Huskies Have One Game on NCC Schedule, Travel to Nebraska-Omaha on Saturday:

The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will play the second of three straight North Central Conference road games this Saturday, Feb. 2 when the Huskies tip-off against the University of Nebraska-Omaha at 2:00 p.m. in Sapp Fieldhouse (3,500) on the UNO campus.

For the Record: St. Cloud State dropped to 9-11 overall and 1-4 in the NCC following a 72-65 loss at the University of Minnesota Duluth last Saturday. The University of Nebraska-Omaha enters the week with a 15-5 overall record and 1-3 NCC mark. The Mavericks suffered two losses last week, falling at #6 South Dakota 78-57 and losing at home to #4 North Dakota 86-55.

Team Captains: Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

Roster Addition: The Huskies have added sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) to the roster. Graff is a 6-1 transfer from Anoka Ramsey Community College and a graduate of North Branch High School. She will wear uniform number 13.

Series Record: St. Cloud State leads the all-time series with Nebraska-Omaha, 28-19. The Huskies have won seven of the last ten meetings, and last year the teams split with each winning on the road as UNO won 71-70 and SCSU won 69-67. Prior to the UNO win on Jan. 27, the Huskies had won six straight in the series.

Nebraska-Omaha Notes: The Mavericks have lost two straight games and four of the last five after starting the season with a 14-1 record. The Mavericks average 74.2 points in overall games, but have dropped in league games, averaging 60.4 points and allowing 80.5 points in NCC play. Alyssa Green is the team scoring leader, averaging 13.2 points, while LaToya Wright hits the boards with a team leading 6.9 rebounds per game. Last season UNO posted a 16-12 overall record and finished seventh in the NCC with a 3-9 mark. Mavericks head coach Patty Patton Shearer is in her fourth season at UNO and eighth season as a collegiate head coach. She has a current won/loss record of 65-52 at UNO.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

St. Cloud State Player Notes

#40 Rengel is Senior Leader: In one game last week Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) recorded her third double-double of the season, and had an outstanding line in the box score...Rengel tallied 12 points, 11 rebounds, five assists, five steals, and five blocked shots...the five blocks and five steals equaled career game highs for Rengel..over the last three games she has collected 15 assists and 13 blocks..leads the Huskies in scoring and rebounding this season with 13.8 points and 6.8 rebounds....collected her second double-double on Jan. 17 vs. MSU with 23 points/13 rebounds, and her first double-double of the season on Nov. 28 against UW-Eau Claire with 22 points and 12 rebounds...newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,191 points which ranks 19th on the all-time list...has scored in double figures in 15 games this season and has started all 20 contests... named to the six member Hampton Inn & Suites Basketball Classic All-Tournament team at Sonoma State over the holidays...leads the NCC in blocked shots (league games).

#32 Booth Excels in Line-Up: First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has started all 20 games of her rookie season...averages 13.3 points and 5.7 rebounds per game..has scored in double figures in 16 games this season...in seven of the last eight games, she has shot over 50 percent from the field, including a season high 57.1% in back to back games against UMD and MSU...named to the All-Tournament team at Sonoma State...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on Dec. 29...averages 13.3 points and 5.7 rebounds.

#4 Tacheny Steal and Assist Leader: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) leads the Huskies with 72 assists and 54 steals this season...has started all 20 games and scored a career high 17 points against Minnesota Duluth on Jan. 12...one of four Huskies to average double figures in scoring with 10. points per game...81% free throw shooter...ranks second in the NCC in steals.

#23 Ellison Notes: Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) has started 15 games this season...averages 6.1 points and 2.8 rebounds...she had six rebounds against UMD on Jan. 12 which matches her second best total this season...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on Dec. 28.

#11 Barlow Hits Boards: First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) has had a solid rookie season with the Huskies...has played in all 20 games and started in 15 including the last 11 games...has scored in double figures in three of the last four games and ten overall...scored career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22..solid on the boards with a career high nine rebounds against UMD on Jan. 12.. averages 10.8 points and 4.9 rebounds.

#21 Cashman Notes: Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) leads the team with 38 three-point field goals...twice this season she has made five three-point baskets in a game.

#10 Scott Notes: Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) leads the NCC in steals this week... she has ramped up her game, averaging 7.0 points and 4.4 rebounds in league play...tallied her career high seven assists on Nov. 21 against MSU Moorhead.

#52 Rittenhouse Notes: The first-year post has played in all 20 games and made one start... scored a career high 12 points against Augustana on Jan. 19.

#34 Megan Foley: A sophomore guard, Foley has played in 11 games and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22.

#4 Jordi Gerking: Gerking, a first-year guard, has played in all 20 games, averaging 6.8 minutes a game.

#25 Heather Miller: A junior guard, Miller played a spirited 19 minutes at UMD last Saturday... recorded her season high four points and was two of two at the free throw line.

#2 Jennifer Waletzko: A sophomore forward, Waletzko has played in six games this season.

#30 Rebecca Kitzman: A first-year forward, Kitzman has played in six games.
