**This Week:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team returns to Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) action this week. The Huskies will travel to the University of Minnesota Duluth on Friday, Jan. 9 and Bemidji State University on Saturday, Jan. 10 for two NSIC games. Game time both nights is 6:00 p.m.

The Huskies have a 36-23 advantage over UMD and last season split with the Bulldogs in North Central Conference action, winning at home 86-72 and losing in Duluth, 72-65. St. Cloud State is 27-12 against Bemidji State. The last time these two teams played was during the 2006-07 season and the result was a 79-69 Bemidji State win.

**For the Record:** St. Cloud State enters the week in sole possession of second place in the NSIC with an 11-1 overall record and 4-1 league mark. Minnesota Duluth is tied for 7th with a 3-3 NSIC record and 6-7 overall mark. Bemidji State enters the week with an 0-6 NSIC mark and a 2-11 overall record.

**SCSU Team Captains:** Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

**Series Records:** Both the Minnesota Duluth and Bemidji State rivalries with the Huskies have been in the books since the 1970 season.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



**Darby Noreen** is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



**Katie Jensen** will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

## Game Notes

**About St. Cloud State:** St. Cloud State is 11-1 overall and has won four straight games. The Huskies finished the non-conference portion of the schedule with a 7-0 record. The Huskies continue to shoot well this season as St. Cloud State is shooting nearly 50 percent (.488) from the floor and 39.5 percent from three-point range. St. Cloud State has an impressive +21.5 scoring margin over their opponents and are averaging 80.9 points per game. Twice this season the Huskies have scored over 100 points in a game, marking the first time since the 2005-06 season that SCSU has gone over 100 twice in a season. The school record for points scored in a game is 123 scored against Morningside College during the 1998-99 season. The Huskies have scored 90 or more points three times this season. Three players are averaging double figures in scoring led by sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) with 16.9 points. Senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) is next with 16.8 points and sophomore post Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) is third averaging 12.0 points per game.

**In the NSIC:** St. Cloud State is in sole possession of second place in the NSIC standings with a 4-1 record. Minnesota State University, Mankato at 5-0 leads the league. Through five NSIC games, St. Cloud State leads the league in scoring offense with 75.4 points per game and is tied for the league lead in turnover margin. The Huskies ranks second in the league in scoring margin (+9.4) and three-point field goal percentage (.429).

**Barlow Leads the League in Scoring, Tacheny Second:** Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) leads the NSIC in league scoring with 18.6 points per game. Close behind Barlow is senior teammate Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) who is averaging 18.0 points per game. Barlow also leads the league in three-point field goal percentage (.692) and Tacheny is third (.533). Barlow and Tacheny are third and fifth, respectively in field goal shooting percentage. Tacheny is second in the league in assist to turnover ratio.

**NSIC Preseason Poll:** The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another

newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

### TACHENY NAMED NSIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

St. Cloud State senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) was named the NSIC Player of the Week on Jan. 5. Tacheny averaged 23.0 points, six steals and four assists in wins over Minot State and Concordia, St. Paul last week. She shot 55.6 percent from the field and was 80 percent (12-15) from the free throw line. Tacheny tallied her first collegiate double double of 29 points and ten steals against Minot State on Dec. 30. The 29 points and ten steals were career highs and the ten steals tied the SCSU single game record set in 1982. Against Concordia, St. Paul, she had 17 points. She is the first Husky to earn the honor in the new league.



## Player Notes

**#3 Katie Tacheny Notes:** Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) averaged 23.0 points, six steals and four assists in wins over Minot State and Concordia, St. Paul last week...shot 55.6 percent from the field and was 80 percent (12-15) from the free throw line....tallied her first collegiate double double of 29 points and ten steals against Minot State on Dec. 30...the 29 points and ten steals were career highs and the ten steals tied the SCSU single game record set in 1982. Against Concordia, St. Paul, she had 17 points...has scored in double figures in ten games this season...made ten free throws at Upper Iowa, marking the fourth time in her career that she has made ten or more free throws in a game....has started 57 straight games for the Huskies.



**#10 Krystal Scott Notes:** Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) scored a career high 16 points against Dakota State on Dec. 22, her fifth double figure scoring game of the season...Scott has played in a team high 97 games...has started 21 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season.



**#11 Talisha Barlow Notes:** Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) averaged 18 points, 7.5 rebounds and four assists in wins over Minot State and Concordia, St. Paul last week... collected her second collegiate double-double against Dakota State on 12/22 with a 15 point, 10 rebound game...scored a career high 25 points in the Huskies loss to 13th-ranked MSU Moorhead on 12/12/08...has scored in double figures ten times this season...has played in every game, 40 straight, of her collegiate career and made 35 starts... had a career high seven steals in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08...averaging a team leading 16.9 points per game.



**#21 Anna Cashman Notes:** Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) dished out a career high eight assists against Dakota State on 12/22/08...tallied a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...scored a season high 17 points in win over Nebraska-Omaha...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



**#23 Danielle Ellison Notes:** Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a season high 12 points against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...also had a season high seven rebounds against MSU Moorhead...has started in 29 career games and played in 68 career games as a Husky...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.



**#32 Rachel Booth Notes:** Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) has scored in double figures in eight games this season... tallied a season high 19 points in the Huskies 73-55 win over Northwest Missouri State... has missed two games during her collegiate career... missed the final game of her rookie season due to an injury and this year missed the game against CSP with an injury...has played in 38 of the 38 games of her collegiate career.....starter in 36 collegiate games...has scored in double figures in 28 games during her collegiate career...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07.

**#34 Megan Foley:** Junior guard and team captain, Foley (St. Cloud) scored her first points of the season against Northwest Missouri State...twice has notched two blocked shots in a game this season... equaled her career high of seven rebounds, all on the defensive boards against Dakota State on Nov. 21...played in 13 games in 2007-08 and scored her career high eight points against Lake Superior State on 12/22/07...has missed the last three games due to injury.



**#2 Becca Friestleben Notes:** First year guard Becca Friestleben (Victoria) scored her career high 12 points against Dakota State on 12/22 with four of six shooting from three-point range...her three rebounds, five assists and two steals in that same game were all career highs...has played in nine games this season... holds Holy Family Catholic High School all-time scoring record (boys and girls) with 2,515 career points...led State in three-point baskets made three years in a row.



**#13 Marlayna Graff Notes:** Sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) is a transfer who sat out the second half of the Huskies 2007-08 season...made first collegiate start against Concordia, St. Paul on Jan. 3 and posted four points, five rebounds and two steals...has played in 11 games this season (missed game on 12/22 with the flu)...equaled her season and career high seven points against Upper Iowa on Dec. 6...had a season and career high three steals against Henderson State on Nov. 21...named a NJCAA Division III Preseason Second Team All-American in the fall of 2007 prior to her transfer to St. Cloud State.



**#35 Amy Frye Notes:** First year forward Amy Frye (Hudson, WI) has played in five games this season... tallied season high four rebounds against Dakota State on 12/22...had two points, two assists and two steals, all season highs against Dakota State on Nov. 22... scored 262 points, pulled down 128 rebounds, had 37 steals, and 24 blocked shots during her senior campaign at Hudson (WI) High School.



**#43 Christina Steele Notes:** First year post Christina Steele (Apple Valley) scored ten points and seven rebounds in 15 minutes against Concordia, St. Paul on Jan. 3...the seven rebounds is a career high for Steele... scored eight points in her collegiate debut on Nov. 15...has played in seven games this season...scored a career high 11 points against Dakota State on 12/22...three-time First Team All-Lake Conference in high school...holds record for most points in a season with 504...team rebounding leader for three straight years.

**About Minnesota Duluth:** The Bulldogs along with the Huskies are two of the four new teams to join the NSIC this season. Minnesota Duluth is coming off a road series at Wayne State and Augustana College. The Bulldogs defeated Wayne State 63-54 and lost to Augustana College 72-60 last Friday and Saturday. UMD is 6-7 overall, 3-3 in the NSIC, and have won four of their last six games. Junior Jheri Booker leads the team in scoring and rebounding with 15.5 points and 8.1 rebounds per game. The Bulldogs average 64.0 points per game and are allowing 67.4. UMD averages 35.5 rebounds per game.
