#### Huskies to Host Cardinal Stritch in Final Non-Conference Game:

The St. Cloud State University women's basketball team will play host to Cardinal Stritch University (Milwaukee, WI) on Saturday, Jan. 5. The tip-off is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall (6,927). At 11:30 a.m., Holy Family Catholic High School and LeSeur High School will tip-off in a high school girls game in Halenbeck.

**For the Record:** St. Cloud State enters the final non-conference game of the season with a 7-7 overall record.

**On the Radio:** St. Cloud State University women's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The audio broadcast is available on the web at <http://www.1450knsi.com/pages/733727.php>. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.

**Team Captains:** Senior forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) and junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) will captain the 2007-08 SCSU women's basketball team.

#### Opponent Notes.....

**About Cardinal Stritch:** The Wolves boast an 11-3 overall record and have won six of their last seven games. In their last outing on Dec. 28, the Wolves lost at the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee, 76-55. CSU is averaging 76.4 points per game and allowing 56.9 points this season. They have a 3-1 record on the road. Senior guard Jeni Caldwell leads the team in scoring and rebounding, with 14.9 points and 5.6 rebounds per game. She also leads the team in steals with 40 and has made 24 three-point baskets this season. Sopho-

more forward Michelle Stelloh averaged 12.2 points per game. She leads the team with 26 three-point baskets. The Wolves are shooting 45.4 percent from the field and 37.9 percent from beyond the arc. Cardinal Stritch is an NAIA II program that belongs to the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference. Last season the Wolves posted a 25-6 overall record and won the regular season conference title with an 8-0 record. They were ranked 15th in the final NAIA II national ranking. Head coach Rich Panella is in his 21st season at the helm of the women's basketball program. He has a 20-year record of 472-120 and has taken his team to 11 national tournaments.

#### Booth and Rengel Named to All-Tournament Team:

SCSU first year post Rachel Booth and senior forward Kayla Rengel were named to the six member Hampton Inn & Suites Basketball Classic All-Tournament team. The Huskies went 1-1 at the Classic held at Sonoma State University. Booth had 30 points, 24 rebounds and eight blocked shots in the tournament, including a career high 17 rebounds and six blocks against Sonoma State. Rengel added 31 points, 16 rebounds and seven assists.

#### St. Cloud State Team Notes:

The Huskies are 2-2 since Dec. 20, having lost to eighth-ranked Concordia St. Paul, followed by wins over Lake Superior State and 12th-ranked Chico State, and then losing in overtime to Sonoma State, a team that received votes in the national poll. The Huskies shot a season high 56.8 percent from the field against Chico State. Over the last three games, SCSU has held their opponents to an average of 60.3 points per game as compared to the Huskies overall mark of 75.1 points per game.

**Head Coach Dr. Lori Ulferts**

Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota) marks her 14th season as head coach of the St. Cloud State women's basketball team in 2007-08. Through 13 seasons, Ulferts has compiled a 208-161 won/loss record at SCSU. Her 208 wins ranks second on the SCSU all-time coaching chart. Ulferts is in her 23rd season overall as a collegiate head coach with a 370-250 won/loss record. Her coaching stops have included the University of Minnesota, Crookston (1985-89) and Minnesota State University Moorhead (1989-94), before joining the Husky staff in 1994. She has led the Huskies to back-to-back NCAA Division II North Central Region Championships in 2005 and 2006, followed by NCAA DII Elite Eight appearances in each of those years. In 2006, the Huskies advanced to the semifinals of the national tournament. Ulferts is a member of the both the Minnesota, Crookston and North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame.

**St. Cloud State Player Notes**

**Rengel Named to All-Tournament Team:** Senior forward and co-captain Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) was named to the six member Hampton Inn & Suites Basketball Classic All-Tournament team. The Huskies were 1-1 in the Classic and Rengel scored 31 points and had 16 rebounds over two games. She leads the Huskies in scoring and rebounding with 14.5 points and 6.1 rebounds this season. She recorded the Huskies first double-double of the season with a 22 point, 12 rebound outing against UW-Eau Claire. She is the newest member of the 1,000 point club, with 1,118 points which ranks 22nd on the all-time list. Rengel has scored in double figures in six straight games and 11 overall this season.

**Booth Boards/Blocks and Earns All-Tournament Team Honors:** First year center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) was also named to the All-Tournament team at Sonoma State. She combined for 30 points and 24 rebounds in the Classic. She recorded a career high 17 rebounds and six blocks against Sonoma State to go with 18 points. Booth's 17 rebounds are the most by a Husky since SCSU's all-time scoring and rebounding leader Erika Quigley pulled down 19 boards on Jan. 13, 2007 against Augustana College. Booth, a starter in all 14 Husky games this season, is averaging 13.0 points and 5.9 rebounds. She leads the team with 26 blocks, and has scored in double figures in seven straight games, and 11 overall.

**Tacheny Assists and Steals:** Junior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) has recorded 16 assists over the last three games, including a season high seven against Sonoma State on Saturday. She leads the team with 54 assists and 41 steals. She is averaging 11.3 points per game and has made a team high 63 of 77 free throw attempts for an 81.8 percent average.

**Ellison Lands Career High 18 Points:** Junior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a career high 18 points to lead the Huskies to their 72-60 win over Chico State. She made seven of eight field goal attempts in the game.

**Barlow Nails Career High 24 Points:** First year guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) scored her career high 24 points against Lake Superior State on Dec. 22. She made ten of 13 shots from the field and was four of four at the free throw line. Barlow is averaging 9.9 points and 5.1 rebounds per game in her rookie season.

**Cashman Increases Free Throw Percentage:** Junior guard Anna Cashman (Faribault) scored all nine of her points from the free throw line in the Huskies win over Chico State. Cashman was nine of 11 from the line. She made four straight free throws following a double technical against Sonoma that turned the momentum in SCSU's favor as they went on to win. Cashman leads the Huskies with 28 three-point baskets. Twice this season she has made five three-point baskets in a game.

**Scott Assists:** Junior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) ranks third on the team in assists with 36 this season. She tallied her career high seven assists on Nov. 21 against MSU Moorhead. She has also equaled her career high of four steals in a game, three times during the season.



The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982,83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986,87,88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).
