Two Games On Tap: The St. Cloud State University women's basketball team will travel to the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire on Wednesday, Nov. 28 for a 7:00 p.m. tip-off and return home on Saturday, Dec. 1 for a tilt against Simpson College. That tip-off is scheduled for 6:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall (6,927).

For the Record: St. Cloud State is 2-3 overall after posting a 1-2 record in action last week. The Huskies lost to MSU Moorhead in the home opener, 93-87 last Wednesday. Over the weekend SCSU defeated Northern Michigan 81-77 in overtime and lost to Michigan Tech 73-70 at the UMD Edge Thanksgiving Classic.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.

Team Captains: Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

About UW-Eau Claire: The Bugold women's basketball team is 3-1 overall. The Bugolds hosted the 2007-08 Thanksgiving Showcase last weekend. UWEC posted a 93-38 win over North Park and then lost 56-49 to the University of Chicago. The loss to Chicago ended an 18-game home court winning streak for the Bugolds. Heidi Arciszewski is the leading scorer for UWEC. She is averaging 12.3 points per game and 4.3 rebounds. UWEC is a member of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) and have posted a 143-54 record over the last seven seasons. They are ranked 20th in the USA Today/ESPN DIII preseason coaches poll. The Bugolds have a strong basketball tradition and finished as the NCAA DIII third place team in 2003. Tonja Englund (St. Thomas) is in her eighth season as the head coach. Last year her squad posted a 19-9 overall record and were 11-5 in conference play.

About Simpson College: The Storm compete in the Iowa Conference where they have won five of the last ten Iowa Conference Championships. Simpson enters the week with a 4-0 record, having defeated Northwestern College, Jamestown College, Nebraska Wesleyan and Presentation College. Katelyn Whiton is the leading scorer, averaging 14.3 points per game and 7.3 rebounds. The Storm was ranked 16th in the D3.com preseason poll and 18th in the USA Today/ESPN DIII preseason poll. Head coach Brian Niemuth is in his 21st year at Simpson and has accumulated a 361-64 career record at the school. The Storm advanced the NCAA DIII "Sweet 16" for the first time in 2007. Last season, Simpson posted a 23-7 overall record and a 12-4 conference mark.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

St. Cloud State Team/Player Notes

Series Records: St. Cloud State and UW-Eau Claire have played ten games and the Huskies lead the all-time series 9-1. Last year SCSU won 71-55 in St. Cloud. This will be the first meeting between SCSU and Simpson College.

Rengel and Cashman Named to All-Tournament Team: St. Cloud State senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) were named to the Edge Thanksgiving Classic hosted by the University of Minnesota Duluth last weekend. Rengel averaged 11 points and 6.5 rebounds per game in the Classic. She also dished out eight assists against Northern Michigan which equals her career high. Cashman averaged 13.5 points, pulled down eight boards and had six assists over two games.

Rengel Closing in on 1,000: Kayla Rengel is nearing the 1,000 career point mark as she enters the week with 983 career points. She has played in 93 career games and has averaged 10.6 points per game. Last season she averaged 13.6 points per game. She will become the 25th women's player to reach 1,000 points at St. Cloud State. The career scoring leader is Erika Quigley (2003-07) with 2,570 points.

Cashman in Double Figures: Anna Cashman has come off the bench to score in double figures in four straight games. She scored a career high 23 points in the second game of the season and has dropped double figures since then. She leads the team in overall scoring with 14.6 points per game. She also leads the team in field goal shooting percentage at 58.1. She has made 17 of 28 three-point baskets and is shooting 60.7 percent from three-point range. Currently, Cashman leads the North Central Conference in three-point field goal percentage.

Booth Has Solid Scoring Games: First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has scored in double figures in three straight games. She tallied a collegiate high 22 points against Northern Michigan last Friday. She is averaging 12.2 points and 4.2 rebounds per game.

Tacheny Assists and Steals: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) leads the team in assists with 18 and steals with 17 this season. She notched a career high five steals against Michigan Tech last Saturday and currently leads the NCC in steals. Tacheny has scored in double figures in four of the Huskies five games.



The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).
