### FINAL RELEASE: March, 2008

**Huskies Post 11-17 Record in Final Season of North Central Conference Membership:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team posted an 11-17 overall record in 2007-08, the final season of competition in the North Central Conference. The Huskies were 8-8 in non-conference games and 8-5 in games played at Halenbeck Hall.

**Conference Finish:** St. Cloud State finished fifth in the NCC with a 3-9 record. As the #5 seed, SCSU faced Minnesota State University, Mankato, the #4 seed in the quarterfinals of the NCC post season tournament. Minnesota State posted a 73-71 win on March 5, bringing the Huskies season to an end.

### Rengel Named to All-North Central Conference Team:

St. Cloud State senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) was named to the 2007-08 All-North Central Conference team. The ten member team was voted on by the league coaches. Rengel, the lone senior on the St. Cloud State squad this season, led the Huskies in scoring, rebounding and blocked shots. She averaged 13.5 points per game, 6.6 rebounds per game, and had a team high 61 blocked shots. Rengel started all 28 games for the Huskies. She led the NCC (league games only) in blocked shots and ranked fourth in the league in rebounding, sixth in assists, and ninth in scoring.



### Three Named to Commissioner's

**Academic Honor Roll:** Three St. Cloud State players were named to the 2007-08 NCC Commissioner's Academic Women's Basketball Honor Roll. Sophomore guard Jen Waletzko (St. Cloud), and junior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Heather Miller (Sun Prairie, WI) were honored for maintaining a minimum 3.20 grade point average. Waletzko is a pre-physical education major, while Cashman and Miller are nursing majors.

**Final NCC Championship:** The final NCC women's basketball championship was won by the University of South Dakota. The Coyotes finished the regular season with a 12-0 record. USD went on to defeat the University of North Dakota 72-69 in the championship game of the NCC tournament at the DakotaDome in Vermillion, SD.

**Team Captains:** Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) captained the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

## Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) completed her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 14 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 219-178 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 219 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts also completed her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 381-267 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. She coached the NCAA Division II Player of the Year Erika Quigley. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

St. Cloud State assistant coach Carol Thelen has completed her second season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.

The 2007-08 school year marks the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).

St. Cloud State Player Notes

**#40 Kayla Rengel Notes:** Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) started all 28 games of her senior campaign... led the team in scoring and rebounding with 13.5 points and 6.6 rebounds... was the leading shot blocker on the team with 61... tallied four double doubles during the season and scored in double figures 12 times...tallied a career high six blocked shots against Minnesota State University on 2/9/08....newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,292 points which ranks 15th on the all-time list...has 152 blocks in her career which ranks fifth all-time...also ranked sixth in the career charts in steals (181) and three point field goals made (11), seventh in three-point field goal attempts (317), and eighth in games played (116)...named to the UMD The Edge Thanksgiving Classic All-Tournament team and the Hampton Inn & Suites Basketball Classic All-Tournament team at Sonoma State...NCC leader in blocked shots...ranked fourth in rebounding and ninth in scoring in league games... member of the 2004-05 and 2005-06 Husky squads that won the NCAA Division II North Central Region titles and advanced to the NCAA Division II Elite Eight in both of those years... Huskies advanced to the semi-finals of the national tournament in 2006.



**#3 Katie Tacheny Notes:** Junior guard and co-captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) started all 28 games this season...scored a career high 18 points against USD on 2/16 and equaled her career high of eight rebounds against UNO on 2/14....averaged 11.5 points and 4.1 rebounds...notched a career high six steals versus Glenville College on 12/8/07...had eight games where she was perfect from the free throw line...led the NCC in steals.



**#32 Rachel Booth Notes:** First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) started first 27 games of her rookie season...suffered a knee injury in the first 30 seconds of second to the last game of the season and did not play in the final game..averaged 12.5 points and 5.3 rebounds for the Huskies...scored in double figures in 20 games... named to the All-Tournament team at Sonoma State...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07...is one of two rookies to rank in the top ten in league scoring...ranked tenth in NCC scoring and fourth in blocks... career highs of 22 points, 17 rebounds, and six blocks.



**#11 Talisha Barlow Notes:** First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) played in all 28 games and started in 23 including the last 19 games of the season...she started her collegiate career with back to back ten and 20 point games, and went on to record double figures in scoring in 15 games...scored career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on 12/22/07, making ten of 13 field goal attempts..tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08... ten rebounds was also a career high...had season/career highs of six assists and five steals...named NCC Player of the Week on 12/10/07...averaged 11.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.



**#10 Krystal Scott Notes:** Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) started the last nine games and played in all 28 this season...tallied her career high seven assists on 11/21/07 against MSU Moorhead... averaged 6.0 points and 3.1 rebounds per game.

**#23 Danielle Ellison Notes:** Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) started 16 games this season and played in all 28... averages 5.3 points and 2.7 rebounds...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07...equaled her career highs in rebounds (8), assists (4) and steals (3).



**#2 Jennifer Waletzko:** A sophomore forward, Waletzko played in eight games.

**#4 Jordi Gerking:** Gerking, a first-year guard, played in all 28 games...she scored a career high eight points against UNO on 2/14... had career high of two assists on 2/16...had career high four rebounds on 11/17/07.



**#13 Marlayna Graff:** Graff transferred to SCSU from Anoka Ramsey Community College midway through the season. She was a 2007-08 redshirt.

**#21 Anna Cashman Notes:** Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) led the team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...pulled career high five rebounds twice during the season... twice during the season she made five three-point baskets in a game...played in 27 games and made two starts...named to the UMD The Edge Thanksgiving Classic All-Tournament Team...averaged 7.5 points...tallied career highs in points (23), rebounds (5), assists (4), and steals (2).



**#25 Heather Miller:** A junior guard, Miller played in 21 games, scoring 14 points and grabbing 26 rebounds. this season...had a season high six rebounds at UWEC on 11/28/07.

**#30 Rebecca Kitzman:** A first-year forward, Kitzman played in eight games.



**#34 Megan Foley:** A sophomore guard, Foley played in 13 games and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on 12/22/07...averaged 1.5 points per game.

**#52 Abby Rittenhouse Notes:** The first-year post played in all 28 games and made one start...scored a career high 12 points against Augustana on 1/19/08...twice tallied season and career high six rebounds.



**Team Notes**

**A Look Back at the NCC:** The Huskies have been members of the NCC since the 1984-85 season... SCSU shared the NCC title (NDSU) in 1988-89 with an 11-3 record...twice during that span, the Huskies boasted the NCC Player of the Year... in 2007, it was Erika Quigley, SCSU's all-time scoring and rebounding leader...in 1996, it was Brenda Meyer...in all, SCSU players were honored 30 times as All-NCC team members...SCSU had one Defensive Player of the Year in Jennifer Higgins (2000) and three first year players in Quigley (2004), Andrea Shogren (2001)...Quigley was a four-time All-North Central Conference first team selection during her career from 2004-2007...three-time first team selections include Sarah Howard (1986, 1987, 1988), Tina Schreiner (1998, 2001, 2002) and Christine Williamson (1998, 1999, 2001).

**Leading the NCC in Blocks:** As a team, the Huskies led the NCC in blocked shots with 5.25 per game during the 12-game league schedule. The next closest average of 4.00 blocks per game was shared by Augustana College and NCC Champion South Dakota.

**Free Throw Streak:** The Huskies had a streak of 36 straight free throws during the season that stretched from the second half of the UNO game on Feb. 14 (eight straight), continued on Feb. 16 against South Dakota with a 22 of 22 team performance, and ended on Feb. 23 at Augustana College with six straight.
