### This Week Marks Start of Four

**Game Home Stand:** The St. Cloud State women's basketball team returns to Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) action this week. The Huskies will host the University of Mary on Friday, Jan. 23 and Northern State University on Saturday, Jan.24. Tip-off is 6:00 p.m. both nights in Halenbeck Hall (6927).

**For the Record:** St. Cloud State is in sole possession of second place in the NSIC with a 7-2 league mark and 14-2 overall record. The University of Mary is in tenth place in the league standings with a 9-7 overall record and 4-5 conference mark. Northern State is 9-7 overall and 5-4 in the league, and tied for seventh place.

**Series Records:** The St. Cloud State women and the University of Mary will play each other for the first time this Friday. Mary is a new member to the NCAA Division II ranks. The Huskies and Northern State University have played each other twice with Northern State winning both contests. The first game was played in 1995-96, a 76-66 Wolves win. Last year, the two teams met in a non-conference game in Aberdeen, SD, a 74-52 SCSU loss.

**SCSU Team Captains:** Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

Assistant Coaches



St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



**Darby Noreen** is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



**Katie Jensen** will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

## Game Notes

**About St. Cloud State:** St. Cloud State suffered its second loss of the season to third-ranked Minnesota State University, Mankato Saturday night, 67-60. Both Husky losses have been to top 25 teams, as SCSU lost to 13th-ranked MSU Moorhead earlier this season. The losses have been by a combined nine points. The Huskies finished the non-conference portion of the schedule with a 7-0 record. The Huskies are shooting at a rate of 47.5 percent from the field and 38 percent from beyond the arc. St. Cloud State has an impressive +18.3 scoring margin over their opponents and are averaging 78.6 points per game. The Huskies lead the NSIC in scoring with 73.8 points per game. Twice this season the Huskies have scored over 100 points in a game, marking the first time since the 2005-06 season that SCSU has gone over 100 twice in a season. The school record for points scored in a game is 123 scored against Morningside College during the 1998-99 season. The Huskies have scored 90 or more points three times this season. Three players are averaging double figures in scoring led by senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) with 17.9 points, sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) with 16.6 points per game, and sophomore post Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) is averaging 12.7 points per game.

**Fish Gets 75th Career Win:** St. Cloud State head coach Lori Fish collected her 75th career win on Jan. 10 at Bemidji State. Fish has a 76-55 career record in four plus seasons as a collegiate head coach.

**Tacheny Leads the League in Scoring, Barlow Fourth:** Senior guard Katie Tacheny leads the NSIC in scoring with a 19.4 points per game average. She takes over the top spot previously held by teammate sophomore guard Talisha Barlow. This week, Barlow ranks fourth in league scoring with 17.2 points per game. Barlow leads the NSIC in three-point field goal percentage (.524) and Tacheny is third (.484). Sophomore post Rachel Booth ranks fifth in the league in field goal percent (.537) and Tacheny is sixth (.527) and Barlow eighth (.512). Tacheny is fourth in free throw percentage (.877), fifth in assists (4.22), third in steals (3.00), tenth in three-point field goals made and second in assist/turnover ratio. Booth ranks fifth in the league in blocked shots (1.38) and Barlow is tied for sixth in steals.

**30+ Points:** Tacheny scored a career high 31 points last Saturday against Southwest Minnesota State. The last Husky to score 30 or more points was three-time NCAA Division II Player of the Year Erika Quigley.

Quigley scored 35 points in the final game of her collegiate career on Feb. 28, 2007.

**Receiving Votes:** St. Cloud State earned 30 points in the Jan. 20th *USA Today* ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll, and have yet to crack the top 25. NSIC member Minnesota State University, Mankato is ranked third and MSU Moorhead is 18th in the weekly poll. The Huskies have received votes in three straight polls.

**NSIC Preseason Poll:** The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

## Player Notes

**#3 Katie Tacheny Notes:** Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) scored a career high 31 points against Southwest Minnesota State last Friday...averaged 25 points, 6.5 rebounds, 6.5 assists and 3.5 steals over the weekend...had a season high nine assists against SMSU...tallied her first collegiate double double of 29 points and ten steals against Minot State on Dec. 30 with 29 points and ten steals, and the ten steals tied the SCSU single game record set in 1982...has scored in double figures in 15 games this season...ten free throws made at BSU, marked the fifth time in her career that she has made ten or more free throws in a game.... has started 61 straight games for the Huskies.



**#10 Krystal Scott Notes:** Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) scored 12 points and pulled in a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota State on Jan. 17...it marked her seventh double figure scoring game of the season...scored a career high 16 points against Dakota State on Dec. 22...Scott has played in a team high 101 games as a Husky...has started 25 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season.



**#11 Talisha Barlow Notes:** Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) averaged 14 points and six rebounds last weekend...collected her second collegiate double-double against Dakota State on 12/22 with a 15 point, 10 rebound game...scored a career high 25 points in the Huskies loss to 13th-ranked MSU Moorhead on 12/12/08...has scored in double figures 15 times this season...has played in every game, 44 straight, of her collegiate career and made 39 starts...had a career high seven steals in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08.



**#21 Anna Cashman Notes:** Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) had nine rebounds over the weekend...dished out a career high eight assists against Dakota State on 12/22/08...tallied a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...scored a season high 17 points in win over Nebraska-Omaha...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



**#23 Danielle Ellison Notes:** Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) equaled her season high with 12 points against UMD on Jan. 9...scored a season high 12 points against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...also had a season high seven rebounds against MSU Moorhead...has started in 42 career games and played in 72 career games as a Husky...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.



**#32 Rachel Booth Notes:** Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) scored 20 points against Southwest Minnesota State...equaled her career high with 22 points at BSU on Jan. 10...has scored in double figures in 11 games this season... has missed two games during her collegiate career... missed the final game of her rookie season due to an injury and this year missed the game against CSP with an injury...starter in 41 of 42 collegiate games...has scored in double figures in 30 games during her collegiate career...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07.

**#2 Becca Friestleben Notes:** First year guard Becca Friestleben (Victoria) came off the bench against BSU to score six points on three point baskets and handed out an assist to spark the Huskies and equaled career high with three rebounds...scored her career high 12 points against Dakota State on 12/22 with four of six shooting from three-point range...her three rebounds, five assists and two steals in that same game were all career highs...has played in 11 games this season... holds Holy Family Catholic High School all-time scoring record (boys and girls) with 2,515 career points...led State in three-point baskets made three years in a row.



**#13 Marlayna Graff Notes:** Sophomore post Marlayna Graff (Harris) is a transfer who sat out the second half of the Huskies 2007-08 season...has started two games this season...has played in 15 games this season (missed game on 12/22 with the flu)... equaled her season and career high seven points against Upper Iowa on Dec. 6...had a season and career high three steals against Henderson State on Nov. 21...named a NJCAA Division III Preseason Second Team All-American in the fall of 2007 prior to her transfer to St. Cloud State.



**#35 Amy Frye Notes:** First year forward Amy Frye (Hudson, WI) has played in five games this season... tallied season high four rebounds against Dakota State on 12/22...had two points, two assists and two steals, all season highs against Dakota State on Nov. 22...scored 262 points, pulled down 128 rebounds, had 37 steals, and 24 blocked shots during her senior campaign at Hudson (WI) High School.
