Second Half Has Begun: The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will take to the road for much of the second half of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) schedule as the Huskies will play six of their final nine games on the road. The Huskies travel to Wayne State (NE) College on Friday, Jan. 30 and Augustana College on Saturday, Jan. 31. Both games are scheduled for 6:00 p.m. kick-offs on their respective campus.

For the Record: St. Cloud State is in sole possession of second place in the NSIC with a 9-2 league mark and 16-2 overall record. Wayne State College is in a three-way tie for fourth with a 7-4 league record and is 10-8 overall. Augustana College enters the week in sole possession of third place with an 8-3 NSIC mark and 14-4 overall record.

Series Records: The Huskies and Wildcats of Wayne State have played five games since the 1991 season. St. Cloud State leads the series 4-1. The last time these two teams met was on Dec. 7, 2002, a 70-60 Wayne State win at the Southwest State Tournament. Augustana and St. Cloud State are former foes in the North Central Conference and have played 50 games since 1984. Augustana leads the all-time series 26-24. Last year, Augustana swept the NCC series, winning 84-61 and 74-64. The Vikings have won four straight against the Huskies. The last SCSU win was at the 2006 NCAA North Central Region Tournament.

SCSU Team Captains: Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

Assistant Coaches



St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



Darby Noreen is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



Katie Jensen will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

Game Notes

About St. Cloud State: St. Cloud State has swept three NSIC weekend series this season and are in sole possession of second place in the league standings. The Huskies, who are 8-2 on their home court and 5-0 away from home this season will play six of their final nine games on the road, beginning this weekend at fourth place Wayne State College and third place Augustana College. The Huskies finished the non-conference portion of the schedule with a 7-0 record. Three Husky starters average double figures in scoring led by senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) with 17.5 points, sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) with 16.1 points and sophomore post Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) with 12.4 points. The Huskies are shooting at a rate of 47.7 percent from the field and 38 percent from beyond the arc. St. Cloud State has an impressive +18.0 scoring margin over their opponents and are averaging 78.8 points per game. Twice this season the Huskies have scored over 100 points in a game, marking the first time since the 2005-06 season that SCSU has gone over 100 twice in a season. The school record for points scored in a game is 123 scored against Morningside College during the 1998-99 season. The Huskies have scored 90 or more points three times this season.

In the NSIC: The Huskies rank first in the NSIC in scoring margin (+10.3), three-point field goal percentage (.400), and turnover margin (+7.18).

Fish Gets 75th Career Win: St. Cloud State head coach Lori Fish collected her 75th career win on Jan. 10 at Bemidji State. Fish has a 78-55 career record in four plus seasons as a collegiate head coach.

Tacheny Leads the League in Scoring: Senior guard Katie Tacheny leads the NSIC in scoring with a 18.5 points per game average.

30+ Points: Tacheny scored a career high 31 points Jan. 16 against Southwest Minnesota State. The last Husky to score 30 or more points was three-time NCAA Division II Player of the Year Erika Quigley. Quigley scored 35 points in the final game of her collegiate career on Feb. 28, 2007.

Receiving Votes: St. Cloud State earned 30 points in the Jan. 20th *USA Today* ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll, and have yet to crack the top 25. NSIC member Minnesota State University, Mankato is ranked third and MSU Moorhead is 18th in the weekly poll. The Huskies have received votes in three straight polls. The next poll is out Jan. 27.

NSIC Preseason Poll: The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

#3 Katie Tacheny Notes: Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) scored a career high 31 points against Southwest Minnesota State on Jan. 16...leads the NSIC in scoring with 18.5 ppg...averaged 14 points, 5.5 assists and 2.5 steals over the weekend...had a season high nine assists against SMSU...tallied her first collegiate double double of 29 points and ten steals against Minot State on Dec. 30 with 29 points and ten steals, and the ten steals tied the SCSU single game record set in 1982...has scored in double figures in 16 games this season...ten free throws made against Mary on Friday marked the sixth time in her career that she has made ten or more free throws in a game...has started 63 straight games for the Huskies.



#10 Krystal Scott Notes: Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) scored 11 against Mary last Friday...it marked her eighth double figure scoring game of the season...scored a career high 16 points against Dakota State on Dec. 22...Scott has played in a team high 103 games as a Husky...has started 27 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season.



#11 Talisha Barlow Notes: Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) averaged 12 points last weekend...collected her second collegiate double-double against Dakota State on 12/22 with a 15 point, 10 rebound game...scored a career high 25 points in the Huskies loss to 13th-ranked MSU Moorhead on 12/12/08...has scored in double figures 16 times this season...has played in every game, 46 straight, of her collegiate career and made 41 starts...had a career high seven steals in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08.



#21 Anna Cashman Notes: Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) averaged 11.5 points, 3.5 assists, 2.5 steals, and shot 61.5 percent from the field including 63.6 percent (7 of 11) from three-point range in St. Cloud State's wins over Mary (87-74) and Northern State (73-54)...back to back games of double figure scoring, 11 points vs. Mary and 12 vs. Northern...one other game in double figures, scoring 17 points at Nebraska-Omaha back in November...made three of five three-pointers against Mary and four of six against Northern...six assists against NSU, second highest total of the season...dished out a career high eight assists against Dakota State on 12/22/08...tallied a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...scored a season high 17 points in win over Nebraska-Omaha...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



#23 Danielle Ellison Notes: Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored 11 points against Mary, one point shy of her season high in 2008-09...scored a season high 12 points against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08 and UMD on 1/9/09...also had a season high seven rebounds against MSU Moorhead...has started in 44 career games and played in 74 career games as a Husky...scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.



#32 Rachel Booth Notes: Sophomore center Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) scored a game high 17 points against Northern State on Jan. 24...equaled her career high with 22 points at BSU on Jan. 10...has scored in double figures in 12 games this season...has missed two games during her collegiate career...missed the final game of her rookie season due to an injury and this year missed the game against CSP with an injury...starter in 43 of 44 collegiate games...has scored in double figures in 31 games during her collegiate career...recorded her first collegiate double-double in an 18 point, 17 rebound effort against Sonoma State on 12/29/07.
