**Huskies Home For Two This Week:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will finish off a three-game North Central Conference home stand, the final home contests of the season, on Thursday, Feb. 14 against the University of Nebraska-Omaha and on Saturday, Feb. 16 against the University of South Dakota. Game time Thursday is 6:00 p.m. and Saturday is 2:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall (6,927) on the St. Cloud State campus.

**For the Record:** St. Cloud State is 10-13 overall and 2-6 in the NCC following an 82-47 loss at #3 University of North Dakota on Thursday night and a 76-62 win over #24 Minnesota State University last Saturday. Nebraska-Omaha enters the week with a 16-7 overall record and 2-5 mark in the NCC. Fourth-ranked South Dakota, the NCC leader, enters the week with a 20-1 overall record and 6-0 NCC mark. The Coyotes will play at Minnesota State on Thursday, before traveling to St. Cloud.

**Series Records:** St. Cloud State holds a 28-20 series advantage over Nebraska-Omaha. SCSU is 8-2 against UNO over the last ten games but the Mavericks have won two of the last three including an 81-77 win on Feb. 2. The Huskies have a 26-25 advantage over South Dakota and are 5-5 over the last ten games. SCSU has won three of the last four in the series.

**Senior Day:** Saturday is Senior Day for Husky Basketball. Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) will be honored prior to the game.



**"Think Pink" Stated for Feb. 14:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team in conjunction with the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) "Think Pink" campaign will hold its "Think Pink" night on Thursday, Feb. 14. The WBCA's "Think Pink" is Feb. 8-17, and is a breast cancer awareness initiative. The Huskies plan to emphasize breast cancer awareness by wearing pink wristbands, hair bands, and shoe laces. In addition, a ceremonial jump ball will take place with a pink and white basketball. There will be some in-game give aways, all in an effort to help raise breast cancer awareness.

**Team Captains:** Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

**Roster Addition:** The Huskies have added sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) to the roster. Graff is a 6-1 transfer from Anoka Ramsey Community College and a graduate of North Branch High School. She will wear uniform number 13.

**On the Radio:** St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. **Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts**

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

## St. Cloud State Player Notes

**#40 Rengel is Senior Leader:** Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) leads the Huskies in scoring and rebounding with 13.6 ppg and 6.6 rpg...tallied a career high six blocked shots against Minnesota State University last Saturday...collected her third double-double on Jan. 26 at UMD with 12 points, 11 rebounds...collected her second double-double on Jan. 17 vs. MSU with 23 points/13 rebounds, and her first double-double of the season on Nov. 28 against UW-Eau Claire with 22 points and 12 rebounds...newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,227 points which ranks 18th on the all-time list...has 50 blocks this season and 141 in her career which ranks fifth on the career chart...has scored in double figures in 17 games this season and has started all 23 contests... named to the six member Hampton Inn & Suites Basketball Classic All-Tournament team at Sonoma State over the holidays...leads the NCC in blocked shots (league games)with 3.38 per game, is fourth in rebounding and steals, and eighth in NCC scoring this week.

**#32 Booth Notes:** First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has started all 23 games of her rookie season...averages 12.6 points and 5.5 rebounds per game...has scored in double figures in 17 games this season...named to the All-Tournament team at Sonoma State...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on Dec. 29...is one of three rookies to rank in the top ten in league scoring...tied for tenth in scoring and ranks fourth in blocks.

**#4 Tacheny Notes:** Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) equaled her career high in scoring with a 17-point performance at UND...leads the Huskies with 84 assists and 64 steals this season...has started all 23 games...one of four Huskies to average double figures in scoring with 11.0 points per game...leads the NCC in steals with 2.75, ranks eighth in assists and ninth in free throw percentage.

**#23 Ellison Notes:** Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) has started 15 games this season...averages 5.7 points and 2.6 rebounds...she had six rebounds against UMD on Jan. 12 which matches her second best total this season...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on Dec. 28.

**#11 Barlow Notes:** First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) has had a solid rookie season with the Huskies...has played in all 23 games and started in 18 including the last 14 games...has scored in double figures in five of the last seven games and 12 overall...scored a game high 20 points against MSU last Saturday...scored career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22...solid on the boards with a career high nine rebounds against UMD on Jan. 12... averages 11.0 points and 4.9 rebounds...is tied for tenth in league scoring this week.

**#21 Cashman Notes:** Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) leads the team with 42 three-point field goals...twice this season she has made five three-point baskets in a game.

**#10 Scott Notes:** Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) has been a defensive spark for the Huskies the last several games...has started the last four games and is averaging seven points a game over the last eight...tallied her career high seven assists on Nov. 21 against MSU Moorhead...ranks fourth in the NCC in steals.

**#52 Rittenhouse Notes:** The first-year post has played in all 23 games and made one start...scored a career high 12 points against Augustana on Jan. 19.

**#34 Megan Foley:** A sophomore guard, Foley has played in 12 games and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22.

**#4 Jordi Gerking:** Gerking, a first-year guard, has played in all 23 games...she has scored a career high six points on two three-point baskets at UNO and at UND in the last week.

**#25 Heather Miller:** A junior guard, Miller has gained playing time over the last couple of weeks... she has played in 16 games this season.

**#2 Jennifer Waletzko:** A sophomore forward, Waletzko has played in seven games this season.

**#30 Rebecca Kitzman:** A first-year forward, Kitzman has played in seven games.

Husky Team Notes: St. Cloud State broke a five game losing streak with a 76-62 NCC win over #24 Minnesota State University, Mankato last Saturday...as a team, the Huskies lead the NCC in blocked shots and are second in steals this week...three Huskies, including two first year players rank in the top ten in league scoring this week...senior F Kayla Rengel is eighth with 12.8 ppg...first year guard Talisha Barlow and first year center Rachel Booth are tied for tenth with 12.3 ppg...only one other first year player ranks in the top ten in league scoring...the Huskies average 74.3 points per game this season...UND held SCSU to its lowest point total of the year, 47 points last Thursday...the Huskies have four league games remaining, including two against league leading South Dakota...all three teams that the Huskies will face in the coming weeks are ranked in the region and two are nationally ranked.

Nebraska-Omaha Notes: The Mavericks of UNO have only played one game since hosting the Huskies on Feb. 2. UNO hosted South Dakota last Saturday and fell to the Coyotes 78-66. The Mavericks have lost six of the last eight games after opening the season with a 14-1 record. Sophomore guard Alyssa Green leads the team in scoring with 13.9 points. Junior LaToya Wright is the top rebounder on the team with 7.0 boards per game. UNO is ranked ninth in the North Central Region as of the Feb. 6 poll. The Mavericks average 73.7 points and have allowed 62.7 in all games. Conversely, in NCC play, UNO averages 68.0 points and allows 79.6. UNO head coach Patty Patton Shearer is in her fourth season with the Mavericks.

South Dakota Notes: The Coyotes won a school record 18th straight game last Saturday at UNO and lead the NCC with a 6-0 mark (coming into the week as USD plays at Mankato on Thursday). The Coyotes are 7-0 on the road this season which includes a 70-67 win at then top-ranked North Dakota. USD holds the top ranking in the North Central Region and a fourth place rank in the national poll. The Coyotes are led in scoring by senior guard Jeana Hoffman with 18.3 points per game. Sister Jenna Hoffman is the leading rebounder on the team with 6.4 boards. USD averages 78.5 points per game and has allowed 59.9 this season. Head coach Chad Lavin is in his 20th season with the Coyotes.
