Good To Be Home : The St. Cloud State women's basketball team will host the University of Minnesota Duluth and Bemidji State University in Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) action on Friday and Saturday, Feb. 6 & 7. Both games will tip-off at 6:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall (6,927). These games are two of the three remaining home games of the regular season for the Huskies. St. Cloud State will be on the road for its next four games and return home for the season finale on Feb. 28.

Series Records: Both the Minnesota Duluth and Bemidji State rivalries with the Huskies have been in the books since the 1970 season.

The Huskies have a 37-23 series lead with the Bulldogs, including a 75-61 win in Duluth on Jan. 9. The Huskies and Bulldogs are 5-5 over their last ten games.

St. Cloud State is 28-12 against Bemidji State in a series that includes a 76-70 Husky win on Jan. 10 in Bemidji.

For the Record: St. Cloud State is tied for second in the NSIC standings with Augustana College as both teams sport a 10-3 league record. The Huskies are 17-3 overall. Minnesota Duluth is in a three-way tie for fifth place with an 8-5 NSIC record and are 11-9 overall. Bemidji State brings a 2-18 overall record and 0-13 NSIC mark into the week.

SCSU Team Captains: Senior guards Anna Cashman (Faribault) and Katie Tacheny (Woodbury), along with junior guard Megan Foley (St. Cloud) captain the 2008-09 Huskies.

Head Coach Lori Fish

Lori Fish is a familiar name to the St. Cloud area. Fish grew up in St. Cloud and attended St. Cloud Tech High School. Following her graduation from Tech, she went on to play basketball at South Dakota State and competed against the Huskies in the North Central Conference.



Following the completion of an outstanding collegiate playing career where she gained First Team All-Conference honors as a junior and senior, Fish entered the coaching ranks. She started as a high school coach in Foley, Minn., for two seasons before returning to South Dakota State as a graduate assistant coach. She spent one year at NCAA Division I Eastern Illinois University and returned to SDSU as an assistant. In 1999, Lori Ulferts hired Fish as an assistant to the Husky program and she served as the recruiting and strength and conditioning coordinator under Ulferts for five seasons. In 2004, Fish became a head coach at rival Minnesota State University, Mankato. She quickly distinguished herself as a rising young coach and in 2007-08, her final season with the Mavericks, led her team to a 23-9 record and the championship game of the NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament.

In four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Fish has compiled a 62-53 overall won/loss record.

St. Cloud State assistant coach **Carol Thelen** is in her third season with the Huskies. An SCSU alumnus and Albany, Minn., native, Thelen had been the head girls basketball coach at DeLaSalle High School in Minneapolis since 1999.



Darby Noreen is in her rookie season with the Huskies. An Albany, Minn., native, Noreen was a standout athlete at Albany High School and the College of St. Benedict. She has been an assistant coach at both Albany and St. Ben's.



Katie Jensen will serve as a student assistant coach in 2008-09. Jensen played for the Huskies from 2005 to 2007. She is a graduate of English Valleys (IA) High School.

Game Notes

About St. Cloud State: St. Cloud State suffered its first road loss of the season and third overall defeat of the year last Saturday, 74-66 at Augustana. The Huskies are 6-1 on the road this season, having defeated Wayne State on Friday night, 63-54. Following the two home games this weekend, SCSU will be on the road for the next four games and will finish the regular season at home on Feb. 28 against Winona State. The Huskies finished the non-conference portion of the schedule with a 7-0 record. Three Husky starters average double figures in scoring and are shooting 50 percent or better from the field led by senior guard Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) with 17.2 points and a 51.8 shooting percentage, sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) with 15.6 points and a 52.1 shooting percentage, and sophomore post Rachel Booth (Minneapolis) with 12.5 points and a 51.9 percentage. Reserve first-year forward Aaryn Booker (Minneapolis) is also shooting better than 50 percent from the field with a mark of 52.6 percent. St. Cloud State has a +16.8 scoring margin over their opponents and are averaging 77.3 points per game. Twice this season the Huskies have scored over 100 points in a game, marking the first time since the 2005-06 season that SCSU has gone over 100 twice in a season. The school record for points scored in a game

is 123 scored against Morningside College during the 1998-99 season. The Huskies have scored 90 or more points three times this season.

In the NSIC: The Huskies rank second in the NSIC in scoring offense (73.3), scoring margin (+8.8), and 3-point field goal percentage (.392)

Tacheny Leads the League in Scoring:

Senior guard Katie Tacheny leads the NSIC in scoring with a 17.8 points per game average. She also is the league leader in assist/turnover margin.

30+ Points: Tacheny scored a career high 31 points Jan. 16 against Southwest Minnesota State. The last Husky to score 30 or more points was three-time NCAA Division II Player of the Year Erika Quigley. Quigley scored 35 points in the final game of her collegiate career on Feb. 28, 2007.

Receiving Votes: St. Cloud State earned 27 points in the Jan. 27th *USA Today*/ESPN Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll, and have yet to crack the top 25. NSIC member Minnesota State University, Mankato is ranked sixth and MSU Moorhead is 22nd in the weekly poll. The Huskies have received votes in four straight polls. The next poll is out Feb. 3

NSIC Preseason Poll: The 2008-09 NSIC Women's Basketball Coaches Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 22 and the Huskies were picked to finish eighth in the league. Conference newcomer Minnesota State University, Mankato was tabbed the preseason favorite followed by another newcomer Augustana College. Concordia-St. Paul, the defending NSIC champion was picked third.

Fish Gets 75th Career Win: St. Cloud State head coach Lori Fish collected her 75th career win on Jan. 10 at Bemidji State. Fish has a 78-55 career record in four plus seasons as a collegiate head coach.

Fourth in the Region: The first NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Region poll was released on Jan. 28 and St. Cloud State University is ranked fourth in the Central Region.

#3 Katie Tacheny Notes: Guard and senior captain Katie Tacheny (Woodbury) scored a career high 31 points against Southwest Minnesota State on Jan. 16...leads the NSIC in scoring...averaged 14 points and 5.5 assists over the weekend...had a season high nine assists against SMSU...tallied her first collegiate double double of 29 points and ten steals against Minot State on Dec. 30 with 29 points and ten steals, and the ten steals tied the SCSU single game record set in 1982...has scored in double figures in 18 games this season...ten free throws made against Mary on Jan. 23 marked the sixth time in her career that she has made ten or more free throws in a game....has started 65 straight games for the Huskies.



#10 Krystal Scott Notes: Senior guard Krystal Scott (Rosemount) has scored in double figures eight times this season...scored a career high 16 points against Dakota State on Dec. 22...Scott has played in a team high 105 games as a Husky...has started 29 straight games including the final nine of the 2007-08 season.



#11 Talisha Barlow Notes: Sophomore guard Talisha Barlow (Little Canada) collected her second double double of the season and third of her collegiate career against Augustana with ten points and ten rebounds...equaled her career high of ten rebounds...collected her second collegiate double-double against Dakota State on 12/22 with a 15 point, 10 rebound game...scored a career high 25 points in the Huskies loss to 13th-ranked MSU Moorhead on 12/12/08...has scored in double figures 18 times this season...has played in every game, 48 straight, of her collegiate career and made 43 starts...had a career high seven steals in the season opener against UW-Oshkosh on Nov. 15...tallied her first collegiate double-double vs UNO with 21 points/ten rebounds on 2/14/08.



#21 Anna Cashman Notes: Senior guard and captain Anna Cashman (Faribault) matched her career high with seven rebounds against Wayne State on Jan. 30...has back to back games of double figure scoring, 11 points vs. Mary and 12 vs. Northern...one other game in double figures, scoring 17 points at Nebraska-Omaha back in November...dished out a career high eight assists against Dakota State on 12/22/08...tallied a career high seven rebounds against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08...scored a season high 17 points in win over Nebraska-Omaha...led the 2007-08 team with 46 three-point field goals...scored a career high 23 points vs. UW-Stout on 11/17/07, hitting eight of 12 field goals...twice during the 2007-08 season she made five three-point baskets in a game.



#23 Danielle Ellison Notes: Senior forward Danielle Ellison (St. Paul) scored a season high 12 points against Minnesota, Crookston on 12/13/08 and UMD on 1/9/09...also had a season high seven rebounds against MSU Moorhead...has started in 46 career games and played in 76 career games as a Husky....scored her career high 18 points against Chico State on 12/28/07.
