**Huskies Travel to Mankato, Host Augustana in Second Week of NCC Schedule:**  
 St. Cloud State will hit the road for the first time in 2008 with a North Central Conference game scheduled for Thursday, Jan. 17 at 6:00 p.m. at 12th-ranked Minnesota State University, Mankato. On Saturday, Jan. 29, the Huskies return home for a 2:00 p.m. tip-off against Augustana College.

**For the Record:** St. Cloud State enters the week with a 9-8 overall record and 1-1 NCC mark. Minnesota State University is 14-2 overall and 1-1 in conference play and Augustana College enters the week with a 15-4 overall record and 1-1 NCC record.

**Roster Addition:** The Huskies have added a player to their roster. Sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) is a 6-1 transfer from Anoka Ramsey Community College and a graduate of North Branch High School. She will wear uniform number 13.

**On the Radio:** St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The audio broadcast is available on the web at <http://www.1450knsi.com/pages/733727.php>. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.

**Team Captains:** Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

**Minnesota State University Notes:** Minnesota State University is enjoying one of its best starts in recent history as both Maverick losses were at the hands of nationally ranked teams, #1 North Dakota

and #3 Concordia-St. Paul...Minnesota State is ranked 12th in NCAA DII in last week's coaches poll...junior guard Heather Johnson leads the team in scoring with 17.1 points...MSU head coach Lori Fish, a former SCSU assistant coach, is in her fourth season with the Mavericks...she has recorded a 39-44 career mark in three seasons at MSU.

**Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts**

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

**St. Cloud State Player Notes**

**Rengel is Senior Leader:** Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) leads the Huskies in scoring (13.6) and rebounding (6.2) this season...she was named to the six member Hampton Inn & Suites Basketball Classic All-Tournament team at Sonoma State over the holidays...she scored a season high 23 points against MSU Moorhead on Nov. 21 and collected her first double-double of the season on Nov. 28 against UW-EauClaire with 22 points and 12 rebounds...she is the newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,146 points which ranks 22nd on the all-time list...Rengel has scored in double figures in 12 games this season and has started all 17 contests...she is currently tied for the NCC lead in blocked shots with five.

**Booth Excels in Line-Up:** First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has started all 17 games of her rookie season...she has scored in double figures in ten straight games and opened NCC play with a combined 35 points, 12 rebounds, and five blocked shots...she was also named to the All-Tournament team at Sonoma State...she recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on Dec. 29... she averages 13.4 points and 5.8 rebounds...she is the NCC co-leader in blocked shots and free throw percentage, and ranks fifth in league scoring.

**Tacheny Lands Career High 17 Points:** Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) scored a career high 17 points against Minnesota Duluth on Saturday and is the third Husky to start all 17 games this season...she leads the team in assists (63) and steals (49), and leads the NCC in steals.

**Ellison Notes:** Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) has started the last seven games for the Huskies and 14 this season...she had six rebounds against UMD which matches her second best total this season...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on Dec. 28...is tied for the conference lead in free throw percentage having made four of four attempts last week.

**Barlow Hits Boards:** First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) has started eight straight games for the Huskies this season...she has scored in double figures in three of the last four games...scored her career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22...combined for 22 points and 14 rebounds in last week's NCC games...is tied for eighth in NCC rebounding.

**Cashman Notes:** Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) is averaging 20.1 minutes of playing time this season...she has cashed in on a team leading 32 three-point field goals and is a 79 percent free throw shooter...twice this season she has made five three-point baskets in a game.

**Scott Notes:** Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) combined for 14 points, nine rebounds and six assists in NCC games last week....she tallied her career high seven assists on Nov. 21 against MSU Moorhead...she ranks second in the NCC in steals this week.

**Rittenhouse Notes:** The first-year post has played in all 17 games and made one start... she scored a season high 10 points against Simpson College on Dec. 1.


**Megan Foley:** A sophomore guard, Foley has played in nine games and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22.

**Jordi Gerking:** Gerking, a first-year guard, has played in all 17 games, averaging seven minutes a game.

**Heather Miller:** A junior guard, Miller has been slowed by injury and has played in ten games.

**Jennifer Waletzko:** A sophomore forward, Waletzko has played in five games this season.

**Rebecca Kitzman:** A first-year forward, Kitzman has played in five games.



The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).
