Minnesota State University Mankato Pepsi Tip-Off Gets SCSU Season Underway: The St. Cloud State University women's basketball team will officially open the 2007-08 season at the Minnesota State University Mankato Pepsi Tip-Off Friday and Saturday, Nov. 16 and 17. The Huskies will open on Friday at 1:00 p.m. against Northwood University. On Saturday, SCSU will play the University of Wisconsin-Stout with the tip scheduled for 1:00 p.m.

Record Against Tip-Off Opponents: The Huskies and Northwood College will meet for the first time. The Huskies have played the University of Wisconsin-Stout three times and are 3-0 against the Blue Devils.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away. This weekend, Minnesota broadcast legend Tom Witschen will call the games from Mankato.

Team Captain: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

2007-08 Player Notes: St. Cloud State returns eight players from last season's roster and one returning starter in senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud). Rengel is the top returning scorer for the Huskies, having averaged 11.8 points per game. Junior guard and captain Katie Tacheny started the first 17 games of the season but missed the remainder of the year with a knee injury. She averaged 8.6 points and contributed 58 assists and 40 steals. Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) played in 28 games last season and averaged 4.7 points. Newcomers Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) and Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) will make their first collegiate starts this weekend.

2006-07 Record: St. Cloud State women's basketball posted a 17-11 overall record and 5-7 in the North Central Conference, good for a fourth place finish.

About Northwood University: Northwood University is located in Midland, Michigan and is a member of the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC). The Timberwolves posted a 9-17 record last season and went in conference play. NU is coached by Jeff Curtis who is in his fourth season and has compiled a 28-51 won/loss mark.

About UW-Stout: The University of Wisconsin-Stout is located in Menomonie, WI. The Blue Devils posted a 23-6 overall record last season and won the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with a 13-3 mark. UWS returns three starters from last season. The Blue Devils are coached by Mark Thomas, in his 21st season at UWS. He has compiled a 355-180 career record.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.
