Upcoming Games: The Huskies (7-2) will battle at home again this week. They face the University of Wisconsin-Stout on Tuesday, December 14. Tip-off is set for 7:00 pm. On Sunday, December 19, the Huskies take on the University of Minnesota-Crookston once again. The game is schedule for an 8:00 pm start time.

Series Record: Last year marked the first meeting between St. Cloud State and Wisconsin-Stout. The Huskies won the battle 88-83.

The Golden Eagles of Crookston will look to avenge last week's loss to the Huskies and improve the overall 5-1 series record held by SCSU. To do so, they will have to shut down Quigley and Hansen, who combined for 66 of SCSU's 94 points.

2003-04 Record: The Huskies posted a 17-11 overall record and finished fifth in the North Central Conference with a 7-7 record. In the NCAA Division II statistics, St. Cloud State ranked 6th in free throw percentage with 78.0% and ranked first in the NCC with 77.6% free throws. The Huskies ended their season with a loss in first-round action in the 2004 Wells Fargo Tournament at the University of South Dakota on March 2.

Next Up: The Huskies will travel to Winona State University on Tuesday, December 21 for a 7:00 pm game.

Head Coach: Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota, 1983) enters her eleventh season with the Huskies and 20th season as a collegiate head coach. **She has compiled a 139-135 record in 10 seasons at SCSU and has amassed a 291-224 record in 19 years as a head coach.** Under her guidance the Huskies reached the 2001 NCAA North Central Region Tournament

Semi-Finals before falling to the University of North Dakota, 76-63. That season the Huskies posted a 21-9 record, the best for a Husky team since the 1989-90 team posted a 23-5 overall record and was Co-NCC Champions. Before coming to St. Cloud, Ulferts coached at MN-Crookston (four seasons) and MN-State, Moorhead (five seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the Year.

Assistant Coaching Staff: Mike Jewett (Augustana College, 1994) begins his first year as Coach Ulferts' top assistant at SCSU. Prior to joining the SCSU staff, Jewett was the head women's basketball coach at Franklin College in Franklin, Indiana for 3 seasons (2001-2004). During his tenure, he compiled a 62-20 overall record. In 2004 he led his team to the second round of the NCAA Division III tournament, won the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference (HCAC), and was named the HCAC Coach of the Year. **Megan Taylor** (Iowa State, 2002) will serve as the graduate assistant coach.

The Huskies Last Week: The Huskies posted a decisive 94-78 win over Southwest Minnesota State University in their first home appearance of the season. Sophomore guard Shannon Francis lit up the offense early in the first half, nailing 3 of 3 shots from beyond the arc in just over 3 minutes. The Huskies played tough defense and put strong half-court pressure on SMSU, forcing 17 turnovers in the first half. St. Cloud led Southwest Minnesota State 46-29 at the half. In the second half, the Mustangs shot their way out of a 25 point Husky lead to trail by just 6 points with 11:27 remaining. The Huskies turned the tide, however, and nailed shots while forcing SMSU fouls to extend the final score to 94-78. Quigley led SCSU with a career high 37 points, just one point shy of the school record 38 points. Hansen pulled down a career high 12 boards, a team high for the night. In their first battle against North Central University, St. Cloud scored a season high 95 points. Despite poor shooting in the first half, the Huskies outscored the Rams 42-15 by half-time. The Huskies improved their shooting in the second half and tightened their defense, forcing NCU to commit 20 turnovers in the second half alone. NCU finished with 39 turnovers. The final score of the game was 95-37. Leading the team was Quigley with 20 points, Davis with 10 rebounds, Youngberg with 5 assists, and Legge with 5 steals. The Huskies had 11 players see 14+ minutes of court time. SCSU's final game of the week resulted in a 94-83 win over Minnesota-Crookston. The Golden Eagles kept the game close in the first half as there were 9 lead changes and UMD led by as many as six points, 30-24, at the 7:40 mark. The Huskies held a 48-44 edge at the half. The Huskies never trailed in the second half and led by 17 points with 2:27 left in the game. They extended their win streak to 2 against UMC with the 94-83 win. Hansen scored a career high 32 points on the night, shooting 10 of 16 from the field including 7 of 12 three pointers. The 7 three point baskets is one shy of the school record 8 made by Teri Watkins during the 1998 season. Quigley had a game high 34 points and 16 rebounds. Huschle dished out a game high 7 assists.

Huskies Picked Third in NCC Women's Basketball Coaches Poll

North Dakota has been chosen by the league's women's basketball coaches as the favored team to capture the North Central Conference women's basketball championship. UND won the Wells Fargo Finals last year after finishing third in the regular-season NCC standings with a 10-4 mark. North Dakota advanced to the NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Championship and defeated Fort Lewis and North Dakota State before falling 72-70 in overtime to South Dakota State in the region title game to finish the season with a 27-6 record.

Minnesota Duluth finished second in the coaches' balloting with Augustana and St. Cloud State tied for third. UMD, a newcomer to the NCC, finished last season with a 20-11 mark overall and a 9-7 mark in the Northern Sun Conference. Augustana was 13-15 overall and 5-9 in the NCC while St. Cloud State was 17-11 overall and 7-7 in the league last year.

North Dakota was chosen as the champions by five of the seven coaches with the other two votes coming for second place. Minnesota Duluth and Augustana each received one first-place vote.

The North Central Conference has had teams in the NCAA Division II women's basketball championship game in 11 of the last 14 years and NCC schools have brought home the title on nine of those occasions.

About the University of Wisconsin-Stout: UW-Stout is a member of the NCAA Division III Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. They come into Tuesday's game with a 6-3 overall record and are 1-3 in the WIAC. Last year's matchup between the Blue Devils and the Huskies was the first time the teams played. The Huskies pulled off a narrow 88-83 win. Senior captain Lindsey Erichsen and sophomore Kelsey Duoss, both forwards, lead UW-Stout with 12.1 and 12.0 points per game, respectively. Erichsen holds the edge on rebounds with 7.2 per game. Senior guard and captain Erin Churchill has dished out 36 assists on the season. Head coach Mark Thomas is in his 18th year at the helm of the Blue Devil program. He topped the 250-win milestone 2 years ago and currently holds a 292-162 overall record.

About the University of Minnesota-Crookston: The University of Minnesota-Crookston women have posted an impressive 7-2 record. They suffered their first home loss of the season on Saturday when they fell to St. Cloud State. Forwards Karna Plaine (17.2 ppg, 6.7 rpg) and Kari Score (16.3 ppg, 7.0 rpg) have been the scoring forces that have helped turn the UMC program around from a disappointing 11-16 overall finish and a 4-12 performance in the NSIC last season. Senior guard Steph Mayclin is also averaging 14.4 points per game and has dished out a team high 44 assists. Head coach Mike Curfman, the 2001-02 NSIC Coach of the Year, has posted a 38-73 record at UMC in 5 years.

Husky Notes:

Sophomore center Erika Quigley (Duluth) was named NCC co-Player of the Week for her December 6-12 performances, sharing the honor with UM-Duluth's Lindsey Dietz. This is the second Player of the Week honor for both Quigley and Dietz. Quigley scored 37 points against Southwest Minnesota State University, one point shy of the school record 38. Quigley posted her seventh double-double of the season against UM-Crookston. She leads the NCC in double-doubles, having finished 7 out of the season's 9 games with such figures. In Saturday's game against Crookston, she went 15 of 19 from the field, which is just one shy of the school record 16 held by Diane Scherer and Ramona Rugloski.

Junior guard and captain Sascha Hansen (Marshall) gained a new personal career high scoring record against the University of Minnesota-Crookston, finishing with 32 points. That puts her over the 600 point mark for her career. Hansen has scored 609 points in her 63 games played as a Husky. Of the 32 points scored, 21 came from three-pointers, hitting 7 out of 12 attempts. Hansen has made 72 threes in her career, which moves her to 6th place on the all-time 3FG made list.
