Home and Away for the Holidays: The St. Cloud State University women's basketball team will play four games between Dec. 20 and Dec. 29. The first two games will be at home on Thursday, Dec. 20 versus Concordia St. Paul (7 p.m. start) and Saturday, Dec. 22 against Lake Superior State (4 p.m. start). The Huskies will travel to Rohnert Park, CA for the Sonoma State University Winter Tournament on Dec. 28 and 29. On Friday, Dec. 28, SCSU will play Chico State (7 p.m. CT start) and Saturday will play the host school Sonoma State (9 p.m. CT start).

Fan Appreciation Night: The Saturday, Dec. 22 match-up with Lake Superior State is Fan Appreciation Night. Admission to the game will be free.

For the Record: St. Cloud State enters this portion of the schedule with a 5-5 record.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.
Note: On Dec. 20, the game will be broadcast on 99.9 Lite FM KCML of St. Cloud.

Team Captains: Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

Opponent Notes.....

About Concordia-St. Paul: The Golden Bears are future league opponents of the Huskies as CSP is a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC). CSP leads the NSIC with an 8-0 overall record and 3-0 league mark. The

ninth-ranked Bears will play at Minnesota State University on Tuesday, Dec. 18. The Huskies have a 9-4 advantage in the series and have won five in a row. Two of those wins were in the 2005 and 2006 NCAA DII North Central Region Tournament. CSP is led by senior center Amanda Behnke, with 17.6 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. The Bears average 87.5 ppg and 44.1 rpg, and are allowing 62.6 ppg and 38.4 rpg. Head Coach Paul Fessler (UNI) is in his eighth season at CSP, has a 150-63 record over seven years, has won four NSIC championships, and made five straight NCAA tournament appearances.

About Lake Superior State: Lake Superior State belongs to the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC). The Lakers enter the week with a 3-6 overall record and are 1-4 in the North Division of the GLIAC. LSSU will play at the University of Minnesota Duluth on Friday, before coming to St. Cloud. This will be the first meeting between the teams. Senior guard Shalyn Beauchamp leads the team in scoring with 12.2 ppg. Junior center Alyssa VanderWal is the rebounding leader with 5.8 rpg. LSSU averages 70.1 ppg and 34.9 rpg. Last year, the Lakers posted an 18-9 overall record and 13-5 GLIAC mark in head coach Jamie Pewinski's first season at the helm.

Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

About Chico State: Chico State is a member of the California Collegiate Athletic Association (CCAA). The Wildcats are 6-2 overall and 1-1 in the CCAA and will play one game before meeting the Huskies. This will be the first meeting between the Huskies and Wildcats. Junior Renee Goldoff leads the Wildcats in scoring and rebounding with 14.8 ppg and 8.3 rpg. Chico State is averaging 70.8 points per outing and 44.1 rebounds. They have allowed 33.8 rebounds per game. Last season, the Wildcats posted a 24-5 overall record and an 18-4 mark in the CCAA. Molly Goodenbour, a former standout at Stanford University (went to three Final Fours and won two during her playing career), is in her second season as head coach of the Wildcats.

About Sonoma State: Sonoma State is also a member of the CCAA. The Seawolves are 5-1 overall and 2-0 in the conference. SSU will play two games prior to their match-up with the Huskies. This game marks the second meeting between these two teams. The first game was played during the 1989-90 season, an 89-50 SCSU win. The Seawolves are led by senior guards Danae Wellander with 13.5 ppg and 6.0 rpg. and Genny Anderson with 6.0 rpg. SSU averages 60.0 ppg and 33.7 rpg. Head coach Mark Rigby is in his eleventh season with the Seawolves and has a ten-year record of 164-111.

St. Cloud State Team Notes: The Huskies were 1-1 last week against future NSIC opponents, losing 74-52 at Northern State and winning at home, 91-64 over Minnesota, Crookston. The Huskies had their best shooting performance of the season hitting 54.7 percent from the field against UMC on Sunday. The Huskies are averaging 78.2 points per game and 36.8 rebounds.

Rengel Leads the Way: Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) leads the Huskies in scoring and rebounding with 15.0 points and 6.3 rebounds this season, and currently ranks fifth in NCC scoring and second in blocked shots with 16. She recorded the Huskies only double-double of the season with a 22 point, 12 rebound outing against UW-Eau Claire. She is the newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,065 points.

Tacheny Assists and Steals: Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) leads the NCC in steals this week with 3.00 per game. She scored 20 points, eight rebounds, and dished out seven assists last week. She leads the Huskies with 37 assists and 30 steals. Tacheny tops the team in free throw shooting with an .817 percentage.

Booth on the Block: First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) is tied with Rengel for second in the NCC in blocked shots with 16 this season. She scored 25 points, nine rebounds and six assists last week. Booth has started all ten games this season.

Ellison: Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a season high 13 points, with a broken pinky on her shooting hand on Saturday. She has started seven games and averages 5.6 points per game.

Cashman Hits the Three: Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) continues to lead the Huskies in three-point shooting with 27 made three-point field goals and 50 percent accuracy. Cashman has scored in double figures in all but three games this season.

Scott Assists: Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) had a solid outing against UMC on Sunday. She scored eight points, nearly all on the fast break, had three assists and three rebounds. She ranks third on the team in assists with 29.

Barlow: First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) followed up her Player of the Week honors with an 18 points, seven rebound performance over two games last week. Barlow had 16 points and five rebounds against UMC on Sunday.



The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).
