**2004-2005 FINAL RECORD:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team posted a 23-10 overall record, claiming the North Central Region title and advancing to the NCAA Elite Eight playoffs. They finished fourth in the North Central Conference with a 6-6 league record. St. Cloud State finished the season ranked in several NCAA Division II statistical categories, including 8th in scoring offense (80.1 ppg), 20th in field goal percentage (45.6), 26th in free throw percentage (74.8), 32nd in scoring margin (10.7 ppg), and 35th in three point field goals made (6.5 per game).

**ELITE EIGHT APPEARANCE:** As the North Central Region champs, the St. Cloud State Huskies advanced to the 2004-05 NCAA Elite Eight in Hot Springs, Arkansas. As with SCSU's previous four Elite Eight appearances, the Huskies lost in the quarter-final round of the tournament. The game against Massachusetts native Merrimack College was decided in the final seconds of the game, ending SCSU's improbable season with a 78-79 loss. The Huskies controlled the majority of the game and it appeared that they had a great chance to advance to the Final Four for the first time in school history. The Huskies maintained a 42-35 lead at the half and were ahead for most of the second period. There were a series of runs by both teams throughout the final half, and Merrimack managed to tie the score at 74-74 with 1:16 left. Junior April Carlson beat the shot clock with a jumper to put SCSU up by two, but a three-pointer by Merrimack gave the Warriors a one-point edge with 25 seconds left. Senior Katie Huschle was fouled and headed to the free-throw line, where she hit both shots and put SCSU back on top. An inbounds bucket under the Merrimack hoop gave the lead back to the Warriors with 16 seconds remaining. With just over three seconds left in the game, the Huskies had an inbound opportunity of their own, but they were unable to execute the play and, as the clock ran out, SCSU was handed a bitter 78-79 loss. This was the fifth time that the women of St. Cloud State have advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight. The last time that the Huskies made it this far in the National Playoffs was over 15 years ago, in 1989.

**NORTH CENTRAL REGION CHAMPIONS:** The Huskies overcame a seventh seed ranking to claim the 2004-05 North Central Region Championship. Throughout the Regional tournament, they earned wins over Minnesota State Moorhead (79-57), Minnesota Duluth (67-59), and Concordia-St. Paul (87-70). This marked the fifth NCAA regional championship for the Huskies in school history. St. Cloud won Region titles in 1989, 1985, 1984, and 1983 and lost in the 1987 Region championship game.

**HUSKIES FINISH SEASON RANKED #11 IN NATIONAL POLL:** The final USA Today/ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches' Poll, released March 29, 2005, featured St. Cloud State at a #11 position. The Huskies were ranked #17 in the March 22nd results and were first featured in the poll on January 4, 2005, when they slipped into the #25 position. Prior to the 2004-05 season, the most recent national ranking for the Huskies was in 1989, when St. Cloud finished 20th in the final poll.

**QUIGLEY GAINS DOUBLE ALL-AMERICA STATUS:** Sophomore Erika Quigley (Duluth) was named a 2005 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Kodak First Team All-American. She was also named to the 2005 Daktronics, Inc. All-America First Team, as selected by members of CoSIDA (College Sports Information Directors of America). The 6-2 center averaged 22.7 points and 12.1 rebounds per game for the Huskies this season. Throughout the 33 game run, Quigley recorded 23 double-doubles for scoring and rebounding. Quigley is the first SCSU women's basketball player to earn First Team All-American honors since Jan Niehaus was named to the American Women's Sports Federation (AWSF) All-American First Team in 1990.

**QUIGLEY NAMED TO ALL-REGION TEAM:** Sophomore Erika Quigley was named to the 2005 Daktronics All-North Central Region First Team. She led the North Central Conference in overall scoring, rebounding, and blocked shots. Quigley also set the NCC record for sophomore scoring and tied the mark for sophomore rebounding.

**HANSEN EARNS SPOT ON WELLS FARGO FINALS ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM:** Junior Sascha Hansen (Marshall) was named to the 2005 Wells Fargo Finals All-Tournament Team. Hansen led the Huskies with 22 points, four rebounds, and four assists in SCSU's semifinal loss to North Dakota. She was 7-of-11 from the field, 2-of-3 from three-point range, and 6-of-7 from the free throw line. Hansen dished out 6 assists and had 7 steals in the quarterfinal game against Minnesota State.

**QUIGLEY AND FRANCIS NAMED TO REGIONAL ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM:** Two SCSU sophomores were named to the 2005 North Central Region All-Tournament team. Quigley, also named Region Most Valuable Player, led all players in the tournament with an average 23.7 points per game and shot 51.8% from the field. She also averaged 11.0 rebounds per game. Guard Shannon Francis (Mahnomen) hit 7 three-pointers in the tournament and averaged 14.3 points per game. She was perfect from the free throw line, sinking 10-of-10 shots, and also had 12 assists.

**ALL-NORTH CENTRAL CONFERENCE HONORS:** Three Huskies were distinguished among the top players in the NCC for 2004-05. Junior Sascha Hansen and sophomore Erika Quigley were named to the All-North Central Conference Team and senior Katie Huschle was named Honorable Mention. Hansen led the NCC for three-point field goal shooting percentage (49.2) and was the 12th leading scorer in the league. She ranked third in the conference for three-point field goals made per game (2.17). Quigley led the NCC in scoring (22.5), rebounding (12.1), and blocked shots (2.62). She was named NCC Player of the Week four times. Huschle was second in the NCC in free throw percentage (87.5) and assists (4.66).

**ALL-ACADEMIC NCC TEAM:** Four St. Cloud State women's basketball athletes were named to the 2004-05 Academic All-North Central Conference team. Junior Sascha Hansen and senior Katie Huschle were honored as first team selections and senior Molly Jensen and sophomore Shannon Francis were named Honorable Mention. Hansen is a Physical Education major with a cumulative 3.55 GPA who averaged 11.9 ppg this season. Huschle, an Elementary Education major, maintains a 3.41 GPA and averaged 11.5 ppg.

**REGULAR SEASON ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM SELECTIONS:** Erika Quigley: Grand Valley State Days Inn Tournament Most Valuable Player and All-Tournament Team, and American Family Insurance Classic All-Tournament Team in Duluth. Sascha Hansen: Grand Valley State Days Inn All-Tournament Team and American Family Insurance Classic All-Tournament Team in Duluth.

**HUSCHLE AND QUIGLEY REACH 1,000 POINTS:** Both senior Katie Huschle and sophomore Erika Quigley topped the 1,000 point mark of their careers during the 2004-05 season. Huschle is the most recent addition to SCSU's 1,000 Point Club, hitting the mark on March 4, 2005 against North Dakota. Huschle wrapped up her four-year career with 1,043 total points scored. Quigley reached the 1,000 mark on March 1, 2005 against Minnesota State. She is just the third Husky to reach this milestone as a sophomore, Diane Scherer being the first in 1980 and Ramona Rugloski following suit in 1982. Quigley has 1,129 total career points so far.

**TEAM AWARDS:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team has announced its 2005 team award winners. Sophomore center Erika Quigley (Duluth) was selected as the team's Most Outstanding Player. Quigley led the team in scoring with 748 points and set a school record for rebounds in a season with 400. Junior guard Sascha Hansen (Marshall) was chosen as the team's Most Valuable Player. Hansen scored 392 points on the season and set a new school record for three-pointers made in a season with 65. The Most Improved Player award went to senior Krista Kettner. Kettner appeared in 23 games and averaged 2.7 points and 1.4 rebounds per game. April Carlson (Hugo) was named the Defensive Player of the year. Senior guard Molly Jensen (Minnetonka) and Hansen were given the Hustle Award.

**SCSU COACHING STAFF:** Dr. Lori Ulferts (North Dakota, 1983) finished her 11th season with the Huskies and 20th season as a collegiate head coach. Dr. Ulferts gained her 300th career win on December 19, 2004 against the University of Minnesota-Crookston. In her 11 seasons with the Huskies, Coach Ulferts has amassed a 162-145 record. She maintains a 314-234 record in her 20 years as a collegiate coach. Ulferts has also coached at MN-Crookston (4 seasons) and MSU, Moorhead (5 seasons). She is a two-time Northern Sun Conference Coach of the Year. Assisting Ulferts in his first season at St. Cloud State was former Franklin College head coach, Mike Jewett (Augustana College, 1994).

### SCSU Player Notes:

**Senior Molly Jensen:** Co-captain and senior guard Molly Jensen (Minnetonka) played in every game of her collegiate career, putting her in a fifth place tie for career games played at SCSU with 115. In her four-year stint, Jensen scored 596 points and has recorded 182 assists and 123 steals. She averaged 5.2 points and 2.5 rebounds per game in her career. She is a two-time Honorable Mention NCC All-Academic Team member. Jensen scored a career high 18 points on January 31, 2003 against Nebraska-Omaha. She recorded a career high 10 rebounds against Minnesota Duluth on March 12, 2005.

**Senior Katie Huschle:** Senior guard Katie Huschle (Eden Valley) reached the 1,000 point mark of her career on March 4, 2005 against North Dakota. She was the third-leading scorer for the Huskies this season with an average 11.5 points per game. She dished out a team high 148 assists on the season. Huschle finished her career ranked 11th in Division II free throw shooting percentage with a mark of 87.0% (107-123). Huschle rests at third for SCSU's all-time free throw shooting percentage with 80.7% on her career. Huschle also ranks among SCSU's top 15 players in assists, steals, free throws made, three-point field goal percentage, and three-point field goals made. Huschle received NCC Player of the Week honors on December 22, 2004. She scored a career high 30 points, including 4 three-pointers, on February 12, 2004 against South Dakota. She set her career assist record at 9 on January 20, 2005 against Minnesota Duluth. Huschle is a 2004-05 captain, an Honorable Mention All-NCC pick, and an Academic All-NCC team member.

**Senior Krista Kettner:** Kettner (Nicollet) is a two-year member of the Husky squad, as she transferred from Iowa Lakes Community College in 2003. She proved to be a valuable player from the bench, seeing playing time in 51 games in her career at SCSU. She averaged 2.9 points and 2.2 rebounds per game in two years. Kettner scored a career high 16 points against Augustana on February 17, 2005.

**Junior Sascha Hansen:** Junior guard Sascha Hansen (Marshall) has been an invaluable addition to the SCSU team since her arrival, having started in every game for the past three years. Hansen was the second-leading scorer for the Huskies this season, averaging 11.9 points per game. She set a new school record for three-point field goals made in a season with 65. For the majority of the season, Hansen hovered among the top three players nationally for three-point field goal percentage. She finished the season with a 45.8% average from long distance. Hansen made the 2004-05 season the best of her career, setting new personal bests in scoring (32 vs. UM-Crookston, 12/11/04), rebounding (12 vs. SMSU, 12/7/04), and assists (9 vs. Augustana, 1/15/05). Hansen is a two-time team captain, a 2005 All-NCC First Team member, and 2005 Academic All-NCC team member.

**Junior April Carlson:** Junior guard April Carlson (Hugo) was a strong presence in the Husky front court this season, making starts in all but one game in 2004-05. She averaged 4.9 points and 4.1 rebounds per game this season. Carlson is best known for her efforts on the defensive end of the court. She scored a career high 14 points against UC-San Diego on December 30, 2004.

**Sophomore Shannon Francis:** Shannon Francis (Mahnommen) was the fourth-leading scorer in 2004-05 with an average 10.5 points scored per game. She has played in every game of her career and has started in all but five games. Francis has hit 91 three-point shots in her career, including 52 this season. Francis scored a career high 22 points against Nebraska-Omaha on January 27, 2005. She also had a career high 8 rebounds against Augustana College on January 17, 2005.

**Sophomore Laura Legge:** Laura Legge (Aberdeen, SD) has come off the bench to see action in 48 games in her career. She averaged 2.1 points per game in 2004-05 and scored a career high 18 points on November 27, 2004 against Michigan Tech.

**Sophomore Erika Quigley:** Sophomore center Erika Quigley (Duluth) dominated the NCC this season. As both the leading scorer and rebounder for the Huskies, Quigley averaged 22.7 points and 12.1 rebounds per game. She became the third player in Husky history to reach 1,000 points as a sophomore on March 1, 2005. Quigley finished the season ranking nationally in rebounding (4th), scoring (8th), blocked shots per game (16th), and field goal percentage (42nd). Quigley was named both a Kodak First Team All-American and a Daktronics, Inc. First Team All-American in 2005. She was named NCC Player of the Week four times this season and recorded a conference high 23 double-doubles. Quigley set a new sophomore record for scoring average in the NCC and tied the sophomore record for rebounding. She is the 2005 North Central Region MVP, First Team All-NCC, and 2005 Daktronics, Inc. All-North Central Region First Team. She scored a career high 37 points against SMSU on December 7, 2004 and pulled down a career high 19 rebounds against North Dakota on February 3, 2005.

**Sophomore Sarah Cotner:** Due to a back injury, sophomore forward Cotner (Stillwater) was sidelined for the majority of the season. She played in 8 games early in the season and averaged 2.1 points and 1.3 rebounds.

**Freshman Maggie Youngberg:** Freshman guard Maggie Youngberg (Yankton, SD) saw playing time in 25 games in 2004-05. She averaged 1.6 points per game and hit 7 three-pointers. She recorded a personal high 8 points against North Central University on December 9, 2004.

**Freshman Kayla Rengel:** Rengel (St. Cloud) has been a poignant force from the bench this season. With an average of 7.3 points and 3.6 rebounds in 29 games, Rengel has both the ability to cover space down low and the efficiency to nail field goals from the wing. Rengel hit 4-of-4 threes to help SCSU advance to the second round of Regional playoffs. She has taken over the top position for SCSU's all-time three-point field goal percentage list with a mark of 44.9% (35-78). Rengel scored a career high 21 points against Augustana on January 15, 2005 and pulled down a personal high 10 rebounds on February 12, 2005 against South Dakota.
