Single Game On Tap: The St. Cloud State University women's basketball team will host Glenville State College of West Virginia in Saturday, Dec. 8 at 6:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall (6,927).

For the Record: St. Cloud State is 3-4 overall after posting a 1-1 record in action last week. The Huskies lost at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire on Wednesday, 78-86, and rebounded with a 93-90 win at home over Simpson College on Saturday.

The 16th ranked (WBCA Coaches poll) Glenville State College enters the week with a 3-0 record. The Pioneers will play three games this week, starting Monday, Dec. 3 at Concord, Friday, Dec. 7 at North Dakota, and Saturday's match up with the Huskies.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.

Team Captains: Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

About Glenville State College: The Pioneers play in the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC) and are NCAA Division II members. Dennis Fitzpatrick, a longtime assistant women's basketball coach and assistant Athletic Director, is serving as the interim head basketball coach for the Pioneers. Last season Glenville State posted a 33-3 overall record and won the conference championship with an 18-0 record. GCS won the NCAA Division II East Region title to advance to the NCAA DII Elite Eight. The season came to an end with a quarterfinal loss to UC-San Diego, 71-61. This season, the Pioneers return one starter from that squad, senior Karina Kendrick, a 6'0" forward. Kendrick averages 16.3 points per game and a team high 12 rebounds per game this season. Junior guard Mallory Menendez is the team's leading scorer. She is averaging 19.7 points per game. As a team, the Pioneers average 71.0 points per game and give up 61.7 points. They have out rebounded their opponents 44.0 to 40.0 this season.

Series Record: This will be the first meeting between these two teams.

December 8 Schedule: Please note the schedule for Saturday, Dec. 8. At 4:00 p.m. there will be a boys high school game between Holdingford and Minneapolis South. At 6:00 p.m., the St. Cloud State women will play Glenville State College. At 8:00 p.m., the SCSU men's basketball team will host crosstown rival St. John's University.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

Rengel Becomes 25th Husky to Hit 1,000: On Nov. 28 at UW-Eau Claire senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) became the 25th SCSU woman to score 1,000 points in her career. Her 1,000th point was recorded on a three-point basket with :46 second left in the game. Rengel has played in 95 career games with the Huskies and is averaging 10.8 points in her career. This week, Rengel ranks third in the NCC in scoring. The career scoring leader is Erika Quigley (2003-07) with 2,570 points.

Cashman Makes First Start: Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) had come off the bench and made some big contributions during the first six games on the season. On Saturday, she earned her first collegiate start. She responded with 15 points, including three of five three-point baskets and made four free throws in the waning seconds of the game to seal the win. Cashman has scored in double figures in six straight games and ranks second in team scoring with a 14.9 points per game average. She currently leads the NCC in three-point field goal percentage, is second in three-point field goals made, and ranks fourth in NCC scoring.

Rittenhouse Gets a Start: First year center Abby Rittenhouse (Burnsville) made her first collegiate start on Saturday. She scored a season and career high ten points, had three rebounds and two assists in the game. She has played in all seven games and is averaging nearly 19 minutes a game in playing time.

Tacheny Assists and Steals: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) leads the team in assists with 24 and steals with 20 this season. She has scored in double figures in four straight games and six games on the season.

Booth Hits Boards: First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) pulled down a season high nine rebounds against Simpson last week. She has 24 rebounds over the last three games. Booth has started all seven games this season and averages 12.0 points and 55.3 rebounds.

Barlow: First year guard Talisha Barlow (Roseville) tallied a season high nine rebounds and six assists against Simpson College.

Scott: Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) scored ten points and has five assists against Simpson College, her second best output of the season in both categories. She ranks second on the team with 22 assists.

Ellison: Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a season high seven points against Simpson College.



The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).
