**Release Date: January 4, 2005**

**Upcoming Games:** St. Cloud State will begin conference play on Saturday, January 8 at Halenbeck Hall when they take on the University of Minnesota-Duluth. The tip-off is set for 6:00 pm.

**Series Record:** This is the 35th year that the Huskies of St. Cloud State have battled with the Bulldogs of UM-Duluth. While SCSU holds a commanding 32-17 overall series lead, the Huskies and Bulldogs in the past 5 years have split the wins with 3 each. Saturday's game will mark the first conference meeting between the two teams, with UM-Duluth joining the NCC this year.

**2003-04 Record:** The Huskies posted a 17-11 overall record and finished fifth in the North Central Conference with a 7-7 record. In the NCAA Division II statistics, St. Cloud State ranked 6th in free throw percentage with 78.0% and ranked first in the NCC with 77.6% free throws. The Huskies ended their season with a loss in first-round action in the 2004 Wells Fargo Tournament at the University of South Dakota on March 2.

**Next Up:** The Huskies will travel for two conference games the weekend of January 14-15. The take on Minnesota State University-Mankato on Friday, January 14 at 6:00 pm and Augustana College on Saturday, January 15 at 6:00 pm.

**Head Coach: Dr. Lori Ulferts** (North Dakota, 1983) is in her eleventh season with the Huskies and 20th season as a collegiate head coach. **She has compiled a 139-135 record in 10 seasons at SCSU and has amassed a 291-224 record in 19 years as a head coach. Dr. Ulferts recorded**

**her 300th career win against the University of Minnesota-Crookston on Dec. 19, 2004 with a 92-73 victory.** Under her guidance the Huskies reached the 2001 NCAA North Central Region Tournament Semi-Finals before falling to the University of North Dakota, 76-63. That season the Huskies posted a 21-9 record, the best for a Husky team since the 1989-90 team posted a 23-5 overall record and was Co-NCC Champions. Before coming to St. Cloud, Ulferts coached at MN-Crookston (four seasons) and MN-State, Moorhead (five seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the Year.

**Assistant Coaching Staff: Mike Jewett** (Augustana College, 1994) begins his first year as Coach Ulferts' top assistant at SCSU. Prior to joining the SCSU staff, Jewett was the head women's basketball coach at Franklin College in Franklin, Indiana for 3 seasons (2001-2004) where he compiled a 62-20 overall record. In 2004 he led his team to the second round of the NCAA Division III tournament, won the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference (HCAC), and was named the HCAC Coach of the Year.

**Megan Taylor** (Iowa State, 2002) will serve as the graduate assistant coach. She is the all-time Minnesota Girls High School leading scorer and in December had her jersey retired at Iowa State, where she was a four-year standout.

**The Huskies Last Week:** With three games and three wins over the past week, the Huskies have extended their win streak to 10 games and have positioned themselves at second place in the conference. The wins came at the expense of three non-conference teams, the final non-conference action that the Husky women will see in the regular season. At the University of California-San Diego Triton Invitational, St. Cloud defeated Cal State San Bernardino on Wednesday evening with a final score of 62-37. Erika Quigley hit 10 of 14 field goals to finish with a team high 22 points and 15 rebounds. Shannon Francis chipped in 9 points off of 3-point shots and dished out 6 assists. The Huskies took on the tournament host team, the University of California-San Diego, on Thursday evening and claimed their ninth consecutive win of the season, 72-56. Quigley led the Huskies with 23 points and 14 rebounds and also had 5 blocked shots. April Carlson was the second leading scorer with 14 points. Carlson also pulled down 6 boards and had 2 blocked shots. For their efforts, Quigley was named tournament MVP and Carlson received All-Tournament honors.

For their final non-conference match-up of the regular season, SCSU took on Bemidji State Monday, January 3. The 81-72 win gave the Huskies an overall 13-2 record and kept alive the 10-game win streak. Quigley had 17 points and 16 rebounds, good for her 12th double double of the season. Katie Huschle also played well in the game, tallying 16 points, 5 assists, 3 steals, and 1 blocked shot. Senior Molly Jensen added 9 points and had 5 steals.

### Huskies Picked Third in NCC

#### Women's Basketball Coaches Poll

North Dakota has been chosen by the league's women's basketball coaches as the favored team to capture the North Central Conference women's basketball championship. UND won the Wells Fargo Finals last year after finishing third in the regular-season NCC standings with a 10-4 mark. North Dakota advanced to the NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Championship and defeated Fort Lewis and North Dakota State before falling 72-70 in overtime to South Dakota State in the region title game to finish the season with a 27-6 record.

Minnesota Duluth finished second in the coaches' balloting with Augustana and St. Cloud State tied for third. UMD, a newcomer to the NCC, finished last season with a 20-11 mark overall and a 9-7 mark in the Northern Sun Conference. Augustana was 13-15 overall and 5-9 in the NCC while St. Cloud State was 17-11 overall and 7-7 in the league last year.

North Dakota was chosen as the champions by five of the seven coaches with the other two votes coming for second place. Minnesota Duluth and Augustana each received one first-place vote.

The North Central Conference has had teams in the NCAA Division II women's basketball championship game in 11 of the last 14 years and NCC schools have brought home the title on nine of those occasions.

**About the University of Minnesota-Duluth:** Prior to the 2004-05 season, the University of Minnesota-Duluth had been a commanding member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC). A new era begins for the Bulldogs this year as they enter their inaugural season as a North Central Conference (NCC) member. The Bulldogs finished the 2003-04 season with an overall 20-11 record and placed second in the NSIC with a 9-7 conference record. UMD is currently 11-3 on the season and open conference play on Thursday, January 6 against Minnesota State University-Mankato. Paving the way for the Bulldogs is junior forward Lindsey Dietz who is averaging 20.9 points and 8.5 rebounds per game. Senior guard Tanysha Scott and sophomore forward Katie Winkelman are both averaging 8.4 points per game. Head coach Karen Stromme is in her 21st season at the helm of the Bulldog program. Under her reign, UMD has compiled a 420-175 overall record and has captured the NSIC crown 10 of the last 15 years (11 overall). They have also earned seven trips to the NCAA Division II North Central Regional and have seen 20 or more victories in 14 of the past 16 seasons.

### Husky Notes:

**Way to go!:** The Huskies have received a #25 ranking in the January 4, 2005 USA Today/ESPN/WBCA Division II Top 25 Coaches' Poll. This is the first time since the 2000-01 final poll that the Huskies have even received votes. St. Cloud State finished 20th in the poll during the 1988-89 season.

**Quigley receives NCC honors:** Sophomore center Erika Quigley (Duluth) was named North Central Conference Player of the Week for on January 3, 2005. Quigley averaged 16.7 points and 12 rebounds in three games last week. She led the Huskies to three wins on the week and was named the MVP of the UC San Diego Invitational. She posted her 10th and 11th double-doubles of the season in wins against Cal State San Bernadino and UC San Diego and her 12th double-double against Bemidji State. This is the 3rd time Quigley has been named NCC Player of the Week. She received the honor in Week 1 and was Co-Player of the Week in Week 4.

**Huskies Rank High in NCC:** St. Cloud State (13-2) is in second place in the North Central Conference, trailing first place Augustana College (15-2). The Huskies are currently leading all other NCC teams with a 10-game winning streak. Statistically, St. Cloud State leads the NCC in both field goal percentage (46.9%) and 3-point field goal percentage (41.9%). Several Husky players are posting strong numbers in the individual categories as well. Quigley leads all players in the conference in scoring (135 points, 23.2 ppg), rebounding (174 rebounds, 12.4 rpg), blocked shots (46 blocked shots, 3.29 bpg), and defensive rebounds (115 rebounds, 8.21 rpg). Quigley ranks second in field goal percentage (57.0%) and offensive rebounds (4.21 rpg). Junior Sascha Hansen leads the NCC in 3-point FG percentage (54.7%) and has hit an average of 2.5 3-pointers per game, good for 3rd in the NCC. Hansen also ranks 9th in field goal percentage (50.5%) and 10th in assists (3.5 app). Senior Katie Huschle is third in the NCC for assists (4.86 app) and is second in free throw percentage (88.7%).
