Upcoming Games: The Huskies will face the University of Nebraska-Omaha for the first time this season in a game at Halenbeck Hall on Thursday. They will then travel to Duluth on Saturday to avenge the conference opening loss to the Bulldogs.

Series Record: St. Cloud has an upper hand on both of the series between Nebraska-Omaha and Minnesota, Duluth. The Huskies maintain a 23-18 lead in the series with the Mavericks of UNO. They are currently on a 2 game win streak, having defeated UNO twice last season. Although the Huskies lead the overall series with the Bulldogs 23-18, they trail in the NCC series 0-1. The loss came this season when the Bulldogs, as new members of the NCC, beat the Huskies 79-69.

On the Radio: Both games this week will air on WJON AM 1240 with Sports Director Jay Caldwell calling all of the action. Thursday's game against Nebraska-Omaha will also air on KVSC 88.1 FM. Team Captains: Senior guards Molly Jensen (Minnetonka) and Katie Huschle (Eden Valley) and junior guard Sascha Hansen (Marshall) will serve as the Husky captains in 2004-05.

2003-04 Record: The Huskies posted a 17-11 overall record and finished fifth in the North Central Conference with a 7-7 record. In the NCAA Division II statistics, St. Cloud State ranked 6th in free throw percentage with 78.0% and ranked first in the NCC with 77.6% free throws. The Huskies ended their season with a loss in first-round action in the 2004 Wells Fargo Tournament at the University of South Dakota on March 2.

Next Up: The Huskies have a home stand next weekend as they host the University of North Dakota on Thursday, February 3 and Minnesota State University, Mankato on Saturday, February 5. Both games will get started at 6:00 pm.

Head Coach: Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota, 1983) is in her eleventh season with the Huskies and 20th season as a collegiate head coach. **She has compiled a 139-135 record in 10 seasons at SCSU and has amassed a 291-224 record in 19 years as a head coach. Dr. Ulferts recorded**

her 300th career win against the University of Minnesota-Crookston on Dec. 19, 2004 with a 92-73 victory. Under her guidance the Huskies reached the 2001 NCAA North Central Region Tournament Semi-Finals before falling to the University of North Dakota, 76-63. That season the Huskies posted a 21-9 record, the best for a Husky team since the 1989-90 team posted a 23-5 overall record and was Co-NCC Champions. Before coming to St. Cloud, Ulferts coached at MN-Crookston (four seasons) and MN-State, Moorhead (five seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the Year.

Assistant Coaching Staff: Mike Jewett (Augustana College, 1994) begins his first year as Coach Ulferts' top assistant at SCSU. Prior to joining the SCSU staff, Jewett was the head women's basketball coach at Franklin College in Franklin, Indiana for 3 seasons (2001-2004) where he compiled a 62-20 overall record. In 2004 he led his team to the second round of the NCAA Division III tournament, won the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference (HCAC), and was named the HCAC Coach of the Year.

Megan Taylor (Iowa State, 2002) will serve as the graduate assistant coach. She is the all-time Minnesota Girls High School leading scorer and in December had her jersey retired at Iowa State, where she was a four-year standout.

The Huskies Last Week:

SCSU's loss to UND Saturday night was a tale of two halves. In the first period, the Huskies fought back from an early 9-point deficit to tie up the game midway through the half. Putting together a string of jumpers, they enjoyed lead for a short time. Both teams traded baskets at the end of the half, leaving the Huskies trailing by 2, 28-30. Second half play by the Huskies was marred by fouls and missed shots. SCSU shot 10 for 29 in the second half, just 34.5%. UND, on the other hand, hit 61.9% of their shots, led by Carissa Jahner and Ashley Langen who combined for 9 of UND's 13 field goals in the second half. UND slowly picked away at the Huskies and handed SCSU a 60-72 loss.

SCSU was led in scoring and rebounding by sophomore center Erika Quigley (Duluth) with 17 points and nine rebounds. Senior guard Katie Huschle (Eden Valley) added ten points for the Huskies and dished out 4 assists.

North Dakota had four players score in double figures, led by Ashley Langen with 23 points on ten of 14 shooting from the floor. Carissa Jahner and Kristi Boese had 14 points each, and Kelsey Maffin added ten points. Boese had a game high 12 rebounds.

Huskies Ranked 25th in Nation

St. Cloud State received a #25 ranking in the January 4, 2005 USA Today/ESPN/WBCA Division II Top 25 Coaches' Poll. This is the first time since the 2000-01 final poll that the Huskies have received votes. St. Cloud State finished 20th in the poll during the 1988-89 season. Other NCC schools to make the list were #8 North Dakota, #20 Augustana College, and #22 Minnesota Duluth.

About the University of Nebraska-Omaha: The University of Nebraska-Omaha, under the direction of new head coach Patty Patton-Shearer, have turned around a struggling basketball program to claim a current second place position in the NCC. The Mavericks, who finished the 2003-04 season with overall 5-22 and 0-14 NCC records, are currently 13-6 and 3-1 in the NCC. Leading UNO on their new path of victory are junior forward JJ Smith and sophomore guard Karen Thies. Smith tops the UNO charts in both scoring and rebounding with 15.4 ppg and 6.3 rpg. Thies, a transfer who followed Patton-Shearer from Fort Lewis, has received NCC Player of the Week honors twice this season, including being named Co-Player of the Week this week. Thies has averaged 14.9 ppg and 5.8 rpg and ranks second in the NCC for steals with 54. Patty Patton-Shearer comes to the University of Nebraska-Omaha after a 3-year head coaching stint at Fort Lewis College where she compiled a 60-49 record. While at Fort Lewis, Patton-Shearer proved she was capable of turning around losing teams, transforming a 3-23 team into a 17-8 team in just 2 seasons. Patton-Shearer was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2001.

About #21 University of Minnesota Duluth: Prior to the 2004-05 season, the University of Minnesota Duluth had been a commanding member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC). A new era begins for the Bulldogs this year as they enter their inaugural season as a North Central Conference (NCC) member. The Bulldogs finished the 2003-04 season 20-11 and were second in the NSIC. UMD is currently 14-5 overall and 3-2 in the conference, good for 4th in the NCC. They have been a regular in the National Division II rankings this season and currently hold a #21 position. Power forward Lindsey Dietz, a junior from Elk River, MN, continues to stand at the helm of the UMD program. Averaging 21.2 ppg and 8.9 rpg, Dietz ranks among the best in the NCC and has been deemed NCC Player of the Week twice. Head coach Karen Stromme is in her 21st season with the Bulldogs and holds a 434-180 record. Under her direction, UMD had captured the NSIC crown 10 of the last 15 years and have seen 20 or more victories in 14 of the past 16 seasons.

Husky Notes:

Jensen, Rengel Get Starts: Senior guard Molly Jensen (Minnetonka) and freshman guard/forward Kayla Rengel (St. Cloud) both earned starting spots in SCSU's matchup with the University of North Dakota last Saturday. This was Jensen's second start of the season and Rengel's first start as a Husky.

Jensen: Jensen has played in every game in the 2004-05 season and is averaging 6.0 points per game and 2.6 rebounds per game. She scored a season best 11 points in St. Cloud's win against the University of Minnesota Crookston on December 19. Her career scoring high came against the University of Nebraska-Omaha when, as a sophomore, Jensen hit four field goals and connected with 10 of 11 shots from the free throw line to lead the team with 18 points. Jensen has scored 114 points this season and has hit 44 field goals.

Rengel: Rengel is a 6-0 post from St. Cloud. She earned her first collegiate start after several impressive performances, including leading the team with 21 points against Augustana College Jan. 15. The 21 points set a new personal career record for Rengel. Rengel is averaging 6.8 points per game and 3.3 rebounds per game.

Huskies Fourth in Region: The first NCAA Division II North Central Region Poll, released on January 19, featured the St. Cloud State Huskies in the fourth slot. Other NCC teams that made the list were Augustana College (2nd), North Dakota (5th), Minnesota Duluth (8th), and South Dakota (10th).
