Upcoming Action: St. Cloud State will host Concordia-St. Paul on Wednesday at 7 pm. They will travel north to take on Minnesota-Crookston on Saturday afternoon, starting at 3 pm.

The pre-game show begins ten minutes prior to tip-off.

2004-05 Finish: The Huskies had one of the best seasons in school history last season, winning the 2005 North Central Region Championship and advancing to the Elite Eight in Hot Springs, AR. They finished the season with a 23-10 overall record and were 6-6 in the NCC. Sophomore Erika Quigley received All-America status from both the WBCA and Daktronics, Inc.

Huskies Climb to #7 Ranking: The St. Cloud State women's basketball team climbed to a #7 ranking in the first regular season USA TODAY ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches' Poll, released December 6. The team received a tenth place ranking in the preseason poll and, after going 6-0 in the first three weeks of play, climbed three spots to their current position.

Team Captains: Seniors April Carlson and Sascha Hansen will serve as St. Cloud State team captains for the 2005-06 season.

Topping 1,000: Senior Sascha Hansen (Marshall, MN) went over the 1,000 point mark of her career in front of a home crowd on Sunday afternoon against St. Thomas. Hansen reached the K-mark by hitting a three-pointer just to the right of the key. She becomes a member of the 23 player strong 1,000 Point Club and is one of just eight players in SCSU history to score over 1,000 points and have over 300 assists.

Last week's results: In the first of three games played last week, the Huskies defeated Southwest MN State 77-49 on the road. Francis and Rengel scored 19 and 18 points, respectively and combined for 13 rebounds. The Huskies shot 53.8% from the field, 60% from long range, and 80% from the free throw line. They outrebounded the Mustangs by a margin of ten boards.

Also on the road against Upper Iowa, the Huskies posted a 48-point win over the Peacocks, 89-41. Forwards Quigley and J. Carlson both posted double digit figures, Quigley with 12 points and 10 rebounds, Carlson with 11 points and 10 rebounds. The four other starters also scored in double digits, ranging from 10 to 16 points each. SCSU managed the ball much better than against SMSU, finishing with just 12 turnovers. They came up with 13 steals. The Huskies gained their third win of the week against St. Thomas on Sunday afternoon. SCSU hit 10 three-pointers in the game, including six from senior Sascha Hansen, who topped the 1,000 point mark of her career on her fifth three. Hansen led the team with 24 points, had five assists and a steal. Quigley chipped in 18 points, 13 rebounds, and four steals. The win tied the 2005-06 squad for best season start in SCSU history at 9-0.

The Competition: *Concordia-St. Paul* will be looking for revenge against the Huskies on Wednesday night after SCSU handed CSP a season-ending 81-70 loss in the championship round of the Regional Tournament last year. The Golden Bears are 3-3 on the season after suffering losses to then-ranked #8 North Dakota, Colorado State, and Minnesota Duluth. Nakia Carlisle is their current top scorer with an average 16.7 points per game. Amanda Behnke has averaged 16.0 points and a team high 8.5 rebounds per game. The team is averaging just 69.7 points per game, but with a 42.3% shooting average and a reason to win, CSP may well be the toughest opponent SCSU seen by SCSU this season.

Minnesota-Crookston has had a rough start this 2005-06 season. They are 2-7 overall and have been outscored by opponents by a margin of 12.9 points. The Huskies trampled over the Screaming Eagles in their first meeting of the season, gaining a 110-77 win. They have seen some success since then, however, and have most recently gained a 76-72 win over Minnesota State. Guard Karna Plaine is averaging 23.1 points and 6.1 rebounds per game and posted 25 points against SCSU. Twins Carly and Kari Score are UMC's next leading players to watch.
