**Upcoming Games:** The Huskies head to Grand Forks, North Dakota for a matchup against the University of North Dakota on Saturday, Jan. 22. The game will start at 6:00 pm.

**Series Record:** Over the years, the Huskies have encountered some difficulties with the women of UND. UND holds the lead in the series at 33-15. The Huskies dropped both games last year and are currently on a 7-game losing streak against UND.

**2003-04 Record:** The Huskies posted a 17-11 overall record and finished fifth in the North Central Conference with a 7-7 record. In the NCAA Division II statistics, St. Cloud State ranked 6th in free throw percentage with 78.0% and ranked first in the NCC with 77.6% free throws. The Huskies ended their season with a loss in first-round action in the 2004 Wells Fargo Tournament at the University of South Dakota on March 2.

**Next Up:** SCSU will face the University of Nebraska-Omaha on Thursday, January 27 at 6:00 pm at Halenbeck Hall. They will then travel to Duluth on Saturday, January 29 to avenge a prior loss to the University of Minnesota, Duluth. Tip-off will be at 6:00 pm.

**Head Coach: Dr. Lori Ulferts** (North Dakota, 1983) is in her eleventh season with the Huskies and 20th season as a collegiate head coach. **She has compiled a 139-135 record in 10 seasons at SCSU and has amassed a 291-224 record in 19 years as a head coach. Dr. Ulferts recorded**

**her 300th career win against the University of Minnesota-Crookston on Dec. 19, 2004 with a 92-73 victory.** Under her guidance the Huskies reached the 2001 NCAA North Central Region Tournament Semi-Finals before falling to the University of North Dakota, 76-63. That season the Huskies posted a 21-9 record, the best for a Husky team since the 1989-90 team posted a 23-5 overall record and was Co-NCC Champions. Before coming to St. Cloud, Ulferts coached at MN-Crookston (four seasons) and MN-State, Moorhead (five seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the Year.

**Assistant Coaching Staff: Mike Jewett** (Augustana College, 1994) begins his first year as Coach Ulferts' top assistant at SCSU. Prior to joining the SCSU staff, Jewett was the head women's basketball coach at Franklin College in Franklin, Indiana for 3 seasons (2001-2004) where he compiled a 62-20 overall record. In 2004 he led his team to the second round of the NCAA Division III tournament, won the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference (HCAC), and was named the HCAC Coach of the Year.

**Megan Taylor** (Iowa State, 2002) will serve as the graduate assistant coach. She is the all-time Minnesota Girls High School leading scorer and in December had her jersey retired at Iowa State, where she was a four-year standout.

**The Huskies Last Week:** SCSU defeated MSU, Mankato 80-73 Friday night. The Huskies hit 14 of 31 field goals in the first half and limited the Mavericks to 35.3% shooting to pull ahead 39-31 at the half. The Mavericks pulled to within 4 points with 6:29 remaining in the game, but a steal by April Carlson followed by a Maverick foul set the Huskies back on their feet. Sascha Hansen led the Huskies in scoring with 23 points, including 4 three-pointers. Quigley nailed another double double, finishing with 22 points and a team high 13 rebounds. Hansen and Huschle dished out 4 assists each.

Augustana College mounted a strong second half come back to defeat SCSU 90-89 Saturday night in Sioux Falls. St. Cloud State led 49-38 at the half behind 16 first half points from first year guard Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud). Augustana opened the second half with a 15-6 run and took a 10-point lead, 85-75 with 4:35 remaining. St. Cloud State then went on a 10-2 run fueled by Katie Huschle, Sascha Hansen, and Kayla Rengel and trailed 87-85 with 1:59 left. SCSU's Erika Quigley scored two baskets in the last 1:06 to close the game to 90-89. The Huskies finished the game with 11 three point baskets, shot 50 percent from the field and 47.8 percent from three-point range.

### Huskies Ranked 25th in Nation

St. Cloud State received a #25 ranking in the January 4, 2005 USA Today/ESPN/WBCA Division II Top 25 Coaches' Poll. This is the first time since the 2000-01 final poll that the Huskies have received votes. St. Cloud State finished 20th in the poll during the 1988-89 season. Other NCC schools to make the list were #8 North Dakota, #20 Augustana College, and #22 Minnesota Duluth.

**About the University of North Dakota:** The University of North Dakota, ranked #14 in last week's national poll and last year's NCC Wells Fargo Champions, have a young roster that features just one senior and three juniors. Despite this, UND has posted big numbers on the scoreboard, leading the NCC in scoring offense (81.0) and scoring margin (19.5). They have posted a 14-4 overall record and are 2-1 in NCC play. Junior forward Kristi Boese is leading both the UND offense and defense with 17.1 points per game and 7.8 rebounds per game. On her heels is freshman center Ashley Langen with 16.9 points and 7.5 rebounds per game. Langen currently ranks 4th in the nation and leads the NCC in field goal percentage (51.9%). Veteran head coach Gene Roebuck has compiled a 439-78 record in 17 years at UND. He holds an overall 526-92 record as a collegiate coach (20 years). Under his guidance, the University of North Dakota women have strung together 15 consecutive seasons with 20 or more wins, a streak that UND hopes to continue this season.

### Husky Notes:

**Dishin':** Sascha Hansen (Marshall) set a new personal career record for assists in Saturday's game against Augustana. The 5'9" junior guard dished out 9 assists in the heartbreaking 89-90 loss. Hansen has accumulated 68 assists so far this season and has 223 in her career. The all-time SCSU record for assists is held by Dawn Anderson (1981-85) at 705.

**Quigley Posts Big Figures:** Sophomore center Erika Quigley (Duluth) continues to lead the NCC and ranks high nationally in scoring and rebounding. With an average 22.8 points per game, Quigley is the highest scoring player in the NCC and 5th highest scorer in Division II basketball. The former NCC Freshman of the Year has made an even better name for herself off the boards, with an average 11.9 rebounds per game. This figure tops the NCC and is good for 4th in the nation. She is mere decimal places behind the national leader, Keauna Vinson of Barton College, who is averaging 12.2 boards per game.

**Rengel Steps Up:** Freshman Kayla Rengel, the 6'0" St. Cloud native, had an impressive showing Saturday night. Scoring a team high 21 points on the evening, including 16 points in the first half alone, Rengel is making a name for herself as a potentially powerful force in the post position. Rengel has seen action in 14 games and has averaged 6.9 points per game.
