Upcoming Games: The Huskies will take a seven game win streak into the University of California-San Diego Triton Invitational on Wednesday and Thursday, December 29-30. St. Cloud State, 10-2 overall, will play Cal State-San Bernardino (6-1) on Dec. 29 at 8:00 p.m. central time. On Dec. 30th, the Huskies will play the host school, UC-San Diego (5-2) at 10:00 p.m. central time. Western New Mexico is the fourth team in the tournament and will play UC-San Diego on Wed. and CS-San Bernardino on Thursday. SCSU will return home on Monday, January 3 for a game against Bemidji State University.

NCC Player of the Week Katie Huschle: Senior guard Katie Huschle (Eden Valley) was named the NCC Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 22. In three games last week, Huschle averaged 24.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, and 6.3 assists. She scored a career high 28 points in the win over UW-Stout.

Series Record: St. Cloud State and Cal State San Bernardino have played each other twice. Both games were played in a back-to-back series during the 1996-97 season. SCSU won the first contest 67-62 and CS-San Bernardino won the second 70-62. The Huskies will play the UC-San Diego Tritons for the first time. SCSU and Bemidji State have a long history dating back to 1970 and the Huskies lead the all-time series 25-11. That includes SCSU's season opening win over the Beavers on Nov. 15, 75-49.

On the Radio: The games played at the UC-San Diego Triton Invitational will not be aired. The January 3rd game versus Bemidji State will air on WJON AM 1240 with Sports Director Jay Caldwell calling all of the action. Team Captains: Senior guards Molly Jensen (Minnetonka) and Katie Huschle (Eden Valley) and junior guard Sascha Hansen (Marshall) will serve as the Husky captains in 2004-05.

2003-04 Record: The Huskies posted a 17-11 overall record and finished fifth in the North Central Conference with a 7-7 record. In the NCAA Division II statistics, St. Cloud State ranked 6th in free throw percentage with 78.0% and ranked first in the NCC with 77.6% free throws. The Huskies ended their season with a loss in first-round action in the 2004 Wells Fargo Tournament at the University of South Dakota on March 2.

Next Up: The Huskies will open North Central Conference play on Saturday, January 8 when SCSU hosts league newcomer Minnesota Duluth at 6:00 p.m. at Halenbeck Hall.

Head Coach: Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota, 1983) is in her eleventh season with the Huskies and 20th season as a collegiate head coach. **She has compiled a 139-135 record in 10 seasons at SCSU and has amassed a 291-224 record in 19 years as a head coach. Dr. Ulferts recorded**

her 300th career win against the University of Minnesota-Crookston on Dec. 19, 2004 with a 92-73 victory. Under her guidance the Huskies reached the 2001 NCAA North Central Region Tournament Semi-Finals before falling to the University of North Dakota, 76-63. That season the Huskies posted a 21-9 record, the best for a Husky team since the 1989-90 team posted a 23-5 overall record and was Co-NCC Champions. Before coming to St. Cloud, Ulferts coached at MN-Crookston (four seasons) and MN-State, Moorhead (five seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the Year.

Assistant Coaching Staff: Mike Jewett (Augustana College, 1994) begins his first year as Coach Ulferts' top assistant at SCSU. Prior to joining the SCSU staff, Jewett was the head women's basketball coach at Franklin College in Franklin, Indiana for 3 seasons (2001-2004) where he compiled a 62-20 overall record. In 2004 he led his team to the second round of the NCAA Division III tournament, won the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference (HCAC), and was named the HCAC Coach of the Year. **Megan Taylor** (Iowa State, 2002) will serve as the graduate assistant coach. She is the all-time Minnesota Girls High School leading scorer and in December had her jersey retired at Iowa State, where she was a four-year standout.

The Huskies Last Week: SCSU won its fifth, sixth, and seventh straight games last week with victories over UW-Stout, 90-73, Minnesota-Crookston, 92-73, and Winona State, 72-54. Katie Huschle led all scorers against UW-Stout with a career high 28 points and Erika Quigley added 25 points and 13 rebounds. Quigley was the leading scorer against Minnesota-Crookston with 21 points and 11 rebounds, while Huschle added 18 points and a career high eight assists. Against Winona State, it was Huschle again with a game high 26 points and seven rebounds.

Huskies Roll: SCSU has won seven straight games in the longest winning streak since the 1999-2000 season when the Huskies won eight straight early in the year. During this win streak the Huskies put 90 or more points on the scoreboard in five straight games. The last time SCSU had a streak like that was during the 1998-99 season when the Huskies won four straight games scoring 90 points or more. SCSU received votes in both the Dec. 7 and Dec. 14 USA Today/ESPN/WBCA Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll. As a team, the Huskies lead the NCC in scoring offense (82.1ppg) and field goal percentage (.477).

Huskies Picked Third in NCC Women's Basketball Coaches Poll

North Dakota has been chosen by the league's women's basketball coaches as the favored team to capture the North Central Conference women's basketball championship. UND won the Wells Fargo Finals last year after finishing third in the regular-season NCC standings with a 10-4 mark. North Dakota advanced to the NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Championship and defeated Fort Lewis and North Dakota State before falling 72-70 in overtime to South Dakota State in the region title game to finish the season with a 27-6 record.

Minnesota Duluth finished second in the coaches' balloting with Augustana and St. Cloud State tied for third. UMD, a newcomer to the NCC, finished last season with a 20-11 mark overall and a 9-7 mark in the Northern Sun Conference. Augustana was 13-15 overall and 5-9 in the NCC while St. Cloud State was 17-11 overall and 7-7 in the league last year.

North Dakota was chosen as the champions by five of the seven coaches with the other two votes coming for second place. Minnesota Duluth and Augustana each received one first-place vote.

The North Central Conference has had teams in the NCAA Division II women's basketball championship game in 11 of the last 14 years and NCC schools have brought home the title on nine of those occasions.

At the UC-San Diego Invitational: The Huskies will play a pair of teams from the California Collegiate Athletic Association in Cal State San Bernardino and UC-San Diego. CS-San Bernardino enters the invitational with a 6-1 overall record and a 1-1 CCAA mark. The Coyotes are coached by Kevin Becker, who is in his eighth season at CSUSB. The Coyotes return two starters from a year ago on a team that posted an 11-16 overall record and an 8-14 CCAA mark. CS-San Bernardino has a balanced scoring attack as five players average eight points each. The Coyotes average 62.1 points per game and give up 43.0 per outing. They hold a +5.4 rebounding margin over their opponents.

UC-San Diego is 5-2 overall and 2-0 in CCAA games. The Tritons are coached by Judy Malone, who is in her 29th season at UC-San Diego. The Tritons joined the Division II ranks in 2000-01 after many years in Division III. UCSD has two players that average in double figures in Leora Juster (14.4 ppg) and Margaret Johnson (14.3 ppg). The Tritons average 76.3 points per game and allow 67.0 points per game. They hold a +5.3 rebounding margin over their opponents.

About Bemidji State: Bemidji State will play two game between now and their January 3rd date with the Huskies. The Beavers are 2-7 overall and play at Upper Iowa on December 28 and at Morningside College on December 29 before meeting the Huskies. BSU head coach Michael Power is in his third season with the Beavers. Last year, BSU posted a 14-15 overall record and placed fifth in the Northern Sun with an 8-8 mark. Maggie Gernbacher is the leading scorer for the Beavers averaging 14.7 ppg. Stacia Swanson chips in 12.7 ppg. BSU averages 60.1 points per game and are allowing 69.0 points. They are being out rebounded 6.4 boards per game.

Husky Notes:

Huschle is Hot: Senior guard and captain Katie Huschle (Eden Valley) is on a roll. In the last three games, she has scored 72 points and dished out 19 assists. She scored a career high 28 points against UW-Stout, followed by 18 points against UMC and 26 points against Winona State. She handed out a career high eight assists against Crookston. She has scored in double figures seven times this season. She has started all 12 games and is averaging 12.4 points per game. She leads the team in assists (57) and steals (23). Her season scoring average is the best in her career. She has scored 813 career points.

Quigley Doubles: Sophomore center Erika Quigley (Duluth) has scored in double figures in all but one game this season. She had limited playing time against Winona State. She has recorded nine double-doubles this season and is averaging 23.3 points per game and 12.1 rebounds per game. Quigley was named NCC co-Player of the Week on Dec. 13 and She scored a career high 37 points against Southwest Minnesota State University, one point shy of the school record 38. Quigley leads the NCC in scoring, rebounding, blocked shots, and defensive rebounds this week.

Hansen for Three: Junior guard and captain Sascha Hansen (Marshall) has been dropping the threes. She has 33 three-point field goals this season, which is above her total of 28 for all of last season. Hansen is shooting 56.9 percent from three-point range (22-58). She has scored in double figures eight times this season and had a season and career high 32 points in SCSU's win over Minnesota-Crookston. Hansen has started in every game of her collegiate career, a total of 67 straight games. This season she is averaging 12.8 points per game. Hansen leads the NCC in three-point field goal shooting percentage (.569).
