Huskies Finish Out Regular Season on the Road Starting in Sioux Falls: The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will finish out the North Central Conference regular season on the road beginning this Saturday in Sioux Falls, SD. The Huskies will tip off against 23rd-ranked Augustana College at 6:00 p.m. in the Elmen Center on the Augustana campus. The Huskies will play the final game of the regular season on Saturday, March 1 at the University of South Dakota.

For the Record: St. Cloud State is 11-14 overall and 3-7 in the NCC following a 67-62 loss to the University of South Dakota last Saturday. Augustana College is 20-6 overall and 6-3 in the league. The Vikings are in third place in the league standings while the Huskies are in fifth place.

Series Records: Augustana leads the all-time series with the Huskies 25-24. The Vikings defeated SCSU on Jan. 19, 84-61 in St. Cloud. AC has won three straight games in the series and are 7-3 against SCSU over the last ten games.

In the Polls: Augustana dropped out of the Top 25 this week after being ranked 23rd in the Feb. 12 USA Today/ESPN Top 25 Coaches poll. The Vikings are ranked fourth in the latest NCAA Division II North Central Region poll released on Feb. 13. The next region poll will be released on Feb. 20.

Final Two Weeks of the NCC: The final season of North Central Conference is winding down. Two weeks remain in the regular season schedule. That will be followed by North Central Conference Tournament on March 5, 8 and 9. The regular season champion receives a bye in the first round of the tournament and will host the semifinals and finals. The other six teams will be seeded according to their finish in the NCC standings. On March 5, the #2 seed will host #7, #3 will host #6, and #4 will host #5.

Team Captains: Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

Roster Addition: The Huskies have added sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) to the roster. Graff is a 6-1 transfer from Anoka Ramsey Community College and a graduate of North Branch High School. She will wear uniform number 13.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The audio broadcast is available on the web at <http://www.1450knsi.com/pages/733727.php>. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

St. Cloud State Player Notes

#40 Rengel is Senior Leader: Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) had solid outings last week against two regionally ranked teams...recorded her fourth double-double of the season against UNO with 11 points/10rebounds and came back with 17 points against fourth ranked USD...tallied a career high six blocked shots against Minnesota State University on 2/9...collected her third double-double on Jan. 26 at UMD with 12 points, 11 rebounds...collected her second double-double on Jan. 17 vs. MSU with 23 points/13 rebounds, and her first double-double of the season on Nov. 28 against UW-Eau Claire with 22 points and 12 rebounds...newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,255 points which ranks 17th on the all-time list...has 55 blocks this season and 146 in her career which ranks fifth on the career chart...has scored in double figures in 19 games this season and has started all 25 contests... named to the six member Hampton Inn & Suites Basketball Classic All-Tournament team at Sonoma State over the holidays...leads the NCC in blocked shots (league games) this week and ranks eighth in scoring.

#32 Booth Notes: First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has started all 25 games of her rookie season...averages 12.8 points and 5.4 rebounds per game...has scored in double figures in 19 games this season...named to the All-Tournament team at Sonoma State...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on Dec. 29...is one of two rookies to rank in the top ten in league scoring...ranked ninth in NCC scoring and fourth in blocks.

#4 Tacheny Notes: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) recorded two career highs last week as she scored a career high 18 points against USD on Saturday and equaled her career high of eight rebounds against UNO on Thursday...leads the Huskies with 88 assists and 69 steals this season...has started all 25 games ...one of four Huskies to average double figures in scoring with 11.1 points per game...leads the NCC in steals this week.

#23 Ellison Notes: Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) has started 15 games this season...averages 5.4 points and 2.6 rebounds...she had six rebounds against UMD on Jan. 12 which matches her second best total this season...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on Dec. 28.

#11 Barlow Notes: First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) has had a solid rookie season with the Huskies...has played in all 25 games and started in 20 including the last 16 games...has scored in double figures in 13 games...scored career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22...tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds... ten rebounds was also a career high...averages 11.1 points and 5.0 rebounds...is tied for tenth in league scoring this week.

#21 Cashman Notes: Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) leads the team with 42 three-point field goals...twice this season she has made five three-point baskets in a game.

#10 Scott Notes: Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) has been a defensive spark for the Huskies the last several games...has started the last six games and is averaging seven points a game over the last ten...tallied her career high seven assists on Nov. 21 against MSU Moorhead...ranks fourth in the NCC in steals.

#52 Rittenhouse Notes: The first-year post has played in all 25 games and made one start...scored a career high 12 points against Augustana on Jan. 19.

#34 Megan Foley: A sophomore guard, Foley has played in 12 games and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22.

#4 Jordi Gerking: Gerking, a first-year guard, has played in all 25 games...she scored a career high eight points against UNO on 2/14...equaled her career high of two assists on 2/16.

#25 Heather Miller: A junior guard, Miller has gained playing time over the last couple of weeks... she has played in 18 games this season.

#2 Jennifer Waletzko: A sophomore forward, Waletzko has played in seven games this season.

#30 Rebecca Kitzman: A first-year forward, Kitzman has played in seven games.



Husky Team Notes/Opponents Section

A Perfect Mark: Against South Dakota on Saturday, the Huskies were a perfect 22 of 22 from the free throw line...the 22 free throws marked the second most made in a game by a Husky team (the record is 27 of 27 set in 1982)...junior G Katie Tacheny made ten free throws and led the team in scoring with 18 points...four of the Huskies starters scored in double figures as Rengel made seven free throws and finished with 17 points...FY post Rachel Booth made three FT's and tallied 15 points...junior G Krystal Scott scored ten points including two free throws.

Husky Team Notes: St. Cloud State split in games against regionally ranked opponents last week...the Huskies won their second straight with a 70-63 win over ninth (region) ranked Nebraska-Omaha...SCSU nearly upset league leader and the #1 team in the region, South Dakota on Saturday, losing 67-62 on their home floor...the Huskies combined to out-rebound both UNO (+11) and USD (+5), marking the third time this season that SCSU has outrebounded opponents in back to back games...SCSU is averaging 73.7 points per game and allowing 76.1.

Leading the NCC in Blocks and Steals: As a team, the Huskies lead the NCC this week in steals with 10.80 per game and blocked shots with 5.80.

Augustana College Notes: The Vikings will travel to Minnesota State University, Mankato on Thursday, Feb. 21 before playing host to the Huskies on Feb. 23. Augustana has lost two of their last three games, both losses against the University of North Dakota. UND defeated the Vikings 83-75 on 2/14. Augustana is 7-3 on their home court this season. Junior guard Amy Puthoff leads the Vikings in scoring with 14.2 points per game. First year guard Molly Hayes is second in scoring for the Vikings with 13.4 points per game. She also leads the team with 122 assists. Senior center Ashley Holiday suffered a season ending knee injury and missed last week's game against UND after starting all 24 games this season. She led the Vikings in blocked shots and had tallied eight double-doubles this season. She had been averaged 13.4 points and 8.0 rebounds. Th Vikings average 73.8 points per game and are allowing 66.0 points this season. Dave Krauth is in his 19th year as head coach of the Vikings and owns a 374-172 career record.
