Huskies Play Two This Week: The St. Cloud State University women's basketball team will play two games this week. The Huskies will play at Northern State University (Aberdeen, SD) on Tuesday, Dec. 11 at 6:00 p.m. On Sunday, Dec. 16, St. Cloud State will host the University of Minnesota, Crookston at 7:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall (6,927).

For the Record: St. Cloud State is 4-4 overall after posting an 84-75 win over 13th-ranked Glenville State College last Saturday. The Huskies have won two in a row.

Northern State enters Tuesday's game with a 6-3 overall record.

The University of Minnesota, Crookston enters the week with a 4-6 record. The Golden Eagles will host Minnesota Duluth on Tuesday, before heading to St. Cloud.

will meet for the 12th time since the 1995-96 season. SCSU holds a 10-1 advantage in the series, and have won six in a row.

The last game played between these teams was a 91-59 SCSU win during the 2005-06 season.

About Northern State: The Wolves had a three-game win streak come to an end with last Saturday's loss at Wayne State. Northern State is 3-1 in NSIC games and was picked to finish third in the league in the preseason coaches poll. Noelle Hall, a 6-1 senior center leads the team in scoring and rebounding with 19.3 points and 9.4 rebounds per game. Hall was voted last season's (2006-07) NSIC preseason player of the year. NSU posted a 20-9 record last season with a 12-7 mark in the conference, and return two starters from that squad. NSU head coach Curt Fredrickson is in his 28th season as a head coach, all with the Wolves. He has compiled a 632-192 career record in his 27 years with the Wolves.

Series Records: Both Northern State and Minnesota, Crookston are members of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC), SCSU's new league beginning the fall of 2008. St. Cloud State and Northern State will be playing against each other for only the second time. Northern State won the first an only meeting during the 1995-96 season, 76-66. The Huskies and Eagles

About Minnesota, Crookston: The Golden Eagles return four starters from a team that posted a 0-27 record last season. UMC opened the new season with three straight wins and won four of their first five games, before going into a five game losing skid. Four players are averaging in double figure scoring for the Golden Eagles, led by first year guard Jamie Zelinsky with 16.5 points. Another first year player Gina Jaroszewski leads the team with 7.1 rebounds per game. The Golden Eagles have four first year players in the starting line-up. UMC is coached by Mike Roysland, who is in his second season with the Golden Eagles.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

St. Cloud State Team/Player Notes

Team Notes: St. Cloud State has won two in a row following last Saturday's 84-75 win over 13th-ranked Glenville State College. The Huskies are averaging 79.9 points per game this season. St. Cloud State has received significant playing time from its rookie class this season. First year players Rachel Booth (26.6 mpg), Talisha Barlow (19.0 mpg), and Abby Rittenhouse (17.3 mpg) have played significant minutes for the Huskies.

Barlow Named NCC Player of the Week: First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) was named an NCC Player of the Week Monday. Barlow led the Huskies in the win against Glenville, scoring a team high 19 points and pulling down eight rebounds. She made eight of 12 field goal attempts, including one three-point basket, and did it all in 21 minutes of playing time. She has played in all eight games this season and made four starts. Over the last two games, she has scored 28 points and brought down 17 rebounds. Overall, Barlow averages 8.8 points, five rebounds, and is a 51.8 percent field goal shooter.



Rengel Leads the Way: Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) leads the Huskies in scoring and rebounding with 15.0 points and 6.5 rebounds this season, and currently ranks fifth in the NCC in scoring. She recorded the Huskies only double-double of the season with a 22 point, 12 rebound outing against UW-Eau Claire. She is the newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,035 points.

Tacheny Assists and Steals: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) tallied a season high six steals against Glenville State, and for the second time this season dished out six assists. She is the team leader in assists with 30 and steals with 26. This week she ranks third in the NCC in steals and fourth in assists.

Booth Hits Boards: First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) tallied 16 points, five rebounds and three blocked shots against Glenville. Three times this season she has tallied three blocks in a game, and this week ranks second in the NCC in blocked shots. Booth has started all eight games this season and averages 12.5 points and 5.3 rebounds.

Ellison: Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a season high 12 points and equaled her career high with a season high eight rebounds against Glenville State.

Cashman Hits the Three: Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) leads the Huskies and NCC in three point field goal shooting. She leads the Huskies with 25 of 47 three-point field goal attempts. She leads the NCC in three-point field goal shooting percentage with a .532 clip. She is second in the NCC in 3pt field goals made. Cashman has scored in double figures in all but two games.

Scott Assists: Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) ranks second on the team with 25 assists and has dished out ten assists over the last two games.



The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).
