- **St. Cloud State** finishes out a four game home stand this weekend when Minnesota State University and Southwest Minnesota State University come to town for Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) women's basketball action. The Huskies entertain Minnesota State on Friday at 6:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall. Saturday Southwest Minnesota State tips off at 4:00 p.m.
- Saturday is **Alumni Day**. St. Cloud State women's basketball alumni have been invited back to enjoy the game and play in their own game at 8:00 p.m. (following the Husky men). Alumni will be introduced at halftime of the women's game.
- **National Girls and Women in Sports Day** will be celebrated on Saturday as well. All girls and women will be admitted to the game free of charge.
- **Husky Basketball Fans!** Treat your family to a St. Cloud State University men's and women's basketball doubleheader at a reduced price. St. Cloud State is offering a **Basketball Family 4-Pack**. Purchase four tickets for \$20 (upper level seating only). These 4-packs can be purchased at the door and are available for all of the Huskies remaining home games February 10, 11 and 25.
- Last season the **Huskies** posted a 12-14 record and finished 9-13 in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC).
- The **Huskies** are in their fourth season as a member of the NSIC. SCSU won the 2009 Sanford Health/NSIC Tournament.
- **Minnesota State** tied for eighth in the NSIC with a 10-12 conference record and went 13-13 overall last season.
- **Southwest Minnesota State** posted a 7-19 overall record and 6-16 mark in the NSIC last season and finished 12th in the league.
- The Huskies, tied for eighth in the NSIC standings are looking for a top eight finish to advance to the NSIC/Sanford Health Conference Tournament. Following this weekend, SCSU has three games remaining on its regular season schedule.

- The NSIC weekend sweep was the second this season for the Huskies and first home sweep. The win over Winona ended a five game losing streak to the Warriors. SCSU has won five of its last eight games. The Huskies are 5-5 on their home court this season.
- The Huskies 97 point output against Upper Iowa last Saturday was the most points scored this season for SCSU and the most since scoring 100 points against Upper Iowa on Jan. 8, 2011.
- First year forward **Jessica Benson** (Grand Meadow) had a game high 20 points against the Peacocks and shot 61.5 percent from the field making 8 of 13 field goals. She also set a personal career mark with four assists. Against Winona State, Benson scored 11 points. She has scored in double figures in three straight games and nine this season. She has the only SCSU double double this season of ten points, 11 rebounds against Bemidji State on Jan. 13.
- Sophomore guard **Rachael Moen** (Savage) had a season and career high nine assists against Upper Iowa on Saturday. She was 11 of 12 from the free throw line over the weekend including 9 of 10 against Winona State. She made 5 of 6 in the final :38 seconds against the Warriors. Moen ranks second this week in the NSIC in free throw percentage (.868) in overall games played.
- Junior forward **Morgan Lof** (Detroit Lakes) had a season high four assists in the win over Upper Iowa. She made 4 of 4 free throws and scored four points.
- Senior post **Christina Steele** (Apple Valley) scored a season high ten points in the Huskies win over Upper Iowa on Saturday.
- Senior guard **Jordi Gerking** (Spirit Lake, Iowa) played in her 100th career game on Saturday, Jan. 28. She has played in 102 career games and been a starter in all 21 games this season. She has 86 made three-pointers in her career and ranks tenth on the all-time career chart for three-point baskets made.
- **NSIC Stats:** In overall games played junior guard **Nicole Anderson (Cannon Falls)** ranks second in steals per game with 2.38. **Amanda Wagner** is tied for ninth with 1.71 and **Aaryn Booker** is 12th with 1.67 steals
- **Gerking** and **Anderson** have been starters in all 21 games this season. Anderson has played in every game of her collegiate career, 74 and been a starter in 73. In addition junior guard **Amanda Wagner** (Webster) has played in all 74 games of her collegiate career and made 68 career starts. Sophomore guard **Rachael Moen** (Savage) has also played in every game of her collegiate career, a total of 47.
- St. Cloud State is averaging 64.2 points per game and allowing 63.0 this season. The Huskies are shooting 36.9 percent from the field and 74.4 percent from the free throw line.
- **Series Records:**
- St. Cloud State is 29-16 all-time against Southwest Minnesota State. The Huskies have won five straight over the Mustangs including a 72-61 win in Marshall on Dec. 9. This long time series began in 1970.
- The Huskies and Mavericks have one of the oldest rivalries in women's basketball dating back to 1969. Coach Fish is 3-4 against her previous team including a 60-46 loss at Mankato on Dec. 10.
- **About Minnesota State:** The Mavericks have lost four of their last six games and last weekend earned a home split, defeating Augustana College 98-95 in overtime and losing to Wayne State 83-45 the following night. MSU has three starters who have started every game of the 2011-12 season. They are led by Laura Weber with 12.7 points per game. The Mavericks average 65.7 points per game and are allowing 63.0. MSU is shooting 39.2 percent from the field.
- **About Southwest Minnesota State:** The Mustangs are in the midst of a nine-game losing streak. They are led by senior Abby Kenealy, the team's leading scorer (14.4 ppg) and rebounder (4.9 rpg). SMSU averaged 59.9 points per game and is giving up 66.7 points. Prior to this losing streak the Mustangs had a three game win streak against Upper Iowa, Minnesota, Crookston and MSU Moorhead.
- **New on the Radio Dial:** St. Cloud State men's and women's basketball has a new home on the radio dial in 2011-12. All Husky home and away games can be heard on **WMIN 1010 AM** and JW Cox will call the action. The broadcasts are also available on the web at www.wmin1010.com/. The **Above the Rim** weekly basketball coaches show also airs on 1010 AM every Wednesday during the season and is broadcast live from the Green Mill Restaurant in downtown St. Cloud from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.

Head Coach Lori Fish

St. Cloud, Minn., native Lori Fish is at home in her fourth season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2011-12 and her eighth overall as a collegiate coach.

During the 2008-09 season, her first season with the Huskies, Fish guided St. Cloud State to a 22-9 overall record, won the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship, and advanced to the NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament.

In 2009-10 the Huskies posted a 10-17 overall record and in 2010-11 were 12-14 overall.

On Dec. 18, 2010 Fish collected her 100th career coaching win. The milestone came in an exciting 61-60 win over Concordia University, St. Paul on the Huskies home court.

In seven seasons as a collegiate coach, Fish has compiled a 106-93 career record. In her three season at St. Cloud State she is 44-40.

She brought 19 years of coaching experience, including 17 years at the collegiate level to the Huskies' program. During her career she has coached teams that have made six NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances including the 2008-09 St. Cloud State women.

A familiar name to the St. Cloud area, Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State from 1986-1990 and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.

Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant.

In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons.

In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament. She compiled a 62-53 won/loss record with the Mavericks.
