Huskies Finish Out Regular Season at South Dakota on Saturday: The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will finish out the North Central Conference regular season on Saturday, March 1 at the University of South Dakota. The tip-off is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. at the DakotaDome on the USD campus.

For the Record: St. Cloud State is 11-15 overall and 3-8 in the NCC following a 74-64 loss at Augustana College last Saturday. South Dakota, ranked fourth in the Feb. 19 ESPN/USA Today Women's Basketball Coaches poll, enters the week with a 24-1 overall record and 10-0 mark in the NCC. The Coyotes will host Augustana College on Thursday night before taking on the Huskies in Saturday's matinee.

Series Records: The series featuring the Huskies and Coyotes is tied at 26-26 following SCSU's 67-62 loss to USD back on Feb. 16. USD has won two straight in the series and the team's are 5-5 over the last ten outings.

In the Polls: South Dakota was ranked #4 in the Feb. 19 USA Today/ESPN Top 25 Coaches poll. The Coyotes are the #1 ranked team in the North Central Region when the last ranking was announced on Feb. 20. South Dakota has clinched a share of the 2008 North Central Conference title and will be the host of the NCC women's basketball tournament semi finals and finals on March 8 and 9.

Final Week of the NCC: The final season of North Central Conference play is winding down as this is the final week of regular season play. The North Central Conference Tournament follows on March 5, 8 and 9. The regular season champion (South Dakota) receives a bye in the first round of the tournament and will host the semifinals and finals. The other six teams will be seeded according to their finish in the NCC standings. Five of the seven seeds have been determined while only the #5/#6 seed between Nebraska-Omaha and St. Cloud State is yet to be determined. On Wednesday, March 5, the #2 seed North Dakota will host #7 Minnesota Duluth, #3 seed Augustana will host either SCSU or UNO and #4 seed Minnesota State will host either SCSU or UNO.

Team Captains: Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

Roster Addition: The Huskies have added sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) to the roster. Graff is a 6-1 transfer from Anoka Ramsey Community College and a graduate of North Branch High School. She will wear uniform number 13.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The audio broadcast is available on the web at <http://www.1450knsi.com/pages/733727.php>. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

#32 Booth Notes: First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has started all 26 games of her rookie season...led the Huskies in scoring with 17 points against Augustana last Saturday...

#4 Tacheny Notes: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) had 14 points and seven rebounds against Augustana on 2/23.. scored a career high 18 points against USD on 2/16 and equaled her career high of eight rebounds against UNO on 2/14....

#23 Ellison Notes: Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) has started 15 games this season and played in all 26...averages 5.3 points and 2.6 rebounds...

#11 Barlow Notes: First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) has has played in all 26 games and started in 21 including the last 17 games...has scored in double figures in 14 games...

#21 Cashman Notes: Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) leads the team with 42 three-point field goals...twice this season she has made five three-point baskets in a game...

#10 Scott Notes: Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) has started the last seven games... has 20 points and ten rebounds over the last two games...

#52 Rittenhouse Notes: The first-year post has played in all 26 games and made one start...scored a career high 12 points against Augustana on Jan. 19.

Husky Team Notes/Opponents Section

Streak Ends: The Huskies had a streak of 36 straight free throws made come to an end in the second half of Saturday's 74-64 loss at Augustana College...since the second half of SCSU's game against UNO on Feb. 16, the Huskies had not missed a free throw, including a 22 of 22 free throws made performance against South Dakota on 2/16. The Huskies have only missed three free throws over the last three games.

Husky Team Notes: The Huskies are 2-2 over the last four games and have played solid first halves against top ranked South Dakota and Augustana College...SCSU averaged 73.3 points per game and is allowing 76.0 points per game...after hitting the boards on an even pace with Augustana, 38 each, the Huskies have closed the rebounding gap to -1.8...SCSU is averaging 36.7 rebounds per game while the opponents are averaging 38.6...the Huskies have been even or out rebounded the opponents in the last three games.

Leading the NCC in Blocks and Steals: As a team, the Huskies lead the NCC this week in blocked shots and are second in free throw percentage, rebounding defense, and offensive rebounds.

The Last Time: St. Cloud State nearly upset the Coyotes in Halenbeck Hall on Feb. 16. The Huskies controlled the tempo in the first half, went on a couple of scoring runs, overcame a USD scoring run and went into half-time with a 28-27 lead. USD opened the second half with a 16-6 run to give the Coyotes the largest lead of the game at 43-34...the Huskies fought their way back into the game and came within three points three times in the final minute of play...USD held on for the 67-62 win...Katie Tacheny led the Huskies in scoring with 18 points and Jenna Hoffman led the Coyotes with 14 points.

About South Dakota: The Coyotes are riding a 22-game winning streak and have clinched at least a share of the 2008 NCC title...this marks the fifth time that USD has won at least a share of the NCC title and the first since 2002-03...South Dakota leads the NCC in scoring defense, three-point field goal defense, turnover margin, and assist/turnover ratio...USD's lone loss this season was a non-conference tilt against Adams State, 83-79 on Nov. 23, 2007...senior guard Jeana Hoffman leads the team in scoring with 17.8 points per game...she also has a team high 88 three-point baskets...Chad Lavin is the USD head coach.
