Huskies Have Two Games on the Schedule This Week:

The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will play the third of three straight North Central Conference road games this Thursday, Feb. 7 and return home for the first of a three-game home stand on Saturday, Feb. 9. On Thursday, the Huskies will play at third-ranked University of North Dakota at 6:00 p.m. in the Betty Engelstad Center (3,064). On Saturday, the Huskies host 16th-ranked Minnesota State University, Mankato at 2:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall (6,927)

For the Record: St. Cloud State dropped to 9-12 overall and 1-5 in the NCC following an 81-77 loss at Nebraska-Omaha last Saturday. The University of North Dakota enters the week with a 20-1 overall mark and 5-1 NCC record. Minnesota State brings a 16-5 overall and 2-4 NCC record into the week. The Mavericks will host Minnesota Duluth on Thursday.

Alumni Day: Saturday is the women's basketball Alumni Day. Alumni will be introduced at half-time of the women's game. Immediately following the women's game, there will be a basketball social in Halenbeck Hall, followed by an Alumni Game at approximately 6:00 p.m., and a post-game gathering at Roster's in St. Cloud. "Think Pink" Slated for Feb. 14: The St. Cloud State women's basketball team in conjunction with the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) "Think Pink" campaign will hold its "Think Pink" night on Thursday, Feb. 14. The WBCA's "Think Pink" is Feb. 8-17, and is a breast cancer awareness initiative. The Huskies plan to emphasize breast cancer awareness by wearing pink wristbands, hair bands, and shoe laces. In addition, a ceremonial jump ball will take place with a pink and white basketball. There will be some in-game give aways, all in an effort to help raise breast cancer awareness.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

#40 Rengel is Senior Leader: Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) led the Huskies in scoring and rebounding with 21 points and seven rebounds in Saturday's 81-77 loss at UNO...Rengel scored the game tying basket with :29 seconds left highlighting a come-back from an 18-point deficit...leads the team in scoring and rebound with 14.1 points and 6.8 rebounds...collected her third double-double on Jan. 26 at UMD with 12 points, 11 rebounds...collected her second double-double on Jan. 17 vs. MSU with 23 points/13 rebounds, and her first double-double of the season on Nov. 28 against UW-Eau Claire with 22 points and 12 rebounds...newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,212 points which ranks 19th on the all-time list...has scored in double figures in 16 games this season and has started all 21 contests... named to the six member Hampton Inn & Suites Basketball Classic All-Tournament team at Sonoma State over the holidays...leads the NCC in blocked shots (league games) and ranks third in rebounding (league games) and seventh in NCC scoring this week.

#32 Booth Notes: First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has started all 21 games of her rookie season...averages 13.3 points and 5.7 rebounds per game...has scored in double figures in 17 games this season...named to the All-Tournament team at Sonoma State...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on Dec. 29...is tied for seventh in NCC scoring this week.

#4 Tacheny Notes: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) leads the Huskies with 76 assists and 57 steals this season...has started all 21 games and scored a career high 17 points against Minnesota Duluth on Jan. 12...one of four Huskies to average double figures in scoring with 10.8 points per game...ranks second in the NCC in steals.

#23 Ellison Notes: Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) has started 15 games this season...averages 6.0 points and 2.8 rebounds...she had six rebounds against UMD on Jan. 12 which matches her second best total this season...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on Dec. 28.

#11 Barlow Notes: First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) has had a solid rookie season with the Huskies...has played in all 21 games and started in 16 including the last 12 games...has scored in double figures in four of the last five games and 11 overall...has scored 14 or more points in four of the last five game...scored career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22...solid on the boards with a career high nine rebounds against UMD on Jan. 12.. averages 11.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.

#21 Cashman Notes: Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) leads the team with 39 three-point field goals...twice this season she has made five three-point baskets in a game.

#10 Scott Notes: Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) leads the NCC in steals this week... she has averaged seven points per game over the last six games and has 16 steals in that span...tallied her career high seven assists on Nov. 21 against MSU Moorhead.

#52 Rittenhouse Notes: The first-year post has played in all 21 games and made one start... scored a career high 12 points against Augustana on Jan. 19.

#34 Megan Foley: A sophomore guard, Foley has played in 11 games and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22.

#4 Jordi Gerking: Gerking, a first-year guard, has played in all 21 games...she scored a career high six points on two three-point baskets at UNO on Saturday.

#25 Heather Miller: A junior guard, Miller has gained playing time over the last couple of weeks...she has played in 14 games this season.

#2 Jennifer Waletzko: A sophomore forward, Waletzko has played in six games this season.

#30 Rebecca Kitzman: A first-year forward, Kitzman has played in six games.



The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

Series Records: North Dakota leads the all-time series with SCSU, 39-16. Over the last four meetings, the record is 2-2, and that includes a 91-58 NCC opening win for UND in St. Cloud on Jan. 10. UND is 8-2 against the Huskies over the last ten games...The Huskies hold the series advantage against Minnesota State University, Mankato 55-35. The Mavericks ended a 19-game losing streak to the Huskies on Jan. 17 with a 105-88 win in Mankato. SCSU is 9-1 against MSU over the last ten games.

North Dakota Notes: The University of North Dakota is ranked #3 in the Jan. 29 USA Today/ESPN Top 25 poll. UND was ranked second in the first NCAA Division II North Central Region poll which was released last Wednesday. The University of South Dakota was ranked first in the region. UND raced to a 17-0 record before falling to the University of South Dakota 70-67 on Jan. 19 in Grand Forks. Since then UND has won three straight including last Saturday's 90-49 victory of Augustana College. UND is led in scoring by senior center Ashley Langen with 16.3 points and 10.5 rebounds per game. Langen has scored over 1,000 points and grabbed over 1,900 rebounds in her career. UND is alone in second place in the NCC standings this week, behind the University of South Dakota.

Minnesota State Notes: The Mavericks are 1-3 since the Huskies played in Mankato on Jan.17. Since that meeting, MSU defeated Bemidji State in a non-conference game, and has lost three straight to nationally ranked teams Augustana, North Dakota and South Dakota. MSU started the season with a 10-0 record and went 14-1 in non-conference games. All five MSU losses have been to nationally ranked teams, including two to North Dakota. MSU is led in scoring by junior guard Heather Johnson with 16.5 points per game. Four of the Mavericks starters are averaging double figures in scoring this season.
