Four players average double figures in scoring including Doyle, Feeney (13.3), Hayes (12.5) and Kristi Board (10.5).

ABOUT WAYNE STATE: The only Wildcat loss was a 61-60 non-conference set back at Colorado Christian on Nov. 19. Head coach Chris Kielsmeier is in his third year with the Wildcats and has compiled a 60-19 career record. Ashley Arlen leads the team in scoring with 15.8 points per game and Alyssa Fishback is the team leader in rebounding with 9.3 boards a game. In the NSIC stat report, Wayne State leads the league in scoring defense (55.4) this week in all games.
