**Upcoming Action:** After gaining wins in all 14 non-conference games this season, the Huskies will start up action in the North Central Conference this weekend, matching up with #20 Minnesota Duluth Saturday afternoon at 1:00 pm. The game will be held at Romano Gym in Duluth.

**On the Radio:** Throughout the season, SCSU's women's basketball games will air on local radio with Sports Director Jay Caldwell calling the action. Select games will also be aired live on 88.1 FM KVSC and can be reached through www.kvsc.org. This Saturday's game will air on 1240 WJON. The game can also be heard via the web at the St. Cloud State athletics web site at www.stcloudstate.edu/athletics by clicking on the Listen to Husky Sports! icon. The pre-game show begins ten minutes prior to tip-off.

**The Lori Ulferts Show:** The Lori Ulferts Show will air every Thursday throughout the 2005-06 season. Join Lori Ulferts and Jay Caldwell at 1:45 Thursdays on AM 1390 The Fan.

**2004-05 Finish:** The Huskies had one of the best seasons in school history last season, winning the 2005 North Central Region Championship and advancing to the Elite Eight in Hot Springs, AR. They finished the season with a 23-10 overall record and were 6-6 in the NCC. Sophomore Erika Quigley received All-America status from both the WBCA and Daktronics, Inc.

**Team Captains:** Seniors April Carlson and Sascha Hansen will serve as St. Cloud State team captains for the 2005-06 season.

**Head Coach: Dr. Lori Ulferts** (North Dakota, 1983) is in her twelfth season with the Huskies and 21st season as a collegiate head coach. **She has compiled a 176-145 record at SCSU and has amassed a career record of 328-234.** Dr. Ulferts recorded her 300th career win against the University of Minnesota-Crookston on Dec. 19,

2004 with a 92-73 victory. Under her guidance, the Huskies went 23-10 last season, winning the 2005 North Central Region title and earning a berth at the NCAA Elite Eight, the first under Head Coach Ulferts and the fifth in school history. The Huskies were defeated by Merrimack College in the final seconds of the Quarterfinal game, falling 78-79. The Huskies also reached the NCAA North Central Region Tournament in 2000-01 but fell to the University of North Dakota in the semifinal round, 63-76. Before coming to St. Cloud, Ulferts coached at MN-Crookston (four seasons) and MN-State, Moorhead (five seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the Year.

**Assistant Coaches: Mike Jewett** begins his second year as Coach Ulferts' top assistant at SCSU. Prior to joining the SCSU staff, Jewett was the head women's basketball coach at Franklin College in Franklin, Indiana for 3 seasons (2001-2004), where he compiled a 62-20 overall record. In 2004 he led his team to the second round of the NCAA Division III tournament, won the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference (HCAC), and was named the HCAC Coach of the Year. Jewett has also served as an assistant coach at Augustana College and has high school head coaching experience. **Megan Taylor** (Iowa State, 2002) begins her second season as a graduate assistant coach at SCSU. At Iowa State, Taylor was a 4-time All-Conference Player, an All-American, and in 1998 she was named the Big 12 Freshman of the year. She is the state of Minnesota's second leading scorer for girls' and boys' basketball with 3,300 career points. **Katie Huschle** begins her first season as a student assistant coach for the Huskies. Huschle was the third-leading scorer for SCSU last season, averaging 11.5 points, and led the team in steals with 67. Huschle became St. Cloud State's 22nd member of the 1,000 Point Club on March 4, 2005 against North Dakota. She wrapped up her career with 1,043 points scored.

**Huskies Sit at #6:** The St. Cloud State Huskies continue hold the #6 spot of the USA TODAY ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches' Poll for the third straight week. They are one of six undefeated teams ranked among the top ten nationally and one of three NCC schools on the list. North Dakota maintains a #2 ranking while Minnesota Duluth claims the #20 spot.

**Quigley Shares Honor with UND Foe:** SCSU junior Erika Quigley, a native of Duluth, MN, was named North Central Conference Player of the Week on January 3. The 6-2 center will share the title this week with Minnesota Duluth's Lindsey Dietz. This is the second time that Quigley has been named Player of the Week this season.

Quigley averaged 29.0 points, 14.7 rebounds, and 5.3 blocks per game against Minnesota State-Moorhead, Bemidji State and Minnesota-Crookston. She shot .589 (33-56) from the field and .724 (21-29) from the free throw line. Against BSU, Quigley scored 32 points, pulled down 20 rebounds, and had eight blocked shots.

**Quigley Named Player of the Month:** St. Cloud State center Erika Quigley (Duluth) has been named Player of the Month by the Women's Division II Bulletin for the month of December. Quigley averaged 21.3 points and 11.5 rebounds throughout the month and also posted 31 blocks. She shot 55.2% from the field (64-116) and 77.8% from the free throw line (42-54).



**Husky Replay:** The Huskies posted wins against their last three competitors, pushing their overall record to 14-0. Senior April Carlson hit one of the most clutch shots of her career against MSU-Moorhead, overcoming a foul to drain a sideline three-pointer and resulting free throw, a four-point play that put SCSU up 65-60 with one minute remaining. In a game with the score tied up 17 times, the five point differential was the largest spread at that point in the game and gave the Huskies enough momentum to propel them to a win. The Huskies shot just 37.7% from the field and an uncharacteristic low of 21.4% from three-point range. The team was outrebounded 49-57. Quigley led SCSU with 32 points, 15 rebounds, and 7 blocks. Quigley had another 32 point performance against Bemidji State on December 29, also garnering 20 rebounds and 8 blocks. The Huskies took a quick 5-0 lead after a Quigley layup and a Francis three, but did not extend the lead until well into the first half. Tough Beaver defense kept SCSU at bay at the 14 minute mark, with the Huskies failing to hit a field goal for over 3 and a half minutes. BSU also struggled offensively, however, failing to score for nearly five game minutes. SCSU picked up the pace and took a 38-24 halftime lead. Although they struggled in shooting from outside the paint, they increased their lead in the second half by dishing the ball to Quigley. Hansen came up with 8 assists on the night as the Huskies won 81-62. In their first game of the New Year, the Huskies took on UM-Crookston for the third time this season. Shannon Francis led the team with a career high 24 points, including 5 threes, while Quigley chipped in another 23 points in the 91-59 win. The team improved their shooting to 52.2% and were 8-of-20 (40%) from long range. They struggled from the free throw line, however, hitting just 11 of 23 shots for a 47.8% average. All active players saw at least 13 minutes of playing time and posted figures in the scoring column. April Carlson led the team in rebounds with 11, the best of her career, while Hansen posted 11 assists.



**#20 Minnesota Duluth Notes**

The Bulldogs, now in their second year as members of the North Central Conference, have started the 2005-06 season on a good foot, going 13-2 overall and receiving a national ranking of #20. UMD finished last season 8-4 in the NCC and 20-9 overall. After defeating SCSU twice in the regular season last year, they entered the North Central Region Semifinals confident that they could repeat for the third time. SCSU upset the Bulldogs, however, ending their season with a 59-67 loss. The Bulldogs have rallied behind All-American senior Lindsey Dietz (Elk River, MN), who is averaging a conference high 24.1 points per game. She falls in behind Quigley for rebounds with an average of 9.3 per game. Katie Winkelman comes in second for UMD scoring with 10.9 points per game and averages 5.7 boards per contest. Minnesota Duluth does most of its scoring from close range or in the paint. As a team, UMD comes in second to last among NCC

schools for three-pointers made per game with just 5.33. The team comes in last in the conference for three-point percentage, hitting just 28.9 long range shots. UMD is strong on the boards, however, averaging 40.7 per game, including 28.7 per game defensively. They have posted a +12.1 rebounding margin over their competitors. They will face Minnesota State on Thursday as they open the conference schedule.
