North Central Conference Opener: This week marks the 24th and final North Central Conference opener for the St. Cloud State women's basketball team. The Huskies will host #1 ranked University of North Dakota on Thursday, Jan. 10 at 6:00 p.m. On Saturday, Jan. 12, SCSU will host Minnesota Duluth at 2:00 p.m. Both games will be played in Halenbeck Hall (6,927) on the SCSU campus

For the Record: St. Cloud State enters the North Central Conference race with an 8-7 overall record. North Dakota is undefeated with a 15-0 record and Minnesota Duluth brings a 3-11 record into the week. UMD will play Minnesota State on Jan. 10.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The audio broadcast is available on the web at <http://www.1450knsi.com/pages/733727.php>. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.

Team Captains: Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

Opponent Notes.....

North Dakota Notes: North Dakota is the number one ranked team in NCAA Division II and has rattled off 15 straight wins. North Dakota is led by senior center Ashley Langen and junior forward Kierah Kimbrough. Langen averages 16.3 points while Kimbrough is dropping in 15.5 points per game. UND has won 11 NCC titles and last season won the North Central Region Championship to advance to the NCAA

Division II Elite Eight. UND has outscored their opponents by a 23.1 points per game margin, and average 79.8 points per game. They own a 14.4 rebounding margin, and average 44.3 boards per game.

St. Cloud State Team Notes: The Huskies have won three of their last four games with the loss coming in overtime at Sonoma State University by one point, 68-67. The Huskies have shot better than 53 percent from the field in two of their last three games and have shot over 50 percent four times this season. The Huskies had their best free throw shooting performance of the season on Jan. 5, making 20 of 21 attempts for a .952 average. St. Cloud State is averaging 76.8 points per game and allowing 74.9 points.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

St. Cloud State Player Notes

Rengel is Senior Leader: Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) leads the Huskies in scoring (14.0) and rebounding (6.2) this season...she was named to the six member Hampton Inn & Suites Basketball Classic All-Tournament team at Sonoma State over the holidays...she scored a season high 23 points against MSU Moorhead on Nov. 21 and collected her first double-double of the season on Nov. 28 against UW-EauClaire with 22 points and 12 rebounds...she is the newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,125 points which ranks 22nd on the all-time list...Rengel has scored in double figures in 11 games this season.

Booth Excels in Line-Up: First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) was also named to the All-Tournament team at Sonoma State...she recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on Dec. 29...Booth has scored in double figures in eight straight games and 12 this season...she averages 12.8 points and 5.8 rebounds, and leads the team with 28 blocked shots...Booth has started all 15 games this season.

Tacheny Assists and Steals: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) is the third Husky to start all 15 games this season, along with Rengel and Booth...she leads the team in assists (57) and steals (42), and averages 11.5 points per game...she has averaged five assists per game over the last three outings.

Ellison Lands Career High 18 Points: Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) has started the last five games for the Huskies and 12 this season...she has scored 37 points over the last three games, and scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on Dec. 28.

Barlow Nails Career High 24 Points: First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) has started the six games for the Huskies and ten this season...she has scored in double figures in three of the last four games, including her career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22...she has averaged 12.0 points and six rebounds over the last three games.

Cashman Gets Minutes: Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) is averaging 19.9 minutes of playing time this season...she has cashed in on 29 three-point baskets, a team high and is a 78 percent free throw shooter...twice this season she has made five three-point baskets in a game.

Scott Assists: Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) ranks third on the team in assists with 39 this season...she tallied her career high seven assists on Nov. 21 against MSU Moorhead...Scott equaled her season high of 11 points against Cardinal Stritch in the Huskies last outing.

Abby Rittenhouse: The first-year post has played in all 15 games and made one start...she scored a season high 10 points against Simpson College on Dec. 1.

Megan Foley: A sophomore guard, Foley has played in nine games and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22.

Jordi Gerking: Gerking, a first-year guard, has played in all 15 games, averaging seven minutes a game.

Heather Miller: A junior guard, Miller has been slowed by injury and has played in nine games.

Jennifer Waletzko: A sophomore forward, Waletzko has played in five games this season.

Rebecca Kitzman: A first-year forward, Kitzman has played in five games.
